They are still being ruled as a conquered people by an alien military occupation force which, however benevolent in intent, is not exactly the best demonstration of a Democratic Regime. . . . The Japanese people well know where the real authority lies and in consequence attribute most of their ills to their alien, that is, American rulers. This would be less serious if Gen MacArthur's success in the political field could be matched in the economic field. . . With obvious reference to these policies Gen MacArthur told the Japanese on their anniversary that the continued occupation of their country was not due to any faults on their part . . . 




