The Civil Service Commission recently criticized the Department for delays in processing retirement accounts of employees having periods of overseas service. The Civilian Retirement Accounts Branch, Records Administration Center, St Louis, Missouri, the activity responsible for maintaining records of deductions and service of employees stationed overseas, is taking aggressive action to reduce existing backlog and to develop better internal operating procedures to expedite the handling of retirement cases. Overseas commanders should likewise review the situation with respect to;

(A). Prompt submission of complete reports of retirement deductions,

(B). Maintenance of prescribed retirement controls,

(C). Handling of request for information originated by the Civilian Retirement Accounts Branch.

Full compliance with the Provisions of Civilian Personnel Regulation 211 (27 Sept 45) and Civilian Personnel Regulation P 19.7 is necessary to achieve satisfactory accounting for retirement deductions and to prevent future criticisms from outside agencies and individuals. In connection with the above matter, reference is made to the Secretary of the Army's Cable of 17 Nov 1948 (WCL 22828), and letters of this office dated 15 December 47 and 21 August 46 which emphasized the importance of prompt and accurate handling of retirement matters.
