1. DA radio NCL 32975 transmitted grain shipping schedule for July-September 1949. A total of 286,000 L/T will be shipped in July; 279,000 L/T in August; and 277,000 L/T in September. Cured C 51020 and oured C 50923 indicated a grain handling capacity of 300,000 M/T, 285,000 M/T and 285,000 M/T for July, August and September shipments respectively.

2. The instant radio points out that the subject shipping schedule represents the imported grain handling capacity in Japan and, while satisfactory, should not be increased.

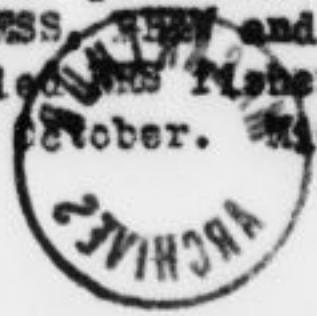

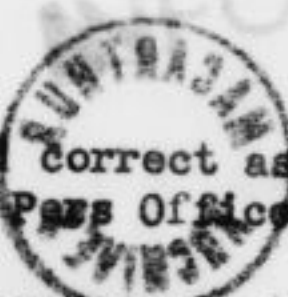
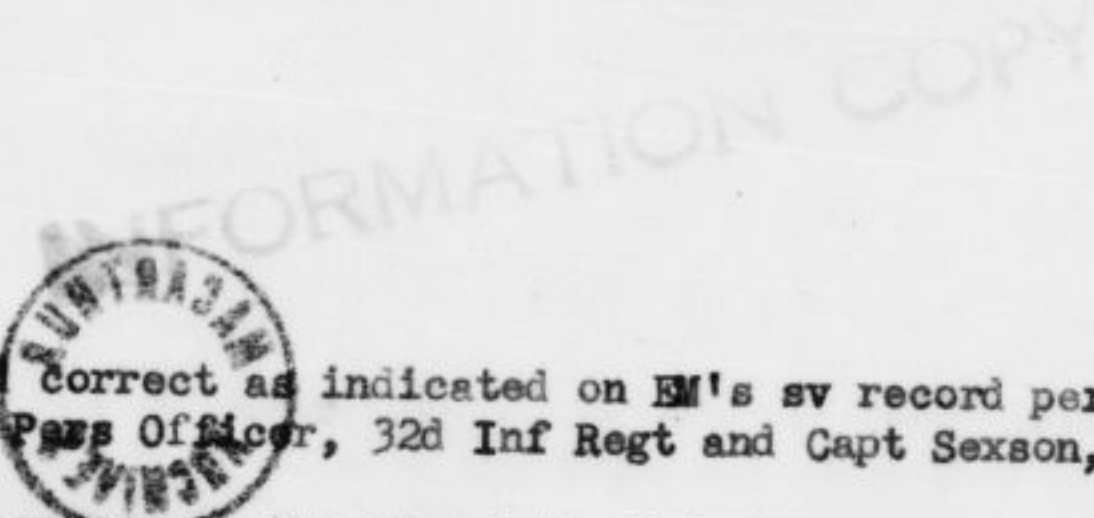

2. The report is unclassified. It contains nothing detrimental to Occupation objectives nor is it critical of SCAP activities. On the contrary, it is objective and constructive and has proved valuable to Japanese scholars and to CIE.
3. Because of paper limitations only a small number of copies of the report were mimeographed. In accordance with established procedure, ten copies were sent to DA. On 23 Apr 49, ltr fr The adjutant General, DA, requested one hundred additional copies for CI distribution. These copies were furnished

4. Personal ltr fr Dr. Charles ... Dean of International Law and Political Science at the University of Washington and Chairman of the Cultural Science Mission, to a CIE officer, dated 6 Jun, made request as follows:

"May I ask you to confer with Mr. Lewis and Col Nigent, and determine whether or not I am authorized to proceed, as Mr. Orr said I might, in the mimeographing and the circularization, on the Pacific Coast especially, of the Cultural Science Mission report. This will be circularized with a brief preface explaining the purpose and the objects of the mission."

5. Chief, CIE, perceived no reason to refuse this request; the report was unclassified; it had been given distribution by the DA; its publication would stimulate interest in the reorientation program; nothing was contained in the report which might embarrass this hq. With approval of Chief, CIE, Dr. Martin was informed that there was no objection to his mimeographing and distributing the report.

6. Although it was now understood by CIE that the Report would be printed as a Bulletin of the University of Washington Institute of International Affairs, no reason is seen to object to its reproduction in that form. Given the distribution ordinarily accorded the Bulletin, the report would reach those most likely to be interested in the reorientation program in Japan.

7. Reason for query of DA contained in WCL 32063 is not understood by Chief, CIE, nor by Col Lynch, Acting Chief, Reorientation Branch, SAOS, presently in Japan on TDY.

1. Subject is re-entry of Japanese insurance companies into international marine insurance field. Consideration is being given to the authorization of a program which would permit Japanese marine insurance companies to write marine insurance on export-import shipments to Dollar and Sterling areas, in line with policy of restoring desirable prewar activities to the Japanese, which strengthen their economy and provide sources of foreign exchange.

2. Establishment of such a policy entails foreign exchange guaranteed by Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers of Dollar and Sterling losses until satisfactory reserves can be built up. Japanese insurance companies would operate within framework of own currency regulations, but premiums would accrue to SCAP commercial accounts in Dollars or Sterling, and the Japanese insurance companies would be permitted to purchase Dollars or Sterling exchange to meet approved claims.

3. In early stages of program, Japanese companies would be restricted to acceptance of risks up to \$50,000 per individual policy on any one shipment, with a maximum exposure of \$100,000 per bottom, balances over these amounts to be automatically reinsured with foreign insurance companies until foreign currency credit reserves built up through operations warrant increased retentions by the Japanese companies for their own account. Japanese companies would be permitted to write outstanding coverage equal to five times the \$2,000,000 liability limit assumed by Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.

4. Information is requested as to any steps considered necessary to assure general acceptance of Japanese insurance policies in areas under United States jurisdiction, as well as any information which may
