



DA msg WCL 21242, 23 Oct 50, in answer to CINCFE msg 21550, 20 Oct 50, states no official offer recd fm Jack Benny for tour FEC and that Hollywood co-ordinating committee advises formal offer will be forthcoming within 3 weeks; req if stipulations contained in CINCFE Msg 216910, 19 Oct 50, on time and male and female pers will apply.
- 2. CINCFE msg Z-16910 states minimum of 21 days required for celebrity units and 6 males maximum in Korea with total of 12 males and females in other areas of FEC.
- 3. Bob Hope unit totalling 61 personnel accepted by G-1, GHQ, FEC and entire unit, including females, are currently touring Korea.

- 1. Data rgstd in urmsg WCL 20801. 21 Oct 50 being furn'd in consolidated FEC repts in reply to DEPTAR (G-4/D-8) msg W 94280.
- 2. FEC repts will cover only the minimum nec civilian type supplies and equip to prevent disease and unrest and to further military operations in Korea. ECA is repting romts for long range rehabilitation and economic stabilization. Civilian type supplies, such as trucks, furn'd as part of T/O&E of Korean Army units will not rpt not be included in either repts as they are covered by MDAP funds.
- 3. Since CINCFE's resp is limited to providing supplies ref'd to in paragraph 2 above, and preliminary FEC est for Ord items amounts to \$810,000, your ref to total of \$11,626,710 for ECA is not understood. Rqst clarification.



- 1. DA msg WCL 20801 fr COFORD rests info pertaining to FY 51 ests for civ aid (ECA) for Korea with respect to items for which Ord is resp: vehs, spare parts, tools and blasting materials.
- 2. Info rqstd is being included in CINCFE replies to DA msg W 94280 which rqsts similar ests for the entire FEC. In order to avoid possible dup and misunderstanding, COFORD is ref'd to the consolidated FEC repts to be rendered in the near future.
- 3. Inst msg points out that the consolidated repts will cover only the min nec civ type supplies and equip to prevent disease and unrest, and that ECA is rept's remts for long range rehabilitation and economic stabilization. In line with the decision made by G-4 KEAD, inst msg also informs the DA that CINCFE repts will not include civ type supplies red for T/O&E's of Korean army units, since MDAP funds are used for this type of supplies.
- 4. Since CINCFE's resp is limited to providing the supplies ref'd to in para 3 above, and preliminary est of funds red for Ord items amounts to \$810,000, inst msg rosts clarification of the \$11,626,710 for ECA mentioned in WCL 20801.
 - 5. This action has concurrence of G-4 KEA Div (Lt Col Goers).

Z × 19180 Subject is Signal Class IV Operational projects paragraph 26c (1), SR 730-5-1. Message in 2 parts.

Part 1. Due to urgency of requirement for above type project. impracticable to attempt project compilation and forwarding until installation of signal communication facility covered by project concerned. Changing tactical situation with resulting changes in project requirements not conducive to development of firm equipment requirements prior to project implementation, In many cases, projects now classed as "OP" will be redesignated as "DEV" if the signal facility originally installed to support military operations is required for postwer utilization. For above and related considerations, suggest Signal Class IV "OP" projects supporting military operations in Korea be administratively compiled concurrent with installation of specific signal facility covered by such projects, and then forwarded as after-the-fact projects.

Part 2. Signal Class IV "OP" projects within the cognizance of Part 1 above will be reduced to brief radio for submission to Deptar, including major items on Bill of Materials. Upon receipt of approval from DeptAr, necessary requisitioning from ZI sources as required will be initiated. When time permits, project letter to include complete Bill of Materials will be forwarded for record and resupply purposes

Note for Record:

- 1. Portion of SR (AFR) referenced in basic radio to DA stipulated items to be included in the preparation of Signal Class IV projects designed to support military operations (OP Projects).
- 2. Since changing tactical conditions necessitates material changes in the Signal Class IV project designed to support such tactical operations, it is impracticable to attempt to foresee requirements and translate them to a firm project. Also, eventually many of the present Signal Class IV operational projects will be redesignated as developmental projects in those cases where the original Signal facility (switchboards, toll circuits, etc.) is required for postwar Signal communications requirements.
 - 3. In basic radio, we suggest that "OP" Signal Class IV projects supporting military operations in Korea be compiled concurrent with installation of the Signal plant covered by each specific project.
- 4. We further advise DA that info will be forwarded as expeditiously as possible on project requirements supporting military operations in Korea, and that requisitioning for equipment required from ZI will be submitted through normal supply channels upon approval by DA.
- 5. Routed through G-4 for concurrence prior to dispatch. Information copy is furnished.
- 6. Coordinated with and concurred in by Signal Supply Div. Information copy furnished.
