outbreak of hostilities, I offered my services to USAFFE  
and received my pay at USAFFE Hqs. It is possible that project


TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

This is to certify that Mr. Doroteo Flores, Surveyman, has been employed continuously by the USAFFE from or around the middle of December, 1941 to April 10, 1942, at the rate of P2.70 per day. First he was assigned to assist in the improvement of the Lahug Airfield, then as a Foreman in the construction of the Cantabaco-Uling Road and later in the survey on Toledo Sector as Chief of a survey party until the landing of the Japanese on April 10, 1942. His work in Toledo consisted of surveying, plotting and tracing plans requested by the Commanding Officer of the 81st. Infantry USAFFE, Cebu Province.

The undersigned during the period of December 15, 1941 to April 10, 1942, was in charge of all USAFFE constructions or projects in Cebu in his capacity as District Engineer of Cebu and subsequently Major Corp. of Engineers, USAFFE; attached to Staff of Brig. General Chynoweth, U. S. A.
