1. This office has received approximately 49 claims from employees of Cebu Portland Cement Co. claiming service as War Department employees from 8 December 1941 until 10 April 1942.


2. Mr. URBANO G. ORTIZA, foreman at Cebu Portland Cement, states in his affidavit (Incl 1, Tab A):

"I do not know of any agreement between the owner and the USAFFE regarding the factory. So far as I know, the factory is a semi-government. From 8 December 1941 we did not sell any cement to any particular person until I left work. We were shipping all cement to all orders only made by USAFFE."

3. There is some indication that certain employees considered themselves employees of USAFFE because orders from USAFFE were the only ones filled by Cebu Portland. However, there is, in my opinion, no justification for the belief that Cebu Portland worked on anything other than a contract basis with USAFFE.

4. It is recommended that with the information available, a Non J determination be made.

I, URBANO G. ORTIZA, whose address is Tinean, Naga, Cebu, being duly sworn according to law, depose and say that the following information is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief:

1. I was employed as Foreman for the Cebu Portland Cement Co. and I had approximately 20 men under my control. My immediate superior was Col. David. The nature of this work was to take charge of loading of Cement from the factory to as per orders by the USAFFE, I did not hire my men under my control. I was employed as Foreman from 8 December 1941 to 31 January 1942.

3. I was employed as Foreman (Cebu Portland Cement Co.) before commencing work in the above mentioned capacity. I was employed in this capacity after applying to Col. David

5. The officers responsible for paying the employees were Mr. Daniel Labitan

6. We were last paid in full on 5 February 1942 to include the 31 January 1942.

7. This installation ~~was~~ was not molested by the enemy during the period of my employment.

8. The names of USAFFE Officers connected with this project were Col. David (first name unknown)
