

- 1. This office has received approximately 49 claims from employees of Cebu Portland Cement Co. claiming service as War Department employees from 8 December 1941 until 10 April 1942.
- 2. Mr. URBANO G. ORTIZA, foreman at Cebu Portland Cement, states in his affidavit (Incl 1, Tab A):

"I do not know of any agreement between the owner and the USAFFE regarding the factory. So far as I know, the factory is a semigovernment. From 8 December 1941 we did not sell any cement to any particular person until I left work. We were shipping all cement to all orders only made by USAFFE."

- 3. There is some indication that certain employees considered themselves employees of USAFFE because orders from USAFFE were the only ones filled by Cebu Portland. However, there is, in my opinion, no justification for the belief that Cebu Portland worked on anything other than a contract basis with USAFFE.
- 4. It is recommended that with the information available, a Non J determination be made.
