1. The Civilian Section has received approximately 43 claims from persons on Cebu claiming to be USAFFE employees at the Cebu Shipyard and Engineer Works between 8 December 1941 and 10 April 1942.
2. There is no specific information on which to base a determination; however, Lt. Robert Smith, RPD team on Cebu, reported on his return to this headquarters that a Mr. Clelland, Manager of the shipyards, stated that the yards worked on a contract basis with USAFFE.
3. Further, Mr. Clelland declared that he had personally paid wages of his employees up to and including the day work was suspended. Due to various factors, Lt. Smith was unable to get an affidavit to this effect, but it is understood that such an affidavit could be secured if necessary.
4. Claims Service has been contacted relative to this case, and has no information.
5. In view of the foregoing facts, it is recommended that the Cebu Shipyard and Engineering Works be classed as "Non-J", as it had no authorized standing as a USAFFE project.
