

2. The Personnel Office will furnish the following information and route the recommendation to the Headquarters Commandant.
 - a. Subject EM (has) or (has not) been AWOL during the past 12 months. Include list of absences if applicable.
 - b. Subject EM (has) or (has not) been subject to court martial or disciplinary action under the 104th Article of War within the last year. Include list of offences and punishments if applicable.
 - c. Verify entries made by the Branch and note necessary corrections after referal to the pertinent Chief of Branch.
 - d. Check with Control Section and make an appropriate remark reference vacancies in subject grade or grades within the Branch concerned, and within the entire Division.
3. The Headquarters Commandant will note his concurrence, or non-concurrence with reason therefor, and forward the recommendation to the Executive Officer RPD for necessary action.


