- 1. The San Marcelino cantonement Project consisted of the construction of twenty two groups of barracks each group to house about five hundred men.
- 2. The attached affidavit indicates that of the several thousand employees involved in this construction only about fifty were still working on 24 Dec 1941 when all work ceased because of enemy action, the others had been laid off between 16 Nov to 30 Nov 1941 because construction had been completed.
- 3. The fifty men who worked till the 24 Dec 1941 are the only employees eligible for benefits under the Missing Persons Act if they worked continuously for a minimum of 30 days .
- 4. The last official payroll/available 18 16 Dec to 24 Dec 1941 listing thirty two employees.
 - 5. The following is therefore recommended:
- a. In the case of the workers listed on payroll Dec 16-24 that they be accepted as eligible to Missing Persons Act benefits, subject to their furnishing acceptable proof that they worked continuously for more than thirty days.
- b. In the case of the group comprising approximately eighteen men who worked until the 24 Dec 1941 and are not listed on the Dec 16 - 24 payroll, that they be accepted as eligible to Missing Persons Act benefits, subject to their furnishing affidavits from two of the following:

My name is Deogracias C. Garcia, Bambang Maternity Hospital, Manila, P.I. I was Field Supt. of the San Marcelino Cantonement Project. I hereby testify to the following:

The Project consisted of building 22 groups of barracks, each group housing five hundred men. Work began on or about Sept. 9, 1941. Roughly there were about seventy men who began work on the Project. Peak employment was reached about last of Oct. to Nov. 15, 1941 when there were six to seven thousand men employed. Most of these men were laid off from Nov. 16 to Nov. 30, 1941 because the building construction was completed. The employees who remained until the 24th of Dec. 1941, when all work ceased because of enemy action, numbered only about fifty men who were building latrines, working on plumbing, and small details of construction.

San Marcelino cases will be processed as a unit. In a number of these cases a previous determination has been made and the case has been closed as a negative determination. The list of those employees who we have deemed as entitled to benifits under the MPA is to be checked against 201 files and those cases which have been processed will be redetermined. However, inasmuch as the payroll information is incomplete and must be agumented by supporting affidavits, in all cases where name appears on payroll a suspense letter must first be sent to subject. When subject appears at office for interview he will be instructed to obtain affidavits corroborating his claim from two acceptable persons.

The remainder of the San Marcelino cases will be closed as negative determinations. Some 18 or 20 employees who worked to 24 Dec 41 are unidentified. If and when they can furnish proof that they are entitled to MPA benifits a redetermination will be made.

DATA: Work began 9 Sept 41 on 22 groups of barracks. All buildings were completed 22 Nov 41, excepting minor details of construction. Approximately one-fourth of labor was contract work (non WDE) and the remainder of employees were laid off after completion of work, with exception of approx 50 men who worked to 24 Dec 41.


