1 August 1946

I certify that in December 1941 I was on duty as Post Executive Officer at Camp John Hay, Baguio, P.I.

On or about December 15, 1941 I was directed by Colonel John P. Horan, the Post Commander, to Commandeer as many trucks as possible for the purpose of transporting military supplies. I had been handling matters of this nature through Major Bado Dangwa who was the owner of one of the largest transportation companies in the area and was well familiar with the location and ownership of the most of the trucks in the vicinity of Baguio.

Pursuant to my orders to Major Dangwa he secured about twenty-five trucks. He informed me as to the names of the owners of the trucks but I have lost the records and do not recall the names.

I feel certain that if Major Dangwa certifies that he secured ten trucks from Mr. Basilio M. Caguioa that such would be the truth. I have the utmost confidence in Major Dangwa and feel sure he would not certify to a false claim.
