SPECIAL REPORT ON CLAIMS FROM BAY, LAGUNA  
(27TH INFANTRY REGIMENT, 25TH RED LION DIVISION)

Herein claim is one of a group of 33 claims from the municipality of Bay, Laguna, commandeering alleged by del Mar and Juan Natividad for the 27th Infantry Regiment, 25th Red Lion Division. All claims are attested by Pastor Timog, on mimeographed forms.

All claims state receipts were issued but lost. Records of the Unit presented by Timog have no bearing on these claims.

Juan Natividad has alleged to have commandeered many items in other claims not included in this survey. He has presented many false receipts and false statements in support of claims not included in this survey.

Facts and Figures:- 33 claims

Period covered	: 3 Feb 1943 to 17 Mar 1945
Authorized rations	: 101,098
Rice rations alleged commandeered:	178,425
Tobacco alleged commandeered	: 3/4 lbs per day per man

Discussion:

As the herein claims represent just a part of the claims against the 27th Regiment from this Municipality, the extreme excessiveness of the alleged commandeering is at once apparent.

The only evidence of any commandeering lies in the affidavits of several persons whose reputations for reliability are not good. It is also peculiar that every file states receipts were given, but lost.

All files were prepared by the same person or group of persons.

Recommendation:

That these claims be disapproved. That any other claims supported by Juan Natividad or Pastor Timog be disapproved, unless overwhelming proof from some source other than IQOG be presented. That all claims against the 27th Infantry Regiment and the Bay Regiment be disapproved, unless overwhelming proof from some other source be presented.

Note: As other claims against this Unit, or supported by the above-named men are located, this report will be included in those files.

Facts:  
This is one of similar claims for supplies and cash loans allegedly commandeered by the 25th Division, Combat Troops, PQOG, thru one Captain Bienvenido del Mar from February 1943 to March 1945, at Bay Laguna. Date of recognition of the unit involved is 1 December 1943.

Opinion:  
That this claim be disapproved based on the following reasons:

1. Additional supporting papers purporting to support the re-consideration of the claim are short of any additional evidence to substantiate proof of commandeering.
2. Dates of procurement of each particular item are not stated so that it is not possible to determine whether such particular article was commandeered prior or subsequent to the date of recognition of the 25th Division, Combat Troops PQOG, 1 December 1943.
3. Nature of claims which are grouped into 50 are identical. Most claimants, if not all of them, are from the same place. Each claimant alleges to have been issued receipts by the commandeering officer, Captain Bienvenido del Mar, which receipts were either lost or burned. Considering the value of the receipts, it is rather unusual that not one of these 50 claimants was ever able to save any of such receipts. This gives rise to a reasonable doubt as to the truth of the issuance of receipts.
4. There are filed in this office by Bienvenido del Mar and Pastor Timog receipts purporting to support subject claims. Careful examination reveals that the owners of the items in said receipts are not identical to the claimants. Subject receipts are therefore not of any value in the equitable investigation of subject claims.
5. It appears that the requisitioning Officer, Captain Bienvenido del Mar, was recognized and processed as Sgt. Infantry, P. A. as of 1 January 1945.


