GERARD HARRINGTON, JR., Claims Investigator, at present assigned to Team #5, states:

More than a year's assignment to Claims Service in Mindanao, four months of which was spent in the Province of Davao, has afforded me a knowledge of the intelligence work and the policies pursued in this work by the guerrilla forces in Mindanao.

One of the prime missions of guerrilla forces all over the Philippines was the collecting of data on enemy movements, numbers, supplies and plans, to be reported to General MacArthur's Headquarters. To do this necessitated personnel in numbers which could not nearly be filled by military personnel, therefore thousands of civilians were used at one time or another under official appointment with agreed monthly compensation; on a "piece-work" basis, on a voluntary basis, or with no understanding at all other than the ambiguous "they would be taken care of when the Americans returned."

In Mindanao, several divisions established concrete policies and issued to civilian operatives appointments which specifically stated thereon the compensation they were to receive -- true of the 110th Division. The 107th Division and intelligence units within it, however, had no policy. Appointments, seldom issued, made no mention of salary for the units reserved the right to verbally promise the individual any salary which would satisfy him and effect completion of a mission. Anything was granted; the more the dangers, the more the promises. FERNANDO R. GABALES, AG/S, Assistant G-2 of the 107th Division states:

"That the majority of the civilian operators were hired in the beginning of 1944 and rendered services throughout the year 1944 until on or about 5 May 1945, after the arrival of the American Forces in Davao, when all civilian operatives working under me were informed that their services were no longer needed, that they were relieved of duty as of that date, and were advised to return to their homes;....."

"that no definite rate of pay or salary for civilian operatives was ever established although promises (often rash for morale purposes) ranged between fifty to more than one hundred pesos a month. What these men actually did receive, I do not know, for I am not aware of any operatives having been paid for their services. I was unable to pay my men and I was informed that they were refused by the Division Finance Officer because of the lack of funds;

"That while civilian operatives did not receive a salary, they did receive funds for an expense account..... No definite amount for this account was ever established. It is my understanding that these funds were completely outside of an in addition to any salary they were to receive....."

Much the same is true of the Special Intelligence Detachment often known as the Sternberg Detachment, possessing about eighty (80) armed men and countless civilian operatives, whose sole duty was intelligence work.

Other divisions in Mindanao existing under circumstances similar to those of the 107th Division and having a definite policy intelligence operators, generally agreed on a monthly compensation of forty (P40.00) pesos. This salary is just and reasonable.

It is the belief of this Investigator that the absence in the 107th Division of an established and sensible policy on the treatment of civilian intelligence agents should not prevent such agents from receiving compensation for identical services rendered under identical circumstance for which payment was established in neighboring units whose claims have been already been honored by this office.

Therefore, recommend that claim be allowed during the period from recognition date of unit or date of commencement of employment, whichever is later, to 5 May 1945, the date of assumption of control in Davao by the American liberation forces, in the amount of P40.00 per month.





Fertig), presently residing in Cagayan, Misamis Oriental, after having been duly sworn to in accordance with law, hereby depose and say:

That the 109th Regimental Hospital at Bolisong, El Salvador, Free Cagayan, Mis.Or. was under construction during the period from November 1, 1942 to April 30, 1943.

That one foreman, Regino Clapano was contracted to work at P3.50 a day excluding Sundays and that he worked continuously during the above period stated.

That the laborers employed in the construction were divided into six groups each managed by a capataz.

That each group was assigned to work only one day each week during the above stated period of construction.

That each capataz and laborer was contracted to work at the rate of P3.00 and P2.00 respectively a day of service.

That the group headed by Capataz Benito Macahilus was assigned to work every Monday of the week during the period from November 1, 1942 to April 30, 1943.


That none of those who worked in this Army project was paid for services rendered because there was no available fund appropriated for the purpose at that time.

MANDATORY ORDER-

SUBJECT- Re Fish Supply for the Army
TO - All Fishermen

1. All fishermen are required to sell one half or 50% of their catch to the local Army Procurement Officers.

2. There will of course be some exceptions to this order pending upon the availability of the Procurement Officers and inconvenience of delivery. In other words, it is not expected that fishermen living considerable distance from a unit command should deliver their fish to the Army whenever too convenient, but it is expected that the Army Procurement Officers will go after their part of the catch.

3. Whenever convenient, local fishermen will deliver 50% of their catches to the local Procurement Officers. In other words, if a fisherman lives in vicinity of a unit he can without any inconvenience take one half of his catch to the Army.

4. The local Procurement Officers must make arrangements with local fishermen to accept their part of the catch at a designated time. If, for any reason, the Procurement Officer does not show up within an hour of the designated time, then the fishermen are permitted to take the entire catch and dispose of it as they wish.

5. In order to enforce this order, Mr. Gregorio Pelaez, Jr. will be in charge of fish procurement for the Division and he will establish a Warden Service. It is the duty of the Warden to inspect the fishermen from time to time to see whether they are holding out on the Army. Any civilian who is caught hoarding their supply or holding out more than 50% of it will be severely dealt with.

6. The fishermen will be paid by the local Finance Officers upon presentation of signed receipts by the local Procurement Officer.

7. Owners of fish corrals and nets will make a monthly report to the local Unit Commander covering the amount of fish caught during the month and the amount sold to the Army.

TO: Commanding General, United States Army Forces, Western Pacific, APO 707

1. The answers to the several questions propounded by the memorandum of the Chief of Claims, dated 17 July 1945, are as follows:

a. Yes. The United States Army will assume the responsibility for paying certain claims arising out of activities of guerrilla forces in the Philippines. That responsibility will be limited to claims for the value of goods or services essential for carrying on operations against the enemy.

b. Yes. No payments will be made on claims arising out of activities of other than recognized guerrilla forces.

c. The effective date of such claims will be the same as those for the pay of the personnel of the guerrilla forces, i.e., the effective date of recognition, not the date upon which the decision to recognize is made.

d. Such claims will be paid from the appropriation, "Expenses Army of the Philippines".

e. Payment will be made only on claims where there was a clear understanding at the time the supplies and equipment or services were purchased or contracted for that payment would eventually be made. There must have been a clear intention on the part of the guerrilla commander and of the vendor or employee that an obligation was being created. It must be definitely shown that the provision of such supplies, equipment or services was not intended as a patriotic donation to the common cause against the enemy. It must also be definitely shown that the supplies, equipment or services were essential for the operation of the guerrilla forces.

2. It is desired that immediate steps be taken to commence the processing of all such pending claims.

3. The identity of those guerrilla forces which have been recognized by this headquarters and the effective date of such recognition will be advised from time to time in letters from this headquarters.



That I was the Finance Officer of the defunct 109th Division, 10th Military District, USFIP, since said Division was activated in March 1943;


That ⁱⁿ such designation I paid cash advances to Officers ^{and men} of the said Division, settled and paid salaries to all civilian employees;

I certify that I was a 1st Lt., AGS, and the senior Assistant Adjutant General of the 10th Military District, USFIP, which was composed of all the guerrilla units on Mindanao. Likewise, I was the senior Assistant Adjutant General of the 6th Infantry Division, Philippine Army, which succeeded the 10th MD, USFIP, after the latter was reorganized into a regular Philippine Army Division during August 1945. I held the same rank and my army serial number was O-24415. On various occasions, I was the Acting Adjutant General of the aforesaid units, for which reason, I assume knowledge, as much as I can remember, of the various policies embodied in circulars, memoranda, etc., most of which I personally issued and disseminated to subordinate units. That among the guerrilla divisions under the 10th MD, USFIP, were the 109th and the 110th Divisions.

That I have been shown numerous claims concerning services allegedly rendered by civilians to the 109th and the 110th Divisions on various capacities as laborers, cargadores, farm-project employees, etc.; and that I strongly suspect malicious attempts to perpetrate fraud through collusion by claimants and former officers whose sworn statements now appear as supporting papers of these claims.

That insofar as the claims for services rendered by claimants to the 109th Division for hauling arms, ammunitions, supplies, etc., involving a total of twenty (20) days, at ₱5.00 per day, with a carabao, are concerned, I believe that there must have been some civilians who actually hauled those supplies which were left by a submarine at Alubijid, Misamis Oriental, in November 1944; but I opine that they could not have been so numerous as claims filed now show. Likewise, I do not believe that there was an understanding between any procurement authority and the supposed civilian laborers that they would be paid for their services in hauling said supplies. When the submarine landed, patriotism was more expressed - and people offered

the 109th Division Commander recommended the appointment of several civilian employees to the Headquarters 10th MD, and I further remember that orders were issued by the 10th MD confirming the appointments made by the 109th Division Commander. However, I do not remember that the 109th Division Commander recommended the appointment of the various civilians who now appear as claimants for services rendered. For clarification, I wish to remind that all correspondence to and from subordinate units usually passed through my office in my capacity as senior Assistant Adjutant General.

That I have noticed in the aforementioned claims that same are supported by mimeographed affidavits issued by four former officers of the 109th Division. I personally know these officers and I have known them to be trustworthy. However, I do not now vouch for the truth of their statements, in view of the fact that I personally know that these claims were prepared wholesale a short time before the recent election, and I know these four officers to be politicians or quasi-politicians. Major Laplap was an interviewer in the Philippine Veterans' Board Unit at Cagayan, and Major Noble was his Chief. Under the Veterans' Board Office was the Headquarters of the Liberal Party. Major Cruz was the Governor, who was a candidate for re-election. Lieutenant Pacana was a candidate for the position of Mayor of Cagayan. As such, I ~~presume~~ ^{presume I} that these former officers did not loathe making false statements.

That regarding another set of numerous claims which pertain to services allegedly rendered, either as head-leader or as a laborer on farm projects under the 110th Regiment, 110th Division, 10th MD, USFIP, I personally know that these people were not promised any remuneration for their services. Prior to my above-mentioned designations, I was in charge of a Regimental farm project which, I believe, functioned

under the same policy that services rendered would not be paid for, as the other farm projects under the 110th Division. This policy was to assign civilians to serve on assigned days as workers on farm projects without pay. Their services were considered voluntary to the cause against the enemy. I believe no man served continuously between two dates, in view of the fact that men were assigned a day or two in a week to work, ~~not~~² not all the days in a week continuously throughout the given inclusive dates as stated now in their claims. ~~the~~² In this connection, I wish to quote a portion of a personal letter sent to me by a man whom I consider honest, respectable, and trustworthy: "How about the project in Looc, Salay, Mis. Oc. we have been talking here? I was told by one of the claimants that they made a payroll of 55 persons for 27 months which was made a month ago. That payroll was sent in your office as one of the requisites of their claims, as if they have really made that payroll 27 months ago. (This is confidential.) I'm telling you this because I have told you this already that the lot the 55 persons cultivated is less than 3 Ha. near my evacuating place. I don't mean to hurt anybody but I just don't like the idea of money making more than those who fought and died in Bataan and in Mindanao. Besides, it is becoming a source of income now of the fellow we are talking about in Looc. The poor innocent people in the mountains listed as claimant. They are only promised one half of the amount. If ever they are paid, only one-half goes to the claimants.

"One funny thing is that some of the claimants listed are mountaineers who do not know where to go and to get the money without him because they have not even gone to Cagayan.

"Mr. Cayton, I'm telling you this brotherly. I hope, not a word is extended to others. I hope to meet you soon in Manila this coming June."

It is deduced from the afore-quoted, unsolicited statement that many claimants who were formerly workers on farm projects are being

encouraged to file fraudulent claims by some persons with the promise that half of any amount approved by Claims Service would go to them.

That due to the foregoing information which have been based on my personal knowledge and belief, unless the good claims can be screened from the fraudulent, disallowance of all these claims is in order.

Pursuant to paragraph 3, c. Memorandum No. 6, dated 17 June 1947, Chief of Claims Service, PHILRYCOM, I have the honor to request the payment for the individual services of these civilian claimants.


Each claim is supported by procurement authority, proof of services including dates of service, proof of non-payment, and CIS Form 619. The procurement authority is in the form of copies of affidavits executed by Col. James R. Grinstead, Inf, AUS, the Division Commander of the 109th (Guerr) Division, the original of which is attached.

Attached also herewith is an alphabetical list of the 420 civilian claimants.

More claims will be submitted from time to time because some civilian claimants have not as yet completed their papers.

As will be noted in the procurement authority, there were 10 projects authorized and as soon as I receive authority from the Chairman, Philippine Veterans Board, Manila, to accept further claims of civilians, I shall resume compilation of claims for submission to that office.

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

AFFIDAVIT ON THE USE OF CIVILIAN LABOR AND PACK
ANIMALS BY THE 109TH (GUERRILLA) DIVISION

I, JAMES R. GRINSTEAD, of legal age, single, and residing at Malabang, Ienao, after being duly sworn to in accordance with law, hereby depose and say:

That I was a Colonel, Infantry, AUS;

That I was the Division Commander of the 109th (Guerr) Division, 10th Military District, PA, from October 15, 1943 to July, 1945;

~~That in my capacity as Division Commander of said Guerrilla Division,~~ and by authority from my superior officer, Colonel WENDELL W. FERTIG, CE, AUS, I have ordered and authorized the construction, operation and maintenance of the following installations within my divisional area:

1. Division Hospital at Talakag, Bukidnon, and Regimental Hospital, 109th Inf Regt., at Hinigdaan, Free Cagayan, Misamis Oriental;
2. C-47 Landing Strip at Talakag, Bukidnon, and L-5 Airstrips at Lourdez, Misamis Oriental, and Taglimao, Lumbia, Misamis Oriental;
3. Back trails for army and civilian use from Tignapoloan, Lumbia, Misamis Oriental, to Taparak, Lourdez, Misamis Oriental;
4. Road from Gitagum, Alubijid, Misamis Oriental, to Lourdez, Misamis Oriental;
5. Repair of Artesian Well at Gitagum, Misamis Oriental, for use of the 3rd Bn., 109th Inf. Regiment;
6. Maintenance and operation of the Ferryboat at Uguiaban, Talakag, Bukidnon;

That in the construction, maintenance and operation of the installations mentioned above, I authorized the Division Quartermaster, 109th (Guerr) Division, and the CO, 109th Inf., Regiment, to employ civilian labor;

That in the early part of November, 1944, an American submarine landed, by pre-arrangement, at Alubijid, Misamis Oriental, within the area of the 109th (Guerr) Division, and unloaded arms, ammunition, fuel, rations, radio equipment and some Filipino U. S. Army soldiers, all of which were American aid to the Mindanao guerrillas;

That I authorized the Division Quartermaster, Major IGNACIO S. CRUZ, to take delivery of all cargoes unloaded by said submarine, and I authorized the CO, 109th Inf Regiment, Major FIDENCIO M. LAPLAP, to use all able-bodied civilians and their pack animals in his area to haul said supplies and equipment from Alubijid, Misamis Oriental, to Talakag, Bukidnon;

That upon the orders of my superior officer, Col. WENDELL W. FERTIG, that part of the supplies, radio equipment, including food supplies, delivered by the submarine be transported to his headquarters at Upper Agusan River, Agusan Province, I authorized my Division Quartermaster to employ civilian cargadores to transport these part of the supplies, radio equipment, including food supplies, for use by Col. W. W. FERTIG and his Staff, from Talakag, Bukidnon, to Upper Agusan River, Agusan Province, passing through enemy territory of Bukidnon, at Mailag, thence straight to Upper Agusan River, Agusan Province;

That to the best of my knowledge and belief, the civilian laborers and cargadores and pack animals used by the 109th (Guerr) Division, in the different projects mentioned above, have not all been paid due to lack of funds.
