I, Macario Molina, of legal age, married and a resident of the barrio Callang, municipality of Gamu, province of Isabela, Philippines, after having been duly sworn to according to law, depose and state;

1. That I know personally Mr. Serapion B. Domingo, he, being my neighbor in the barrio of Callang, Gamu, Isabela, where we now actually reside and from the time I have known him, he was already a land owner, a notary public and a business man engaged in the buy and sell of palay; and he also a camarin which he partly used as store and partly as deposit for palay;

2. That I know that Mr. Serapion B. Domingo, at the outbreak of the war, 1941, he had plenty of palay which he acquired from his land and from his business;

3. That I am a Rice mill owner and am operating same in our barrio from 1936 up to the present time. My rice mill was put under the control of the Army sometimes in the months of February to May, 1942, by Major Joaquin Dunuan, formerly a lieutenant and Supply Officer of the 14th Inf., PA, federalized in 14 July 42, stationed at Jones, Isabela;

4. That from the time my rice mill was put under military control, my rice mill was operating most of the time milling palay which were brought by the different officers of the Army; and at times also milling the palay of the civilians. However, I know that Lt Joaquin Dunuan utilized my mill most often for milling the palay which he commandeered in large scale for the use of the Army;

5. That I know that one among the persons from whom the different officers, like Lts Fabien Soberano, Emilio Carineo etc, but specially Lt Joaquin Dunuan, procured palay in big quantity is Mr. Serapion B. Domingo and this fact I know, because Mr. Domingo is my neighbor aside from most of his palay were milled in rice mill and also the different officers usually told me whose palay I was milling.
