That during the guerilla period I was the CO of "D" Co. 1st Bn. 64th ICT. 6th MD, which was stationed at the mountain of

Pilar, Capiz from May 1944 to March 1945.

That on June 1944, I detailed Pvt. Herminigildo Borja, my trusted procuremen agent, to procure fish in the Fish Pond of Mr. Delfin Arbiz at Sav Ferhando, Pilar, Capiz up to Feb. 1945.

That said Mr. Delfin Arbiz made arrangement with me to instruct Pvt. Herminigildo Borja not to sign receipt for the daily withdrawal but to report to my Headquarter such record. The reason of Mr. Arbiz was the fact that his encargado might lost the receipt.

That on Feb. 25, 1945, Mr. Delfin Arbiz appeared in my Headquarter asking me for a receipt of the fish my unit got from him from June 1944 to Feb. 1945 in as much as the Americans were

expected in Panay.

That I personally checked on the records of withdrawal in our office and ordered a preparation of the receipt of TWO THOU-SAND FOUR HUNDRED THIRTY TWO (2,432) kilos of fish stating therein the different dates of withdrawal with the corresponding number of kilos withdrawn and attatched my signature thereto.

That I have examined the receipt dated Feb. 25, 1945 signed by Herminigildo Borja and myself and identified that this was the same receipt we issued Mr. Delfin Arbiz on Feb. 25, 1945 with the

signature of Herminigildo Borja and myself genuine.
