That the owner Jose Ma. Becares was absent from his farm at the time of commanding and no receipt was issued to him until Dec. 12, 1945 at which time he returned home to his farm and made representation to the Army authorities, either for payment of the palay taken from him or for the proper receipt;

That no payment was given him, but a receipt dated Dec. 12, 1945, for the quantity of 123 cavanese of palay was issued to him by Sgt. Apolonio Vega.

That I am of age, married and a resident of Calasi, Antique.

That I am a discharged officer of the Philippine Army, having the rank of a Captain, and my last station was the "Sixth Provisional Station Complement, P.A. at Camp Tiring, Cabaatuan, Iloilo.

That in April, 1942, I was a Captain of the Philippine Army (USAPFA) assigned as Procurement Officer of the 61st Division, P.A. (Division GM); and I remember that as Procurement Officer, I bought from Mrs. Mercedes Y. Salvani of Patnongon, Antique, ONE HUNDRED (100) cavanes of palay at her farm in the municipality of Patnongon, Antique. The said one hundred cavanes of palay were actually delivered to the ARMY and used by the Army. I issued a receipt in favor of Mrs. Mercedes Y. Salvani for said 100 cavanes of palay at the agreed price of THREE PESOS (P3.00) per cavan. To the best of my knowledge and belief, said 100 cavanes of palay was not paid before the landing of the Japanese Imperial Forces in Antique on April 17, 1942.
