- (a) December 20, 1943 - 26 cavanas of palay (double measure) at the rate of P20.00 per cavan.
- (b) January 24, 1944 - 20 cavañas and 21 gantas of palay (double measure) at the rate of P20.00 per cavan.
- (c) May 24, 1944 - 6 cavañas of palay at the rate of P20.00 per cavan.

That the undersigned as unit commander during those days have had an authority from our high command to demand foodstuffs for the consumption of our men in the field, of which a copy of an authority, nor the date thereof I could remember.

That I further certify that the foodstuffs as above stated, are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.

Army _____ \$0.22 per bulto of palay containing more or less 24 gantas (56 kilos) clean rice.

That to the best of my knowledge, information and belief, the charge of milling palay set forth above were the prevailing local charge for milling palay before the outbreak of the war in 1941.

That on the said date, September 12, 1942, I went along with Sgt. Pedro Ladrón to the barrio Danos of the said Municipality upon order of Lt. Inocencio Fallarría commander uno automobile Ford V-8, model 1933, with plate No. 21-567, 1942 bearing motor No. 18 HF 244412, property of Mrs. Inocencia Jason de Sorromec, which automobile was then under the custody and possession of uno Rufino Barranco of the said barrio.

That on the aforesaid date, September 12, 1942, the above mentioned automobile was delivered to Sgt. Pedro Ledesma, who, in my presence and in the presence of Rufino Barranco, signed and delivered to the said Rufino Barranco, proper memorandum receipt of the said automobile in the name of Mrs. Inocencia Jason de Barranco.

After the signing of the receipt and its delivery at Rufino Moreno, I drove the said automobile to the Headquarters of Lt. Inocencio Mallari who received the said automobile from me.

Since that date, Lt. Inocencio Pallarin was continuously using the said automobile in his operations and activities as officer of the resistance movement having me for his driver or chauffeur.

That the said automobile was never returned to its owner, Mrs. Inezie Jason do Torremano.




That although the aforementioned receipt bears no date which must have inadvertently left out when it was made out, still I can remember that it was during the month of October 1944 that the palay was procured;



In reply to your letter of the 18th instant in which I was made to confirm the receipt issued in favor of Mr Clemente Robles of Jamindan, Capiz for one shotgun, gauge 12, Ser No 340449, covered by license No 112611, I have the honor to inform that office that before the invasion of Panay Island in 1942, instructions has been received from the Chief of Constabulary, Manila authorizing all Provincial Inspectors of the defunct Philippine Constabulary to commandeer all shotguns and rifles regardless of its calibers in their respective provinces.

That inasmuch as I was in-charge of the Firearms & Explosives Sections in the Office of the Provincial Inspector, PC in the province of Capiz, I was then one of those authorized by our then Provincial Inspector, Lt-Col A DE GUZMAN to sign commandeering receipts for him.

In this connection, I then confirmed the receipt in question and all other receipts presented to that office in the future which bears my signature issued to firearm holders or claimants coming from the province of Capiz. This is done so, in order to avoid unnecessary delay on your part in the processing of claims of these firearm holders coming from Capiz province.

That as Commanding Officer it was my responsibility to provide for the subsistence of the men under me, and I was duly authorized to procure foodstuffs and other essential supplies; that I had delegated some of my men to procure foodstuffs during such time when the QM Units were not accessible;

That in January 1945, we were stationed at Tiring, Cabatuan, and foodstuff then being very scarce in that locality, I requisitioned palay from Oton, Iloilo, thru the Municipal Mayor Miguel Suarez;

That I remember that five (5) cavans of palay were commandeered from Mr Roque Gamboa of Oton by the said Municipal Mayor Miguel Suarez and delivered to me at Tiring, Cabatuan; that no receipt was immediately issued by me due to combat activity, and sometime later on, Mr Roque Gamboa was able to present to me for my OKAY the receipt of the Municipal Mayor Miguel Suarez which was dated 10 May 45 -- the day when he made out the receipt; that I signed the said receipt signifying my approval of same as to the delivery to my unit of the five cavans;
