That I joined the guerrilla organization since its initiation up to the liberation in 1946.

That on September 12, 1942, I was assigned as driver in the Motor Pool at Janinay, Iloilo, Philippines.

That on the said date, September 12, 1942, I went along with Sgt. Pedro Lederos to the Service Garage of the said Municipality upon order of Lt. Inocencio Fallaric to commandeer one automobile Ford V-8, Model 1933, with photo No. 21-267, 1942 bearing motor No. 19 HF 244412, property of Mrs. Inocencio Jason de Borromeo, which automobile was then under the custody and possession of one Rufino Barranto of the said barrio.

That on the aforesaid date, September 12, 1942, the above mentioned automobile was delivered to Sgt. Pedro Lederos, who, in my presence and in the presence of Rufino Barranto, signed and delivered to the said Rufino Barranto, proper commanding receipt of the said automobile in the name of Mrs. Inocencio Jason de Borromeo.

After the signing of the receipt and its delivery at Rufino Barranto, I drove the said automobile to the headquarters of Lt. Inocencio Fallaric who received the said automobile from me.

Since that date, Lt. Inocencio Fallaric was continually using the said automobile in his operations and activities as officer of the resistance movement having me for his driver or chauffeur.

That the said automobile was never returned to its owner, Mrs. Inocencio Jason de Borromeo.

That although the aforementioned receipt bears no date which must have inadvertently left out when it was made out, still I ~~am~~ can remember that it was during the month of October 1944 that the palay was procured;

That the actual and lawful owner of the palay was Zacarias Andaya and not Lt Eulogio Andaya who was at the time under Capt Bolido, Depot QM attached to the 66th Inf Regt.; that the receipt was only made out in that way as all requisitions of foodstuff must pass thru the Depot QM's but I hereon reiterate that the true and lawful owner of the palay is ZACARIAS ANDAYA.

That I joined the guerilla organization from its organization until the same was disorganized.

That on September 12, 1942 I was under Lt. Inocencio Palleria of the Motor Pool at Janiway, Iloilo together with Sgt. Pedro Lederos.

That on that day, September 12, 1942, ^{Fe} Sgt. Pedro Lederos and private Marcos Subong delivered to Lt. Inocencio Palleria at the Motor Pool of Janiway, Iloilo, one Automobile Ford V-8, model 1933, bearing plate No. 21-567 for the year 1942.

That upon my inquiry, Sgt. Pedro Lederos and Marcos Subong told me that the said automobile was the property of Mrs. Inocencio Jason de Berronco but was taken by them from Rufino Berronco who lived at Barrio Bance, Janiway under the order of Lt. Inocencio Palleria.

That thereafter, Lt. Inocencio Palleria was the one making use of the said automobile in his activities as officer of the resistance movement.

That I was inducted into the 61st Div USAFFE on 1 Sept 41 as a 3rd Lt Inf, and after the outbreak of the war, I was assigned as JO, Hq & Hq Battery, stationed in Cagayan, Mindanao; I did not surrender to the Japanese forces and joined the guerrilla on 1 Sept 41 as a 3rd Lt; I organized the San Miguel Unit which was later fused with Col. Peralta's forces; I was promoted to 2nd Lt on 16 Oct 42, to 1st Lt on 15 May 43 and to Capt on 16 Mar 45; that my different assignments were: JO Mobile Corps, JO "C" Co., JO "A" Co., Ex-O "A" Co., Bn S-3, 1st Bn, 63rd Inf, 6th MD; Ex-O "A" Co., CO "D" Co., 61st Inf Regt., 6th MD;

That as Commanding Officer it was my responsibility to provide for the subsistence of the men under me, and I was duly authorized to procure foodstuffs and other essential supplies; that I had delegated some of my men to procure foodstuffs during such time when the QM Units were not accessible;

That in January 1945, we were stationed at Tiring, Cabatuan, and foodstuff then being very scarce in that locality, I requisitioned palay from Oton, Iloilo, thru the Municipal Mayor Miguel Suarez;

That I remember that five (5) cavans of palay were commandeered from Mr Roque Gamboa of Oton by the said Municipal Mayor Miguel Suarez and delivered to me at Tiring, Cabatuan; that no receipt was immediately issued by me due to combat activity, and sometime later on, Mr Roque Gamboa was able to present to me for my OKAY the receipt of the Municipal Mayor Miguel Suarez which was dated 10 May 45 -- the day when he made out the receipt; that I signed the said receipt signifying my approval of same as to the delivery to my unit of the five cavans;

That I have examined receipt dated 10 May 45 signed by both Miguel Suarez and myself for 5 cavans of palay which has been filed by Roque Gamboa with Claims Service, Iloilo;

That I recognize and identify the signatures thereon to be the true and authentic signatures of Miguel Suarez and myself; that I hereon reiterate that while the receipt is dated 10 May 45 which may have been the date when Miguel Suarez issued it, the delivery of the palay was made to me in January 45 at Tiring, Cabatuan;

That in the execution of my various duties, I came to know many officers and enlisted men, had seen them sign on Army papers and hence can identify their signatures;






