That our duties then were to transport war materials, supplies ans soldiers of the U.S. Army from one part to another.

That our Immediate C.O of the U.S Army was Col. Dalton.
That on Jan.1, 1942 while in the performance of our duties
enemy planes threw hand grenades and machine gum the boat at Zamboang wharf, which as aresult the ship was totally damage.

Dalton, after that we were ordered to standby until finally the enemy landed in Zamboanga.

Thereafter we tried to report to our unit, but we could not find any, so we went to the mountains and did not surrender to the Enemy.
