2. Extensive wound left thigh on inner aspect at junction lower and middle third. Much damage to muscle but no bone damage.

Sutures placed after cleansing, but not tied.

3. Multiple smaller wounds left leg — one entering just below knee but apparently not involving joint. Also one is thru foot thru near ankle but not involving bone.

4. Thumb and thenar wound at leg without bone injury.
