Dear Mr. Drumright:

I am referring to your letter of 16 June 1954, file reference 711.11-31/6-254, addressed to the Secretary of the Army in behalf of the Philippine Embassy, requesting information regarding the Volunteer Guard Organization of the Philippine Republic.

The records show that the Volunteer Guard Organization, Cebu Area Command, was not favorably considered for recognition as a guerrilla organization. Accordingly, individuals claiming service with this organization are not entitled to benefits under laws administered by the United States Government.

The Guerrilla Recognition Program terminated with the deactivation of the Guerrilla Affairs Division on 30 June 1948. Subsequent to that date, the authority to extend recognition to individuals and organizations claiming guerrilla service ceased to exist.

Dear Mr. Secretary:

There is transmitted a copy of the text of a note from the Philippine Embassy and copies of its enclosures, which pertain to the alleged guerrilla activities of the "Volunteer Guard Organization, Cebu Area Command," during the occupation of the Philippines by the Japanese.

In order that the Department of State may decide what further action should be taken in this matter, it would be appreciated if the Department of the Army would advise whether the unit in question was recognized as a bona fide guerrilla unit and paid as such (see third paragraph, page 2 of the attached resolution), or, if not, whether there is any record of it.

It would also be appreciated if the Department of the Army would confirm this Department's understanding that, in the event that the unit was not recognized, it is now too late for reconsideration of any application for recognition which it may have made.

Will the Department of the Army please return the enclosures to this letter when they have served their purpose.

PETITION OF THE VOLUNTEER GUARD ORGANIZATION
OF THE CEBU AREA COMMAND IN THE PHILIPPINES
IN THE SECOND WORLD WAR

WHEREAS,

The members of the Volunteer Guard Organization who were abandoned by the previous Administration, have come to agree at their meeting held at quadrangle of the University of the Visayas, on November 22, 1953, at 2:30 P.M. to request the New Incoming Administration to reconsider their Petition for the Recognition of the Volunteer Guard Organization in accordance with Act No. 897 - GUERRILLA RECOGNITION;

WHEREAS,

The Volunteer Guards had performed meritorious and patriotic services during the Second World War by the order of the Superior Officers of the Philippine Army, USAFFE and USFIP throughout the whole Philippines;

WHEREAS,

The Volunteer Guards had contributed food to the Philippine Army, besides, securing another supplies from the people of the communities for the supports of the Philippine Army, before the arrival of the American Forces;

WHEREAS,

The work or missions of the Volunteer Guards were more dangerous and sacrificial than the regular army, carrying their provisions to different destinations and messages from one point to another, without complaints and protection. Many were actually killed by the Japs during the performance of their missions without receiving any compensations or rewards for their poor widows and children. The Volunteer Guards were doing underground works or missions. Oftentimes, they were sent by the Army Officers to penetrate the Japs occupied area, to observe the strength of the enemies and to locate their outposts preparatory for the attack and to gather and steal the mit to do so. They were given assignments to gather the wounded and deads from the battle fronts. They also saved the lives of the American Aviators during the bombing of the Japanese boats, headquarters and depots, specially in Cebu, when the American airplanes were hit by the Japanese anti-aircrafts and pongpong guns. Had it not been for the brave Volunteer Guards, these American Aviators were either captured or killed by the Japs. Thank God, for courageous and daring work of the Volunteer Guards all these American Aviators were saved, cared for and sent to the submarine boats who were looking for these lost American Aviators;

WHEREAS,

Upon the arrival of the American Liberation Forces, the Volunteer Guards were directly absorbed by the Liberation Forces, acting as their guides, runners, cargadores of the supplies to the places where the cars could not reach, acting as snipers to hunt the Japanese stragglers in their hiding places and report to the American soldiers; that eased the work of the American soldiers in mopping out the remnants of the Japanese Imperial Forces;

WHEREAS,

The Resistance Movement of the Guerrilla Organization against the forces of the Japanese Imperial Forces, was one of the Resistance Movements, that drew the attention of the whole World. This Resistance Movement of the Filipinos which has contributed much to the prestige of the Filipino people in the international relationship, specially in UNO and commands the respect of the world, is due to the Organization of the Volunteer Guards in the Second World War. The volunteer Guards took active parts in driving out the invaders, not minding that they are the ones to be defended and not to defend in the strictest meaning of the word, War;

WHEREAS,

The Volunteer Guards have their own money allotted by the American Government for their special services in the Second World War in helping the American Liberation Forces, for making their operation an easy task, thus making the termination of the operation earlier than usual. This money had already been set aside by the American Government, but was held by the OUTGOING ADMINISTRATION. Thanks for the Incoming Administration the BOYS of the Volunteer Guard Organization can expect to receive the fruits of their services, which are their own earned thru their sacrifices; and

WHEREAS,

In the consideration of the conference made between Col. James M. Cushing, the recognized Commander of the Guerrilla Forces and the Commissioner Proceso S. R. Aragon of the Volunteer Guard Organization, who at that time depended on the splendid works and activities of the Volunteer Guards in Cebu Area Command, as demonstrated during the warfare and during the Liberation of the Philippines by the American Forces who commented and praised the bravery of the BOYS and the American Liberation Forces suggested that the said Volunteer Guard Organization be recognized as a part of the Regular Army Forces, USAFFE and this conference was reaffirmed by the President-elect during his strenuous election campaign in Cebu, when Major Proceso S.R. Aragon of the Volunteer Guards Organization talked to him about the situation of the Volunteer Guards. The President-elect was interested to help the Volunteer Guards, when he is given the CHANCE TO improve their miserable lots from which he comes from; THEREFORE, be it,

RESOLVED.

That the low status or condition of the Volunteer Guard Organization, as being abandoned or forgotten, be raised and levelled with that of the recognized army as their sacrifices and sufferings are greater than any organization, besides, the regular army before the Altar of Our Mother Land, the Republic of the Philippines.

RESOLVED.

That the prayer of the Volunteer Guards in this Petition be given due merits and consideration for the Recognition of the VOLUNTEER GUARDS ORGANIZATION as embodied in Act No. 897 for the Guerrilla Back Pay, and for further information the said organization has complete records in accordance with the Policy of the Philippine Army and they also request that their prayer be given immediate attention and approval in the Year of Our Lord, the Divine Providence in Heaven, with great appreciation to Social Justice.

RESOLVED.

That this Petition be sent to the President of the Philippine Republic for his consideration and approval for he had been a Guerrilla Leader in the Second World War, serving the cause of Democracy; Therefore, be it further,

RESOLVED.

That copies of this Petition be sent to the President of the Philippines Senate; to the Speaker of the House of Representatives; the Secretary of National Defense and to each and every member of both Houses of Congress for their guidance in enacting a law for the benefit of the forgotten Organization.

Dear Mr. Ignacio:

I am referring to the roster of alleged former members of Fil-American Irregular Troops, Talbae Regiment, formerly Antipolo Unit, which was submitted in connection with a claim for pay and allowances based on alleged guerrilla service rendered during World War II.

The first requirement for crediting an individual with recognized guerrilla service is that his name appear on an approved reconstructed roster of an organization. Records on file in this office do not indicate that the above mentioned guerrilla unit is an approved guerrilla organization.

The extension of official recognition to individuals or organizations claiming guerrilla status was a function of the Guerrilla Affairs Division. Under this program, a period of more than three years was allowed for guerrilla units and members of such units to request official recognition. When that organization was deactivated on 30 June 1948, the guerrilla recognition program terminated and the authority to alter, amend or modify previous decisions made, ceased to exist.

In view of the foregoing, I know of no other action that may be taken.





Dear Miss Fontanille:

Reference is made to your recent communication, with inclosed roster, addressed to the Secretary of the Army, Washington 25, D. C., concerning recognition of alleged guerrilla service rendered by former members of Fil-American Irregular Troops, Talbot Regiments, formerly Antipolo Unit.

The first requirement for crediting an individual with recognized guerrilla service is that his name appear on an approved reconstructed roster of an organization. Records on file in this office do not indicate that the above mentioned guerrilla unit is an approved guerrilla organization.

The extension of official recognition to individuals or organizations claiming guerrilla status was a function of the Guerrilla Affairs Division. Under this program, a period of more than three years was allowed for guerrilla units and members of such units to request official recognition. When that organization was deactivated on 30 June 1948, the guerrilla recognition program terminated, and the authority to alter, amend or modify previous decisions made, ceased to exist.

In view of the foregoing, I know of no other action that may be taken.




