I. Disbandment of Ghq, ECLGA (GUERRILLA), Pangasinan and Manila as a Philippine Army Unit. By direction of the President, the GHQ, EAST CENTRAL LUZON GUERRILLA AREA (GUERRILLA), Pangasinan and Manila, is disbanded effective 21 October 1945.

II. Disposition of personnel, GHQ, ECLGA (GUERRILLA) Pangasinan and Manila. All personnel assigned and/ or attached to the GHQ, ECLGA, with echelons presently located at Dagupan, Pangasinan and Manila, will be attached unassigned to the 2nd Repl Bn (PA), Camp Baysambang, Pangasinan, movement and disposition of personnel will compelled not later than 20 October 1945.

III. Disposition of US Government property of GHQ, ECLGA, (GUERRILLA). All records of G-4, GHQ, ECLGA will be submitted to CO 4th Camp Complement, for audit, on 21 October 1945. All United States government property issued to or in the possession of the GHQ, East Central Luzon Guerrilla Area and attached units, will be turned over to the Commanding Officer 4th Camp Complement, concurrent with the movement directed per section II, above.

I. EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 21 BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE PHILIPPINES.
The following Executive Order No. 21 by the President of the Philippines is published for the information and guidance of all concerned:

Executive Order No. 21

DECLARING TO BE ON ACTIVE SERVICE IN THE PHILIPPINE
ARMY ALL PERSONS NOW ACTIVELY SERVING IN RECOGNIZED
MILITARY FORCES IN THE PHILIPPINES

WHEREAS, many citizens residing in the Philippines of Filipino, American and other foreign citizenships, and Officers and Enlisted Men of the Philippine Army, of the armed forces of the United States and of Allied nations, have continued armed resistance against the imperial Japanese Government since the sixth of May 1942;

WHEREAS, this action has written in blood an epic of courage, devotion and loyalty to the Government and the people of the Philippines;

WHEREAS, these military forces have contributed in a large measure to the Allied military effort and to the liberation of the Filipino people from the yoke of the Japanese invader;

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Government of the Philippines to recognize this allegiance;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SERGIO OSMEÑA, President of the Philippines, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Emergency Powers Law, Section 22 and Section 27 of Commonwealth Act Numbered One notwithstanding, do hereby ordain and promulgate the following:

1. All persons, of any nationality or citizenship, who are actively serving in recognized military forces in the Philippines, are hereby considered to be on active service in the Philippine Army.
2. The temporary grades of Enlisted Men, enlisted or promoted in the field by Commander of recognized military forces or by their delegated authority, are hereby confirmed.
3. The temporary ranks of all officers, appointed or promoted in the field prior to this date by Commanders of recognized military forces, are hereby confirmed.
4. The date of entry into active service in the Philippine Army will be that of joining a recognized military force.
5. The effective date of rank for commissioned Officers and Enlisted Men will be the date on which they were appointed or promoted to such rank by the Commander of recognized military forces.
6. A recognized military force, as used herein, is defined as a force under a commander who has been appointed, designated or recognized by the Commander-in-Chief Southwest Pacific Area.

Executive Order No. 121

PROVISIONS TO BE OF ACTIVE SERVICE IN THE PHILIPPINE
ARMY AND AIR FORCE

WHEREAS, the provisions of Executive Order No. 121 of the President of the Philippines, dated 12 November 1954, are hereby extended to include the following: (a) the armed forces of the United States and of allied nations, have conducted armed resistance against the Imperial Japanese Government since the sixth of May 1942;

WHEREAS, this order has been written in good faith and devotion and loyalty to the Government and the people of the Philippines;

WHEREAS, these military forces have conducted in a brave manner to the Allied Military effort and to the liberation of the Philippines from the yoke of the Japanese invaders;

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Government of the Philippines to recognize this allegiance;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SERVICIO COMANDO EN JEFE, President of the Philippines, do hereby extend and promulgate the following:

1. All persons, of any nationality or allegiance, who are actively serving in recognized military forces in the Philippine Army are hereby considered to be on active service in the Philippine Army.

2. The necessary ranks of United States, enlisted or promoted in the field by Commander of recognized military forces or by their local authority, are hereby confirmed.

3. The necessary ranks of all officers, enlisted or promoted in the field by Commander of recognized military forces, are hereby confirmed.

4. The rank of active and reserve officers in the Philippine Army is hereby confirmed.

5. The rank of active and reserve officers in the Philippine Army is hereby confirmed.


