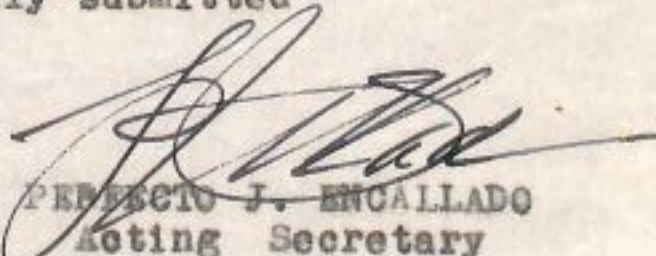

of the

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all of whom are of legal age, residents and citizens of the Philippines, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the law of the Philippines.

AND WE HEREBY CERTIFY:

First:- That the name of said corporation shall be:

WALTER CUSHING VETERANS OF WORLD WAR II, INC.

Second:- That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

a. To bring all together in one association all the veterans who served as guerrillas of the Walter Cushing Organization, under Felipe G. Pastrana (alias Reyes), co-founder, attached to 121st Infantry Regiment, P.S., AUS., Army of the United States of America.

b. To help each other, especially the indigents to acquire property and/or put up home industries in places where such members may happen to be in the Philippines, and to develop their farms and trades in order to improve their economic and social wellbeing;

c. To purchase, lease, or otherwise acquire lands and/or buildings as the corporation may need to carry out its purposes;

d. To assist the government, or supplement its efforts in combating economic slavery in the under developed communities where members of this corporation may be found;

Third:- That the place where the principal office of this corporation be established at "2609 Int. 14, Lico St., Tondo, Manila, Philippines."

Fourth:- That the term for which said corporation is to exist is fifty (50) years from and after the date of its incorporation;

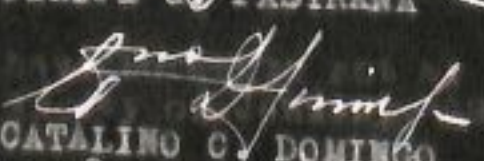
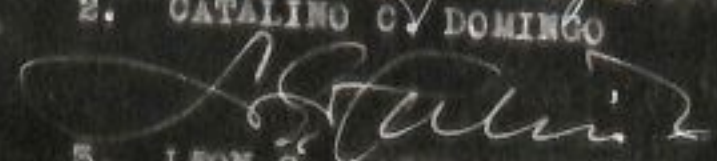

- B. This corporation and/or every individual member will extend help to indigents to secure their means of livelihood; to introduce the home industries suitable to the places for which the members and/or other people living in the Philippines; and to assist the members in the development of their farms and in improvement of profitable trades for the welfare of the populace.
- C. The lands and/or buildings that may be acquired by the corporation through purchase, lease or other legal means of acquisition, whichever the case maybe, are eventually necessary to carry on its motive and principal aim of unity of the whole masses, especially in social and economic welfare of the country. Lands that maybe possessed sometimes in the future are either agricultural or pastoral; and the buildings may be commercial depending on the circumstantial deve-

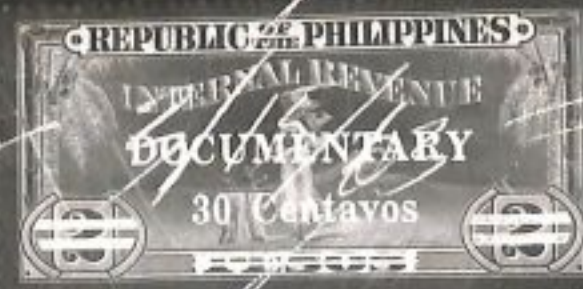

BY-LAWS:

(As approved in the Regular General Meeting,
Held at the Headquarters, on March 6th, 1963).

ARTICLE I - NAME AND DOMICILE

Section 1. - Name: The name of this Corporation is known as the "Walter Cushing Veterans of World War II, Inc." its principal office is at No. 2609 Int. 14, Lico St., Tondo, Manila, Philippines.

ARTICLE II - MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. - (a) Any member of the Walter Cushing Veterans of World War II, who had served from 1942 to 1945 up to the present and who were guerrillas of untrained men and women; (b) Any veterans of this Command who had served during World War II, are separated from the service are still carried on the military rosters. (c) Military personnel of the Armed Forces of the United States of America who are entitled to benefits under American or Philippine Laws; (d) Beneficiaries, heirs and successors-in-interest of the aforementioned military personnel. Provided that any person falling under any of the above qualifications is and shall not be a member of any veterans association which is or shall not be affiliated with the Veterans Federation of the Philippines.

Section 2. - Application for Membership; Any person of nearest of kins from the bonifide members of this command are qualified for membership provided he possesses the qualifications as prescribed in Section I hereof, may seek membership in the Walter Cushing Veterans of World War II, Inc. by filing a written application with the Secretary, who in turn shall sub-

mit the same to the Chairman, Committee on membership for screening and approval; the latter shall take charge of the acceptance of new members; and action on new applications shall be made by the Committee within thirty (30) days from receipt of such application by the Secretary.

ARTICLE III

Section 1. - An annual membership fee of five (P5.00) pesos shall be collected from each member, the same to constitute as operational expenses of the Corporation.

ARTICLE IV - BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND POWERS

Section 1. - The Walter Cushing Veterans of World War II, Inc., shall have a President, 1st Vice President, 2nd Vice President and a Secretary, an Auditor, a Liaison Officer, a Business Manager, a Historian, two (2) Press Relation Officers and Sergeant At-Arms, all of whom shall be elected by the Board of Directors, for a term of one (1) year and shall hold office until their successors are duly elected and qualified;

Section 2. - The Board of Directors shall meet at least once every two (2) months at the call of the President or upon the written request of the majority of the Board. The Board of Directors shall act only as a Body, and no power is vested in any individual member thereof as such. The Corporation shall act by and thru the Board of Directors.

Section 3. - The Board of Director by unanimous vote of all its members may confer Honorary Membership upon any deserving individual and appoint advisers who shall become ex-officio member thereof but without vote.

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ARTICLE V - DUTIES OF OFFICERS

Section 1. - President who shall be elected from the Directors shall preside over all meetings of the Corporation. He shall sign all official communications, notices and minutes of the General Meetings; he shall represent the Corporation on all occasions and in all matters where such representations may be required or agreed upon. He shall be held accountable for all properties of the Corporation, such as but not limited to cash money equivalent, flags, standards, books, printed matters, photographs, office equipments, etc., and shall after his term of office turnover such properties to his successor.

Section 2. - The 1st Vice President if qualified shall take over the duties and responsibilities of the President in the absence or temporary disability of the latter; and in case of permanent disability or death of the President the Vice President shall automatically become the President; likewise, the 2nd Vice President shall take succession thereof.

Section 3. - The Secretary shall keep the records of all the proceedings or meetings and sign agendas of the Corporation; shall be the custodian of all papers and records relative to the administration of same; and shall perform such other duties as the President may assign to him.

Section 4. - The President shall collect all fees, dues or contributions from the members as herein provided, and as may be agreed upon in a general meeting of the Corporation. He shall receive such amounts as may be due from whatever sources; settle with approval of the Board, all obligations legally and properly incurred, take actual custody of all funds and property of the Corporation, keep all the accounts of the Corporation and render a semestral report of the financial condition and property accountability to the Board.

Section 5. - The Auditor shall examine or pass in audit all collections and disbursements of funds, contracts, agreements and the books of accounts of the Corporation; and shall submit to the Board a semestral report of the financial condition and operations of the Corporation.

Section 6. - The Liaison Officer shall be the coordinator of the Corporation and may perform such other duties as the Board or the President may assign to him.

Section 7. - The Business Manager shall take a hand in all business matters of the Corporation and shall plan and recommend the same to the Board for realization of funds. He shall help publish magazines and/or souvenir programs of the Corporation, and exercise such duties as the Board or the President may assign to him.

Section 8. - The Press Relation Officers shall act as publication representatives of the Corporation and may publish in local newspapers or magazines all activities thereof whenever publication is desirable and may perform such other duties that the President or the Board may assign to him.

Section 9. - The Historian shall maintain or prepare the records of the history of the Corporation, memories of its common experience and may perform such other duties that the President or the Board may assign to him.

Section 10. - The Sergeant At-Arms shall take charge of the maintenance of peace and order in all meetings of the Corporation and exercise such other duties as the Board or the President may assign to him.

Section 11. - The Board may appoint the Chairman of various Committee the Corporation may create. The chairman of the Committee may select from among the members of the Corporation his assistants. The Chairman of various Committees shall submit a written report of their accomplishments at the General meeting

of the Corporation.

Section 12. - All other duties not covered in this By-Laws, may be assigned to the members of the Board of Directors upon approval of the same.

Section 13. - In case of temporary vacancy in any offices of the Corporation, the Board of Directors if still constituting a quorum and upon recommendation of the President may appoint a successor and shall serve the remaining portion of said unexpired term of office.

Section 14. - The Board of Directors by a majority vote shall appoint administration officers whose general duty shall be to administer and effectuate the policies of the Board of Directors. His specific duties shall be enumerated and defined by the Board.

ARTICLE VI - MEETINGS

Section 1. - The regular General Meeting of the Corporation shall be on the second Sunday of June and July of each year at the Principal office of such time as the President may determine or at any place within the City of Manila designated by the President.

Section 2. - A special General Meeting may be called by the President, or by a majority of the Board of Directors or when requested in writing by at least two (2/3) third of the membership filed with the Secretary. The latter shall give notice of such meeting at least one week in advance of the holding thereof.

Section 3. - The special Board Meetings may be called by the President or upon the written request of a majority of the members of the Board.

Section 4. - In all meetings of the membership or the Board, majority of the members shall constitute a quorum.

ARTICLE VII - ELECTIONS

Section 1. - Election of Officers: The entire membership shall elect at a meeting on the 1st Sunday of October, and each succeeding period thereafter, the members of the Board of Directors mentioned in Article IV and such other officers as it may deem necessary.

Section 2. - General elections shall not be held once a year.

Section 3. - Procedures of voting: Voting in all issues under consideration in the regular general meeting shall be viva voce except in the case of election of the Board of Directors, suspension, impeachment and/or expulsion thereof, where secret balloting shall be adopted; or when the issue is of vital interest to the Corporation.

ARTICLE VIII - AMENDMENT

Section 1. - Procedure: The Board of Directors by a majority vote of the members thereof may propose amendments to the By-Laws in a meeting duly called for the purpose, and shall become a part of said By-Laws upon ratification by a majority vote of the Corporation members in the meeting specifically called for such ratification.

ARTICLE IX - MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

Section 1. - In all meetings and deliberations, there shall be voting proxy.

Section 2. - In all cases of impeachment of members, a hearing to this effect shall be conducted by the Board wherein the presiding officer shall be designated by the Board of Directors. Majority votes of the members of the Board of Directors shall decide and render the corresponding sentence.

Section 3. - The following are grounds for impeachment and

others of similar nature:

- (a) Culpable violation of the prohibitory provisions of the By-Laws;
- (b) Acts grossly inimical to the dignity and interest of the Corporation;
- (c) Conviction for an offense involving moral turpitude;
- (d) Gross insult and/or disrespect to a member of the Board of Directors; and
- (e) Wanton disregard to the lawful resolutions and process of the Board of Directors.

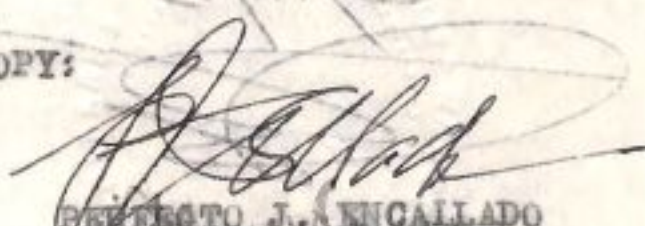

BY-LAWS:

(As approved in the Regular General Meeting,
Held at the Headquarters, on March 6th, 1963).

ARTICLE I - NAME AND DOMICILE

Section 1. - Name: The name of this Corporation is known as the "Walter Cushing Veterans of World War II, Inc." its principal office is at No. 2609 Int. 14, Lico St., Tondo, Manila, Philippines.

ARTICLE II - MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. - (a) Any member of the Walter Cushing Veterans of World War II, who had served from 1942 to 1945 up to the present and who were guerrillas of untrained men and women; (b) Any veterans of this Command who had served during World War II, are separated from the service are still carried on the military rosters. (c) Military personnel of the Armed Forces of the United States of America who are entitled to benefits under American or Philippine Laws; (d) Beneficiaries, heirs and successors-in-interest of the aforementioned military personnel. Provided that any person falling under any of the above qualifications is and shall not be a member of any veterans association which is or shall not be affiliated with the Veterans Federation of the Philippines.

Section 2. - Application for Membership; Any person of nearest of kins from the bonifide members of this command are qualified for membership provided he possesses the qualifications as prescribed in Section I hereof, may seek membership in the Walter Cushing Veterans of World War II, Inc. by filing a written application with the Secretary, who in turn shall sub-

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mit the same to the Chairman, Committee on membership for screening and approval; the latter shall take charge of the acceptance of new members; and action on new applications shall be made by the Committee within thirty (30) days from receipt of such application by the Secretary.

ARTICLE III

Section 1. - An annual membership fee of five (\$5.00) pesos shall be collected from each member, the same to constitute as operational expenses of the Corporation.

ARTICLE IV - BOARD OF DIRECTORS AND POWERS

Section 1. - The Walter Cushing Veterans of World War II, Inc., shall have a President, 1st Vice President, 2nd Vice President and a Secretary, an Auditor, a Liaison Officer, a Business Manager, a Historian, two (2) Press Relation Officers and Sergeant At-Arms, all of whom shall be elected by the Board of Directors, for a term of one (1) year and shall hold office until their successors are duly elected and qualified;

Section 2. - The Board of Directors shall meet at least once every two (2) months at the call of the President or upon the written request of the majority of the Board. The Board of Directors shall act only as a Body, and no power is vested in any individual member thereof as such. The Corporation shall act by and thru the Board of Directors.

Section 3. - The Board of Director by unanimous vote of all its members may confer Honorary Membership upon any deserving individual and appoint advisers who shall become ex-officio member thereof but without vote.

Section 3. - ARTICLE V - DUTIES OF OFFICERS as in such

Section 1. - President who shall be elected from the Direct-
ors shall preside over all meetings of the Corporation. He shall
sign all official communications, notices and minutes of the Ge-
neral Meetings; he shall represent the Corporation on all occa-

sions and in all matters where such representations may be re-
quired or agreed upon. He shall be held accountable for all pro-
perties of the Corporation, such as but not limited to cash money
equivalent, flags, standards, books, printed matters, photographs,
office equipments, etc., and shall after his term of office turn-
over such properties to his successor.

Section 2. - The 1st Vice President if qualified shall take
over the duties and responsibilities of the President in the ab-

sence or temporary disability of the latter; and in case of per-
manent disability or death of the President the Vice President
shall automatically become the President; likewise, the 2nd Vice
President shall take succession thereof.

Section 3. - The Secretary shall keep the records of all
the proceedings or meetings and sign agendas of the Corporation;
shall be the custodian of all papers and records relative to the
administration of same; and shall perform such other duties as
the President may assign to him.

Section 4. - The Treasurer shall collect all fees, dues or
contributions from the members as herein provided, and as may be
agreed upon in a general meeting of the Corporation. He shall
receive such amounts as may be due from whatever sources; settle
with approval of the Board, all obligations legally and properly
incurred, take actual custody of all funds and property of the
Corporation, keep all the accounts of the Corporation and render
a semestral report of the financial condition and property ac-
countability to the Board.

Section 5. - The Auditor shall examine or pass in audit all collections and disbursements of funds, contracts, agreements and the books of accounts of the Corporation; and shall submit to the Board a semestral report of the financial condition and operations of the Corporation.

Section 6. - The Liaison Officer shall be the coordinator of the Corporation and may perform such other duties as the Board or the President may assign to him.

Section 7. - The Business Manager shall take a hand in all business matters of the Corporation and shall plan and recommend the same to the Board for realization of funds. He shall help publish magazines and/or souvenir programs of the Corporation, and exercise such duties as the Board or the President may assign to him.

Section 8. - The Press Relation Officers shall act as publication representatives of the Corporation and may publish in local newspapers or magazines all activities thereof whenever publication is desirable and may perform such other duties that the President or the Board may assign to him.

Section 9. - The Historian shall maintain or prepare the records of the history of the Corporation, memories of its common experience and may perform such other duties that the President or the Board may assign to him.

Section 10. - The Sergeant At-Arms shall take charge of the maintenance of peace and order in all meetings of the Corporation and exercise such other duties as the Board or the President may assign to him.

Section 11. - The Board may appoint the Chairman of various Committee the Corporation may create. The chairman of the Committee may select from among the members of the Corporation his assistants. The Chairman of various Committees shall submit a written report of their accomplishments at the General meeting

of the Corporation.

Section 12. - All other duties not covered in this By-Laws, may be assigned to the members of the Board of Directors upon approval of the same.

Section 13. - In case of temporary vacancy in any offices of the Corporation, the Board of Directors if still constituting a quorum and upon recommendation of the President may appoint a successor and shall serve the remaining portion of said unexpired term of office.

Section 14. - The Board of Directors by a majority vote shall appoint administration officers whose general duty shall be to administer and effectuate the policies of the Board of Directors. His specific duties shall be enumerated and defined by the Board.

ARTICLE VI - MEETINGS

Section 1. - The regular General Meeting of the Corporation shall be on the second Sunday of June and July of each year at the Principal office of such time as the President may determine or at any place within the City of Manila designated by the President.

Section 2. - A special General Meeting may be called by the President, or by a majority of the Board of Directors or when requested in writing by at least two (2/3) third of the membership filed with the Secretary. The letter shall give notice of such meeting at least one week in advance of the holding thereof.

Section 3. - The special Board Meetings may be called by the President or upon the written request of a majority of the members of the Board.

Section 4. - In all meetings of the membership or the Board, majority of the members shall constitute a quorum.

ARTICLE VII - ELECTIONS

Section 1. - Election of Officers: The entire membership shall elect at a meeting on the 1st Sunday of October, and each succeeding period thereafter, the members of the Board of Directors mentioned in Article IV and such other officers as it may deem necessary.

Section 2. - General elections shall not be held once a year.

Section 3. - Procedures of voting: Voting in all issues under consideration in the regular general meeting shall be viva voce except in the case of election of the Board of Directors, suspension, impeachment and/or expulsion thereof, where secret balloting shall be adopted; or when the issue is of vital interest to the Corporation.

ARTICLE VIII - AMENDMENT

Section 1. - Procedure: The Board of Directors by a majority vote of the members thereof may propose amendments to the By-Laws in a meeting duly called for the purpose, and shall become a part of said By-Laws upon ratification by a majority vote of the Corporation members in the meeting specifically called for such ratification.

ARTICLE IX - MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

Section 1. - In all meetings and deliberations, there shall be voting proxy.

Section 2. - In all cases of impeachment of members, a hearing to this effect shall be conducted by the Board wherein the presiding officer shall be designated by the Board of Directors. Majority votes of the members of the Board of Directors shall decide and render the corresponding sentence.

Section 3. - The following are grounds for impeachment and

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others of similar nature:

- (a) Culpable violation of the prohibitory provisions of the By-Laws;
- (b) Acts grossly inimical to the dignity and interest of the Corporation;
- (c) Conviction for an offense involving moral turpitude;
- (d) Gross insult and/or disrespect to a member of the Board of Directors; and
- (e) Wanton disregard to the lawful resolutions and process of the Board of Directors.

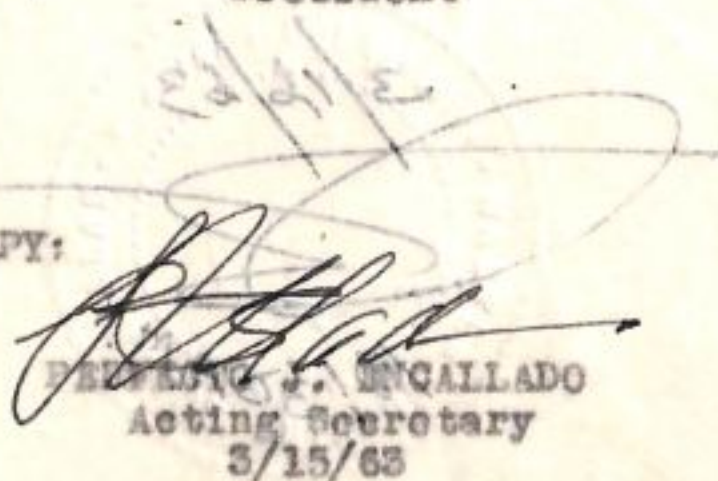
