



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

1. The request of Major Arsanio S. Marana, dated 1 January 1947, for individual non-casualty guerrilla recognition of Angel Bitanga in the rank of captain and the inclusion of his name on the recognized roster of Company G, 1st Battalion, 57th Infantry Regiment, has been investigated by this headquarters.
2. The request is disapproved in the rank of captain but is approved in the rank of first lieutenant. His period of recognition will extend from 15 February 1945 to 29 June 1945, both dates inclusive.
3. It is recommended that the name of Angel Bitanga be inserted with the rank of first lieutenant in the roster of Company G, 1st Battalion, 57th Infantry Regiment by issuance of appropriate orders.
4. It is further recommended that the subject individual be paid for such period as may be authorized by existing laws and regulations after adjudication and approval by the Recovered Personnel Division of this headquarters.
5. This letter rescinds all previous correspondence issued by this headquarters concerning individual non-casualty guerrilla recognition of Angel Bitanga.
6. This recognition will not be used as a basis for recognition by the remaining members of this unit.

1. a. The guerrilla units listed on attached list have been recognized by the Commander-in-Chief as authorized elements of USAFFE. Under the Provisions of Executive Order No. 21, by the President of the Commonwealth of the Philippines, dated 28 October 1944, the status of members of these units, who have served while the unit was in direct support of Sixth Army combat operations, is that of officers and enlisted men of the Philippine Army.

b. At such times as additional units are recognized, you will be forwarded supplementary lists.

2. It is desired that you notify those units on the attached list that are operating under your control that they have been recognized. The rosters of such units, as required by paragraph 3, letter this headquarters, AG 384 A-2, Subject: "Recognition of Guerrilla Units", dated 25 February 1945 which have not yet been submitted will be furnished without delay.

3. It has been noted from recommendations for recognition submitted by US Army organizations that frequently individuals, or groups of 2 to 5 persons, from a large guerrilla unit are the only personnel of such unit serving with the US Army organization. In such cases the unit has not been recommended for recognition. For the payment of such individuals for their services, it is desired that they be included on the payroll of a recognized guerrilla unit serving with your command.
