Extensive reinvestigation and reconsideration of the 1st Regiment, Folsom's Fil-American Guerrillas, a guerrilla unit recognized by the Commanding General, AFWESPAC, on 29 November 1945 with a strength of 4,951 for the period of 31 January 1945 through 26 September 1945, has developed that there existed insufficient justification for the original recognition of this unit.

2. During this reinvestigation full and just consideration was given to each individual listed on the unit rosters. With the exception of 193 men in the 4th Battalion and 512 men in the 5th Battalion, the investigation revealed that the unit's claimed record of service was not substantiated by sufficient acceptable evidence. There was unsatisfactory proof that the unit made any material contribution to the war effort. Scrutiny of rosters indicated that they were composed largely of:

a. Individuals, residing permanently in their homes, who did not make any active military contribution.

b. Individuals who failed, rightfully so, to be recognized with other units.

c. Individuals who were recruited after the termination of military operations in their area.

3. It is therefore announced that the existing recognition of all 4,951 presently listed members of the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th Battalions, 1st Regiment, Folsom's Fil-American Guerrillas, is revoked. to be considered as having been discharged from the Army. It is recommended that the Commanding General recognize the units listed below as battalions by the issuance of appropriate orders recognizing those individuals for the periods of recognition specified, authorized. Remaining casualties are recognized either by individual orders or paragraph 5 of this letter.

5. With reference to paragraph 2, this letter, the units listed below are recognized by the Commanding General, Philippines-Ryukyus Command, as having been authorized elements of the Philippine Army, serving with the Armed Forces of the United States:

6. All personnel of the members of the above-listed units who have previously served in connection with either the 4th or 5th Battalion, and whose names are contained for the six-month periods of recognition, are entitled to further remuneration for this period.

7. Under the provisions of Executive Order No. 21, by the President of the Commonwealth of the Philippines, dated 26 October 1944, the status of the members of these units, during the period above specified, as former officers or enlisted men of the Philippine Army.

8. Under the provisions of Executive Order No. 68, by the President of the Commonwealth of the Philippines, dated 26 September 1945, all officers and enlisted men of this unit, other than those who are members of the Regular Force or the Reserve Force of the Philippine Army, will be considered as having been discharged from the Philippine Army as of 26 September 1945.
