1. The inclosed casualty roster, Killed in Action, Killed in Line of Duty, Died in Line of Duty, of the Sabotage and Demolition Unit 4th Regiment, B.M.D., has been investigated.

2. This roster, consisting of one (1) page and containing the names of three (3) individuals, is approved. The period of recognition for each individual will extend from the date of induction or the date the unit was recognized, whichever is later, to the date the individual died, both dates inclusive. In cases where individuals enter a casualty status prior to the recognition date of the unit, their period of recognition will be the date entered a casualty status only.

3. It is requested that the names and ranks of these individuals be inserted on the unit roster of the Sabotage and Demolition Unit, 4th Regiment, B.M.D., by the issuance of appropriate orders.



5. Upon receipt from their legal heirs of a claim for arrears in pay and allowances due their estates, authority for settlement thereof under existing laws and procedures will be furnished your headquarters by the Director, Recovered Personnel Division, this headquarters.

6. This roster will constitute the only official recognised casualty roster, Killed in Action, Killed in Line of Duty, and Died in Line of Duty of the Sabotage and Demolition Unit, 4th Regiment, B.M.D.
