Fabricated Rosters

6. The so called "records" and "rosters" that have been presented to prove that personnel of the Aritao Detachment of "B" Co were military personnel, inducted into 14th Inf prior to 14 Jul 42, are fabrications. Presentation of such records constitutes fraud. As previous granting of AUS status to personnel of this Unit was based on the belief that the "records" were valid, it appears the entire Unit gained recognition through fraud.
- a. Roster signed by Lt Januario Longno, dated 30 June 42 (R-34).
- (1) This is not one of the 14th Inf archives recovered in the group that the 31 Mar 42 roster was in.
  - (2) Heading showing "Intial Roster" was a later guerrilla practice. This was not a new organization, as Combat Co had been redesignated "B" Co on 6 May 42, and heading should have been "Monthly Roster".
  - (3) Upper left corner of page 1 shows spelling "Rooster" instead of the correct spelling, which was also common in guerrilla units of a later period.
  - (4) So called "Aritao Detachment" on page 2 shows personnel having joined as early as 8 Feb 42, yet not a single one of them is in the 31 Mar 42 roster of Combat Co. (R-33), which clearly shows they were not military personnel of Co "B", 14th Inf.
  - (5) Under "Attached from other Organizations" on page 2, (R-34) both Vidad and Rumbaua have entries concerning Lt Col Theodore Kalakuka. Kalakuka was Gen. Wainwright's personal representative sent to effect surrender of troops, and first came to North Luzon on 9 May 42, when a Japanese plane brought him to Bagabag airstrip. This "roster" attempts to show that Vidad was promoted from Sgt to Tech Sgt., and that Rumbaua was enlisted, by Lt Col Kalakuka. Such action was not possible, in view of Lt Col Kalakuka's known zeal in getting troops to surrender, and his declaring as "deserters" all USAFFE personnel who refused to turn themselves in to the Japanese. (Such declaration was tantamount to giving open license to the Japanese to execute all persons so declared, on capture, as they could not be protected under rules prescribed for Prisoners of War.)
  - (6) Innocenio Palma is listed as "Died in Action-Tayug, 14 Apr 42". Palma was one of the men under Antiporda, who had not joined 14th Inf prior to their deaths. (S-26,15) Note that Montejo lists Palma in his "G" Co. (S-91) (Sec D-79)
  - (7) Records of USAFIP, NL show information concerning following men listed on p2 of "roster".

- b. 15 persons on this list are shown by recovered archives (Troop Roster "A" Co, 31 Oct 42) to have initially joined 14th Inf in Sept or Oct 1942.
- c. Frogo was a Philippine Scout, and initially joined this Unit on 16 Sept 1942.
- d. Photostat of original with Enriquez' signature was found, but since that photostat was made, the part of this document bearing the "signature" has disappeared. Original is in originals file of Rosters.
- e. Sague was never in Bataan, and was in 14th Inf from the beginning.

Dear Captain Keith:

I'm sending you this message with a hope above all that same will reach you in the best of your health and high spirits. I am already a civilian as I was discharged last 30 March 47. At present I am taking summer classes at the Mindanao Colleges under the benefits of the G. I. Bill of Rights.

Coming now to the important purpose of writing you this letter, I have no other objective then reminding the Captain for the reconsideration of the cases of my EM in the attached list re their AUS status. I believe that there is no other important evidence testifying the services of these EM other than my statements as former CO, of "G" Co., 14th Inf. I am ready to face any charges against falsification of documents and I gave my life as a guarantee of my statements pertaining to their services under "G" Co. These particular individuals were not included in either one of the Rosters submitted to HQ 14th Inf which copies are now in your possession, specially those Rosters made in 1944 which I think that office is giving more weight in determining AUS status. The reason why such names were omitted in the 1944 Rosters is that when the CO, 14th Inf called for the 1942 Rosters of our units, my CP was at Pingkian, Nueva Viscaya where it was hard for me to contact some EM whose names could not be remembered by me. (~~1944 Rosters~~ by 1944 Rosters, I mean those Rosters from April 1942 to Dec 1942 which I saw at your Office <sup>which</sup> were only made and submitted on October 1944) The monthly original Rosters in my possession were captured by the Japs when my Camp was raided on 10 Dec. 1942, so that there was no direct reference available at the time the 1942 Rosters were made on October 1944. The latest Roster which is in a consolidated form or rather a Final Roster as of Dec 10, 1942 was made upon the request of Lt-Col R. A. Manriquez former CO, 14th Inf after his arrival from the States. This was in the early part of 1946 when all the units of the 14th Inf as of 1942 were ordered to Alabang for re processing under the AUS status. This Roster was submitted personally to Capt Simons. The names appearing in this Roster was based upon the previous Rosters submitted in Oct 1944 with additional names of EM whom I newly contacted during my first vacation to Eastern Pangasinan (my former sector). It is really clear that comparing the Rosters submitted in 1944 with that of the Final Roster as of 10 Dec 1942, one will suspect something why new names are inserted in the Dec 1942 Roster and as <sup>I</sup> said before, this was due to my inability to contact these new EM during the time ~~I made the first time I made the rosters in 1944.~~ ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ The first time I consulted the Captain <sup>about</sup> the cases of these EM not confirmed, you told me that even though such EM does not appear in the previous Rosters they can be confirmed if they can produce sufficient papers or documents which can prove their services under the unit. To tell you the truth Captain, some of this men became desperate in their individual case and is ~~xxxxxx~~ bothering me much asking for help. Of course for those other men, they just told me that they are thankful enough to survive the war. But ~~judging~~ basing upon how others talk to me they are putting the fault on me

which I do not ignore. So that I am trying my best to explain in this letter the consequences which brought about the omission of the names of this EM in the revised Rosters causing the disapproval of their AUS status. There <sup>are</sup> no other Officers who can testify the validity of the services of the EM other than the late Lt. S. Marinas, Ex. O. of the Co., Lt Lopez and my self. Capt Vicente Matias and Capt. L. Ramirez both members of the Bn Staff, 2nd Bn went to Camp on the later part of Nov. 1942 for inspection and these two Officers can not identify all the members of my Co. as the men were distributed to different detachments in Eastern Pangasinan. One more point I want to tell the Capt is that some of this EM who were processed in the PA did not state that they were original members of the 14th Inf. This really happened when I was at Camp Spencer. The processing Teams rejected EM of the 14th Inf as this unit was known to them as a part of the United States Army. However, for those EM who insisted to be processed some were accepted by the processing teams like also in my case. I bring out this point as I am sure that what is being stated in the PA processing papers are compared to those in the AUS processing papers and one who claims to be an AUS who does not appear in the Roster and same have not stated in his former PA processing papers ~~as~~ to be a member of the 14th Inf in 1942 will have a hard time for confirmation which I see to it that some of my unconfirmed EM falls under this category.

I think this letter of mine is too long to impede the work of the Captain. I am enclosing herewith stamps for the Captains reply so that I may know your decision in considering my request and that I may also inform each individual EM.



1. Reference to letter of that office dated 6 Nov 46, the undersigned has no original copies of rosters for 1942 of "G" Co., 14th Infantry. Rosters under his possession are revised rosters only. The original rosters of 1942 were submitted to the late Major Manuel P. Enriquez, Regtl. Ex. O. and CO, 2nd Bn. 14th Inf. The ones kept by the units were captured by the Japanese when the CP of "G" Co., 14th Inf. was raided on 10 December 1942. On or about October 1944, the new Regtl. Comdr. of the 14th Inf., Lt. Col. R. A. Manriques, called for rosters of my unit since its organization way back in April 1942. Rosters were made and submitted to Regtl. Hq. and I believe that these revised rosters are in records which were turned over to the Adj. Gen. USAFIP, NL, at Camp Spencer when the 14th Inf. was demobilized. When Col. Manriques newly arrived from States, he asked rosters of my unit as of 1942 and I submitted to him a final roster as of 10 December 1942. Col. Manriques told me that the rosters and the narrative report of the activities of "G" Co. were to be submitted to AFWESPAC as same were badly needed.

2. The revised rosters that were submitted were not complete due to the fact that the writer could not contact the rest of the men, as some enlisted men surrendered after the raid on 10 Dec. 1942 and did not rejoin while others joined other guerrilla outfits. There are bona fide members of "G" Co., 14th Inf. who are now writing me letters re their status under the AUS but in as much that their names were not included in the rosters submitted, certificates were issued by me. Request that I be advised if supplementary roster is needed to support the AUS status of these particular individuals.






