- d. The price of P100.00 for rice is very much lower than the current price of P750.00 in Northern Negros. However, considering the fact that other units are consuming lower-priced corn and rice and considering further that the Army is consuming part of the ROF Government share, which cost P7.00 per cavan, it is believed that the P100.00 included in the estimate is a reasonable average.

Part III - Clothing Allowance - This was calculated from GSW Bulletin No. 3 dated 30 Dec. '43. Monthly calculation includes a 12-month amortization of the still unpaid portion of this item.

- GENERAL REMARKS:
- a. Strength - This was taken from the Personnel Distribution, prepared by District Hqs. dated 27 May '44 and from the 7th Division Tactical Distribution of Troops dated 31 May '44. These two references differ slightly and the total strength included in our estimate is a little bit higher than said 7th Distribution of personnel but for purposes of calculation, this difference would not have a material effect. - Part I - a.** Partial Pay and Allowance - \$76.00 for officers multiplied by the number of officers. Add 5% of the product to cover family allowance. \$21.00 for IN multiplied by the number of IN plus 50% of the product to cover also family allowance.
- b.** Operating Expenses - \$2.50 daily per capita as prescribed by regulation.
- c.** Fresh Composites - \$2.50 daily per capita as prescribed by regulation.
- d.** Intelligence Reps. - Rather arbitrary but the latest available financial report of various Finance Officers were referred to and the best of judgment was applied on estimate.
- e.** Supply Supplies - (Stationery, Medical, Engineering, Signal, etc.) - Same comment as in (d)
- f.** Sundry Expenses - (Casualty, travelling expenses, etc.) - Same comment as in (d)
- Part II -** Subsistence Supplies other than Fresh Composites and Laundry Soap
- a.** Calculations a full ration basis.
- b.** Quantities of Subsistence Supplies were based on G-3 Bulletin No. 3 of CTR-T dated 10 Aug. '43, which prescribed the authorized table of subsistence allowance.
- c.** Prices were based on CURRENT ones and were picked up from the Semi-annual Report of the Division Finance Officer for the period ending 30 June '44.
- d.** The price of \$100.00 for rice is very much lower than the current price of \$750.00 in Southern Negroes. However, considering the fact that other units are consuming lower-priced corn and rice and considering further that the Army is consuming part of the 20% Government share, which cost \$7.00 per cwt., it is believed that the \$100.00 included in the estimate is a reasonable average.
- Part III - Clothing Allowance -** This was calculated from G-3 Bulletin No. 3 dated 30 Dec. '43. Monthly calculation includes a 12-month amortization of the still unpaid portion of this item.

In consonance with the proclamation of General DOUGLAS MACARTHUR, Commander-in-Chief, United States Armed Forces in the Far East, dated 23, October 44, re-establishing the Government of the Commonwealth of the Philippines in all free Areas in the Philippines, any and all orders, instructions, procedures, etc. issued by this Headquarters and/or all other subordinate units during the early formation of the guerrilla organization in NEGROS, contrary to the laws, orders, regulations, procedures, etc. of the <sup>Commonwealth</sup> Government of the Philippines, including those orders, instructions, etc. issued by HONORABLE ALFREDO M. MONTELIBANO, Governor of NEGROS and SIKULJOR, are hereby revoked in all the free areas of this District.

Any military personnel who disregards this instructions, and who fails to obey and respect the legal laws, regulations, orders, procedures, etc. of the Government of the Commonwealth of the Philippines will be dealt with accordingly.

Sir:

I believe issuance of this kind of circular is timely and appropriate. Since, however, your circular is intended, not only for the military personnel, 7thD, but also for all the people of Negros and Siquijer, in so far, at least, as they are affected by the orders of Governor A. Montelibano, I believe that it is proper to issue it as a Proclamation. Besides, commensurate with its importance, it should be dignified in the form of a Proclamation. Draft of proclamation hereto attached.

Please note that I have worded your order in the Proclamation in such a way as to merely announce the fact that all your orders and those of Gov. Montelibano contrary to the laws of the Commonwealth are nullified and voided, in the free areas because the Proclamation of Gen MacArthur has already produced that result.

Gov Montelibano is your appointee, as he commanded by President Quezon. At least prior to the proclamation of Gen. MacArthur, he has been acting officially, in actual practice, and probably, in legal effect, under your supervision. This is the implication I gather from the Gen. Mac's proclamation. It is therefore right that his orders be also included in your proposed circular of proclamations.

Re-Occupation of Enemy Areas

1. When enemy occupied areas are retaken by Allied Forces and/or UNCAF, existing records and profiles of enemy agents will assume primary importance. Disqualification from holding public office, pay raise and rehabilitation for UNCAF and Commonwealth are specifically imposed by Congress as a condition to the Philippine Independence Grant. Espionage laws impose duties on one of the penalties for espionage and the same shall be guided by the following rules:

a. The term enemy agent shall include all persons, Commonwealth citizens and foreigners, who shall include all those holding public office with the Japanese-controlled puppet Philippine Government. Commonwealth shall include all those who are employed in Japanese firms, Japanese-controlled firms and plants, or agencies whose business or activity is connected with the Japanese war effort. All individual opportunists who are trading with the Japanese directly or indirectly, but whose business tends to help the Japanese war effort shall also be classified as enemy agents. Lists and profiles shall include all persons who have actually been employed either directly by the Japanese to give them vital information to the detriment of the UNCAF or the Allied Cause as a whole. Copies of the District Intelligence Enemy Agents records will be furnished with lists at the appropriate time.

b. All persons without exception whose names appear in the District Intelligence Enemy Agents' Records shall upon re-occupation be immediately rounded up and placed in War Prisoners Camps, to be designated by the Commanding Officer of the Re-occupation Unit. Male and female delinquents shall be placed in separate compounds. No person whose name does not appear in the list shall in any way be arrested or placed in compounds as an enemy agent without the previous approval of the District Intelligence Office. The Unit Commanders of the re-occupation troops will be held responsible for carrying out these instructions to the letter.

c. Units immediately upon receipt hereof, their intelligence officers shall submit a complete report, per District Intelligence Directive, of all Enemy Agents in their respective areas.

2. UNCAF Operatives must be given due protection. District Policy specifies compensation for civilian operatives killed or disabled in line of duty. All intelligence operatives disabled partially or completely while in the discharge of a assigned mission shall be entitled to compensation in the amount of which shall be determined by the UNCAF and the Pension Board. District beneficiaries of deceased intelligence operatives who have been killed by the enemy while in the pursuit of a mission or as a result thereof shall be entitled to compensation or gratuity to be determined by the District Finance Officer and Pension Board.

a. Submit immediately a list of all your civilian operatives to the District Intelligence Office thru the nearest UNCAF Intelligence Officer in your area. District officers to whom lists are given should issue a receipt. They will be held responsible for its compliance with the enemy. Only absolute reliable carriers should be used in transmitting lists to the UNCAF.

b. Intelligence of local assisting the names of their operatives will be held solely responsible for the accuracy and veracity of list of operatives submitted.

c. NO CLAIM for indemnity, privileges, or future compensation, if any, will be accepted unless the name of the operative appears in the records of the District Intelligence Office.

d. Immediately upon re-occupation, all operatives shall be commissioned to act as agents to identify and arrest all persons whose names appear in the District Intelligence Espionage Record.

3. For the interest of an orderly and efficient manner of dealing with Enemy Agents, all Unit Commanders are ordered to give these instructions minute attention.
