HISTORICAL DATA OF THE 14TH INFANTRY, USARIP, NL

- (1) The 14TH INFARMY, USAFIP, MI was originally designated as the FIRST GURRILLA REGISENT and then redesignated as 14TH INFARMY USAFY. Lt-Colonel EVEREYT I. MARKEN, the senior officer, became the Regimental Commander with MARKEN THE COMMAND THE RESIDENCE OF THE STATE OF MARKEN THE STATE OF THE STATE OF
-) (2) This regiment was organized during the last week of December 1941 and the first week of January 1942.
 - (3) Organized at Aritao and DUPAK. Nueva Vizcaya.
 - (4) By authority from CG, USAFFE.
 - (5) The original members came from remnants of the 112H, 12H, 71ST AND 91ST HIPATRIES URAFF, (PA), 26H CAV (FS), FC COMPANIES and personnel of the 1ST HILITARY DISTRICT MQ (PA). These units were out off due to the rapid advance of the enemy and through no fault of their own culd not join the forces in Estama.
- b. (1) About the middle of February 1942, the regiment was reorganized and its units redesignated as follows: The 2nd Bn under Li-colonel Guillerme Hakar (then a Major) became the He Ha and Hajor Makar became the Regt1 Executive Officer as well as CO, M. BN; Captain Warren Minton, still CO, 1st Haj Major Enriquez was assigned CO, 2nd Bn and his original Hy BN became the 2nd Bn.
 - (2) after the fall of Bataan, 8 April 1942, Lt-Col Warner and Capt Minton Left the regiment and Lt-Colonel laker then took command. Capt AMNOD then became the CO of HQ BN, Capt FERRIN OBTHA Actg CO, 1st En and Major Enriquez, CO of 2nd En.
 After the fall of Corregidor; Lt-Col Nakar, his of-

ficers and men refused to surrender and continued to harrass the enemy and at the same time endeavored to contact GMP, SWPA. On June 30, 1942 radio contact with GMP, SWPA. Serial numbers from 0-888070 to 0-888169 were given to officers and from 10626000 to 10626999 for enlisted men. On Sept 29, 1942, Lt-Col Nakar with some officers and EM were captured in Minuri, Jones, Isabela. - For your information, I am submitting herewith a list of the 2nd Bn and Combat Co, leth Inf, PA personnel who may have acquired AUS status by virtue of Gen MacArthur's radiogram from Australia to Col Guillermo Nakar, C.O., leth Inf, on 12 July 1942.
- The sources of this list of persons are from rosters of officers and troops, and En and Combat Co, 14th Inf presently on file of the 14th Inf Section, your headquarters for the months of May, June, July, and August 1942.
- 3. No documents could be obtained presently in the files of the 14th Inf showing that the personnel in the attached list were inducted into the Army of the United States.
- 4. From my personal knowledge, I have not known of any induction made by the late Lt Col Manuel P. Enriquez.
- 5. The reason, I believe, why Col Euriques was unable to do so was that, at the time he received the authority from Col Nakar to induct the men, his CP was far way off from the men of the 2nd En and consequently he was unable to make the trip to the battalion area on account of intensire enomy nopphing-up operations,
- 6. Some of the men, however, were industed by me when Col Enriques verbally delegated me the authority on 1 October 1942 at BA-BADDI, Pingkian, Nueve Vicaya. Again, no copy of this induction is presently available in the files of the 16th Inf as most of the 1942 records were lost or destroyed by causes beyond our control. Some of the surviving members may have retained their own copies, but we are presently unable to pool them together and collect their own copies,
