3-2 Report on Nueva Vizcaya Province.  
1122 thru 3-14-1113.

1. The following 3-2 report of the above area is hereby submitted for the period May 1, 1944 to May 31, 1944:

2. JAP GARRISONS:

a. Jap garrisons are located at the following places:

b. My estimate of the total number of Japs in the area is: 390

c. The location of the barracks of all Jap garrisons listed above as one hundred or over is:

(1) Bayombong - in Bayombong Elementary School former PC barracks, and in private house south of the public market (for the MP). (Refer to Stationer previously submitted).

d. I submit the following regarding the state of training, morale, etc. of the Jap troops in this area:

(1) Training - No training observed during the period.  
(2) Morale - I believe the Japs enlisted men have high morale, while the officers have low morale.

b. My estimate of the total number of PC in the area is: 700

c. The location of the barracks of all PC garrisons listed above as fifty or over is:

(1) Bagabag - in old market place now under construction.  
(2) Bayombong - in elementary school.  
(3) Bambang - use 500 acres from Municipal Government of Malasin. Site of old PC barracks.

a. Fuel:

- (1) Bayombong, Old Camp - unknown no. of drums of gasoline and oil. (Refer to sketches previously submitted).

b. Munitions:

- (1) Bayombong Am Dump - (Refer to sketches previously subd)

c. Supply:

- (1) Baguio - In the market place. (Refer to sketches previously submitted). Est sacks of rice - 10,000.  
(2) Solao - In St. Louis elem. Sch, N. Viz Rice Mill, and in Mr. Bautista's house. (Refer to sketches previously submitted). Est sacks of rice - 32,000.  
(3) Bayombong - In market place. (Refer to sketches previously submitted). Est sacks of rice - 50,000.  
(4) Bambang - In the market place. Est sacks of rice - 10,000.  
(5) Aritao - In the market place. Est sacks of rice - 14,000.  
(6) Darak - In a private house. Est sacks of rice - 9,000.

9. Motor vehicles are concentrated at the following places:

- a. Solao - In Elementary Sch Bldg - 2 trucks and 2 cars, 5/16/4  
b. Bayombong - In Elementary Sch Bldg - 40 trucks and 2 cars, 5/16/4

10. Tanks are concentrated at the following places: None.

11. The following troop movements took place during the period covered:

- a. About 600 Japs passed through this Province from south going north on May 11-13th.  
b. 14 trucks loaded with artillery pieces of unknown caliber and no. passed thru Bayombong from S going N, May 14th.  
c. 18 empty trucks passed Bayombong from S going N, May 16th.  
d. 10 trucks loaded with Japs soldiers passed Bayombong on the 22nd May from south to north.  
e. 10 trucks loaded with Japs soldiers (3 loaded with auto mobile spare parts) came from south going north, May 22.  
f. 5 trucks loaded with Japs soldiers (est 200) came from south to north, May 31st.  
g. 4 trucks, loaded with barges, from south to north, May 31st.  
h. 4 trucks, loaded with motor spare parts, from S to N, 31st.  
i. 2 trucks, loaded with barb wires, from S to N, May 31st.

12. The following activity took place at ports during the period: No ports.

13. Artillery pieces are located at the following places: None.

14. The following beach defense preparations have been made: None.

15. The following miscellaneous information regarding the area is submitted:

- a. Japs collected from this Province about 40 tons of barb wire and sent north.  
b. The collection of rice in all towns is going on continuously.  
c. Rumors in towns that Japs will eventually requisition or commandeer galvanize iron roofing of all houses to be sent to the coast.  
d. Another rumors in town state that in a very near future all civilians in towns will be evacuated far from military objectives.  
e. Population in towns are in uproar due to the extensive march of Japs.

1. The Japs are in the area of the coast.
