1. We are wornied about Chanuyan because we got no means of knowing his condition and moreover; we could not wait the return of Peciong. However, I hope Sir that you have recovered already from your illness.

2. Str #465-1122 is always inquiring about the return of Chaniyan because Tayaban want to have per, and interview with him. He even sent 2 of his men to Pang, to see Chanuyan last Sept, 25th but they return for obvious reasons. This connection, I am sending 3 of our men to follow Chanuyan to see what his present condition and the same time to bring some correspondence for our units in the pouth.

3. Sir, HGS-1122 desired that our Intellegence Information report covering the sector of the 14th Info completed and accurate and be submitted without possible delay. Copy of that colors dated Aug. 26, 1943 and copy of the G-2 report are in file.

4. Sir, if Chanuyan could not come yet due to obvious reasons, I suggest that the same runner will be sent back immediately with the missive of Chanuyan to Tayaban.

7. Sir, the following is furnsih for your information: The people of Lathang and Penayag surrendered to the

Jap not long ago.

On the Elat of Oct. 80 Japs with some PC from Bayombong patrolled "ang. glyang, Hanstoan, Macdo and return to Bayombong on the 25rd. They have maltreated lobs of civitians in Manstoan and Macdo. They even abused 2 women in Macdo and after the ir animal desire they thrust the vigina with the point of the bayonet.

On the same date, 8 Japs with captured soldiers (their names unknown) from Pangane patrolled Benalian, Bengtoner, Benao, Penayag and Letbang. They return on the 25th following the same route. They have maltreated loss of civilitians in Penayag and Letbang. They seven came to the extend of mellreating that he Boghony of Letbang was illust.

The was reported by a native of Pangpang so one of our men that the Japs in Pangpang are permanent detachment. They have deposited 20 cavans of rice right in the Mun. Bidg, and they are still gathering some more rice to stored thereat frey have constructed trenches around the Mun. Bidg. They are armed with MGs. (No. unkn.) authomatic rifles (No. unkn.) ard rifles. A Captain is incharge thereat. They are forcing the inhabitants of that place to attend classes. They have put also an outpost in Talmoy consisting of 7 Japs. Kayapa is patrolled once a week.

People of Latbang evacuated although they have surren-

dered to the Jap because they are aware that they will be maltreated again when the Japs come for the second time.

It was widely rumored and according to a native talked by one of our men said that the Mayor of Pinklan threaten the people of Benegueng thus making them surrendered some rifles cal 30, shotguns, ammunitions and home wade shotguns. According to a native of this place whom I sent be

Bo. d to buy some provisions some times last more said that the Mayor of Bokod was assassinated last Oct., Den., According to same native the Japa are busy patrolling bokod area to locate the bandits who abduct the Mayor.

News is getting better and better everyday. Hope it won't be long to keep us waiting for the M-day. Regards to all.

- 1. We are worried about Chanuyan because we got no means of knowing his condition and moreover, we could not wait the return of Peciong. However, I hope Sir that you have recovered already from your illness.
- 2. Sir, HQS-1122 is always inquiring about the return of Chamuyan because Tayaban want to have personal interview with him. He even sent 2 of his men to Pang, to see Chanuyan last Sept. 25th but they return for obvious reasons. In this connection, I am sending 3 of our men to follow Changen to see what his present condition and the same time to bring some correspondence for our units in the South.
- 3. Sir, HQS-1122 desired that our Intelligence Information report covering the sector of the 14th Inf. be completed and accurate and be submitted without possible delay. Copy of Instructions dated Aug. 26, 1943 and copy of the G-2 report are in file.
- A. Sir, if Chanuyan could not come yet due to obvious reasons, I suggest that the same runner will be sent back immediately with the missive of Changyan to Tayaban.
- 5. Duhat now known as Beliang is still in B. area. He did not return yet since he went down lat Sept. 23rd. However, he is busy checking the Intell. Infor. in regards to B/ area as Yacal and Valdes are not attending to their duty faithfully. They don't care to submit their reports since the captured of Dau. They even failed to notify this HQS of their whereabouts not until Tayeban notify this HQS about Valdez. At last, Baliang have contacted them. I am inclosing correspondence from Valdez to Tayaban for your information.

We are not far from the old places or that I am positive your runners can find us easily. This is however a more suggestion and if you think of any better idee, it will be O.K. with me.

 Wonder if you were able to contect Major Laphan. The old men are hammering my seh regarding him. Please don't forget to mention about him by return mail.

4. Presently our place is practically quiet and clear of enemies. There are sometimes deep setral but not in big numbers and they set friendly to the civilians unlike the previous reactions. Here is getting better and better everyday. Hope it won't be long to keep us waiting for the M-day. Regards to all.

 reduced and some eliminated. Number of Japs in the Egguio erea still high.
