- 17 2129 1:- BUKIDNON. 5 Japs hiding at INAWAAN vic 74.8-69.2  
MAAPAG Sheet on 16 Aug.
- 18 0928 2:- AGUSAN. Fm 1800 hrs, 14 Aug to 1000 hrs, 15 Aug, approx  
100 Japs made Banzai attack on perimeter of "A" and "D"  
Cos, 110th Exp Bn vic 50.9-97.8 (BALAPITAN). 23 Japs  
KIA, 2 mortars and 7 rifles captured. Dog tags and docu-  
ments taken. 1 dead Jap found floating in ADGAWAN  
RIVER, vic SAUNTO.
- 18 1130 3:- ZAMBOANGA. 2 PWs reported in our Item 4 Daily Intelli-  
gence Summary No 116, were picked up by an LCI on 17  
Aug.
- 18 2342 4:- BUKIDNON.  
Sims of 1st, 2nd and 3rd Bns, 112th Regt on their way  
back fm KAMNAN were attacked by unest nr of Japs at  
KIBUNGKOG (03.8-48.3, TAGPANIO SHEET) on 17 Aug. 3  
Japs KIA, and following were captured: 1 MG cal .30, 3  
Springfields and 4 Jap rifles. Our troops at end of  
period at LINDAGAY CREEK (vic 03.1-48.6).
- 19 0830 5:- BUKIDNON. Datu UNLOPOC (Native) contacted 7 Japs with  
1 Chinaman as interpreter at vic 99.6-93.5 (MT BAHAGN)  
on 13 Aug. Japs came fm SUNBOGAN vic 94.9-94.1 and  
state there are about 500 Japs in SUNBOGAN and surround-  
ing areas and that they expect another group fm DONALA-  
GUING vic 63.6-08.8 (NANGHA SHEET) to arrive this week.  
These Japs still expect aid from their homeland. 2  
contact men sent to inform the Japs of their uncondi-  
tional surrender. Results of cont not yet known.  
Leaflets will be dropped there.
- 18 1920 6:- DAVAO. Enemy attacked all positions of 111 Prov Bn  
at 2030 hrs, 17 Aug. Fight lasted for 8 hours.

DATE TIME ITEM

- 15 2100 1:- BUKIDNON. Recon pl to MIARAYON on 15 Aug made no contact with the enemy.  
Ref KALAGUTAY Sheet. Jap situation map taken by elms 112 Regt at HANHAM indicates that approx 1000 Japs are dispersed between KUMAWAS vic (98.0-80.5) & HANHAM. Japs these areas have MG emplacements and pill-boxes guarding trails fm TANGANTANGAN vic (84.0-57.0) and LUMBAYAO vic 91.8-82.3. Japs have telephone & radio communications.
- 16 0910 2:- AGUSAN. Ptl of 15 Aug contacted unest nr of Japs in vic 83.6-92.4. 2 Japs KIA. 2 Japs who refused to surrender were killed by our ptl in vic 81.9-80.9 at 1000 hrs, 15 Aug. 1 Jap rifle captured. Jap killed identified is member of the 9th Co, 41st INF.
- 16 0925 3:- BUKIDNON. PW captured fm 13 to 14 Aug 2. Pws sent to 81st DIV same day. Names were: Pfc YAMADA and Pfc KUMI, both of the TAKAKURA A/P Bn captured by elms of 117 Inf at LUMBIA, VALENCIA.
- 16 1600 4:- AGUSAN. Late reports. A total of 85 Japs were found dead in the AGUSAN VALLEY area for the month of July. This figure is taken in the Monthly G-2 reports received today for the 110th Div and was not previously included in the total enemy killed in the AGUSAN VALLEY for the month of July.
- 16 2230 4:- AGUSAN. Our ptl contacted Japs in vic 98.4-98.4 on 11 Aug. On same date other ptl located est 50 Japs dug in vic 48.5-99.7.
- 17 1250 5:- AGUSAN. Our troops found 1 dead Jap floating in river via SAGUPTO yesterday, 16 Aug. Fm 1 to 17 Aug our guerrilla troops killed 120 Japs, found 71 dead Japs and captured 3 or a total of 194.  
All our troops assembled vic SAGUPTO enroute to BUTUAN. This closes reports on Upper AGUSAN.
- 17 0112 5:- BUKIDNON. Elms of 117th Inf encountered est 50 Japs in vic 81.6-82.5 on 15 Aug. 14 Japs KIA. Ptl was out of contact then.

- 14 2120 17- AGUSAN, WALOE area. 27 Japs found dead floating on UMAYAN RIVER during last 24 hrs. Our units had no contact with enemy 13 and 14 August.
- 14 2030 2:- BUKIDNON. Ref MAAPAO Sheet. Elms 117 Inf encountered 3 Japs at HABAGO vic 81.2-65.1 at 1100 hrs, 12 Aug. Jap killed identified as officer. Other 2 escaped. Guards at MAMPALI Bridge killed 1 Jap and captured 1 Carbine at COLONIA vic 77.6-78.0 on 13 Aug.  
2 EM 117 Inf with some civs captured 2 Japs without arms at LOMEU vic 72.3-54.4 14 Aug. Japs delivered to 31st Div. They were identified as members of Maj TAKAHURA force formerly stationed at VALENCIA. Force belongs to VALENCIA sector composed largely of Airfield Bns.  
Civ states that approx 100 Japs were seen on 11 Aug at TANDAKOL vic 36.0-97.7 (MAGAJALAR BAY Sheet). Rice and root crops available in this area.
- 14 1914 3:- DAVAO. Elms of 111 Prov Bn captured summit of hill at vic 33.2-77.3 at 1440 hrs, 14 Aug. Enemy offered stiff resistance but was overcome.  
At 1930 hrs, 13 Aug, a squad of Japs raided position of "B" Co, 130th Regt. Fire fight lasted until day break. Enemy repulsed.  
At 2005 a platoon of Japs raided CP of 1st Bn 130th Regt. Firing came from W bank of LIGARAN RIVER. Enemy withdrew at 140400.
- 14 1714 4:- ZAMBOANGA. 2 Japs captured in vic of LABASON, arrived DIPOLOG 13 Aug. Have asked unit commander date when these PWs were captured.
- 15 1522 5:- DAVAO. At 1700 hrs, 14 Aug, positions of "C" Co, 130th Regt, and "B" and "D" Co of 111 Prov Bn, was shelled by enemy mortars. Shelling came from W side of slope 500 yards away from position. Enemy mortar shelling was silenced by our arty fire. No friendly casualties.

- 12 2224 1:- BUKIDNON: 1 civ operative killed 1 Jap straggler at INDAHAG vic 20.3-25.0 on 8 Aug. No rifle recovered but 2 grenades were found in his possession. Jap in good health.
- 12 1734 2:- DAVAO: Elms of 111 Prov Bn reached vic 32.9-78.6 against slight enemy resistance. "C" Co, 130th Inf, met enemy fire at vic 33.2-76.0. "B" Co, 111 Bn, reached position at vic 34.2-77.4. 1 enemy map captured.
- 13 1804 3:- AGUSAN: Ptl engaged unest nr of Japs in vic 48.4-98.6 on 11 Aug. Other ptl located est 50 Japs dug in vic 48.5-99.7. Perimeter at 54.7-95.0 received enemy fire at 1630 hrs, 12 Aug. Gun was fired fm vic 55.1-91.8. Ptl on 12 Aug reached vic 55.0-92.3 along trail N bank of river. Large enemy concentration reported in vic 55.0-92.6. Fm this vic along N bank to 57.7-92.7, ptl observed indication of enemy activity. 3 Japs seen crossing river fm N bank to S bank, STO TOMAS vic.
- 13 2230 4:- BUKIDNON: Elms of 1st Bn, 112 Inf, encountered unest nr of Japs at IGLODSAD at 0700 hrs, 12 Aug, and killed 3 Japs, 2 of whom were identified as officers. Civ operatives again reports presence of unest nr of Japs in KABURAKAHAN vic 96.5-97.5 and MANIKAAH vic 96.0-96.0. Report also states that since July, 2 civs were killed by these Japs in these areas.
- 14 1600 5:- DAVAO: Est 2 squads of Japs raided position of Hq & Hq and Serv Co and "D" Co, 130 Regt. Fight lasted for 8 hrs when enemy withdrew. No friendly casualty.

- 11 2300 1:- BUKIDINOH. Gifs killed 1 Jap straggler at E of MAILAG, vic 80.9-65.2 on 8 Aug.
- 11 2130 2:- AGUSAN. Elms of 110 Exp Bn reports ptl contacted est 20 Japs at 51.3-97.0. 9 Japs KIA and 1 dead found. 1 IMG, 2 rifles, ammo and documents captured. Ptl to COMOTA via 50.2-91.9 reports to have seen no signs of Japs.  
Elms of 113 Exp Bn captured ridge at 55.3-93.0. 6 Japs KIA.  
Elms of 112 Bn received hvz mortar, MG and rifle fire fm strong enemy position at 53.8-92.1. Ptl of same Bn killed 1 Jap at vic 51.3-91.5.  
Ptl to vic 50.7-92.7 (VIOLANTA area) killed 1 Jap and another ptl contacted unest nr of Japs in vic 57.5-93.2 and killed 3.
- 12 0800 3:- ZAMBOANGA. Late reports. 1st Bn, 115 Inf killed 38 Japs in 15 encounters fm 13 June to 30 June. Japs were killed in 1st Bn area. 2nd Bn accounted for 8 Japs KIA for same period.  
It has been reported that unest nr of Japs in LIGATUNAN, between TUPILAG and TUNGUNAN, is under Col INKEDA, believed to be a Marine unit.
- 12 0825 4:- DAVAO. At 1400 hrs, 11 Aug, elms of 111 Prov Bn captured a double barrel 25 MM gun with 30 cases of ammo. Another gun of undetermined caliber was blasted by the enemy in tunnel at vic 33.3-76.3. Japs are retreating W. 2 Japs were killed and 1 Jap rifle captured at vic 32.9-79.3.
- 12 0830 5:- DAVAO. At 1040 hrs, 12 Aug, elms of 111 Prov Bn and 130th Regt reported Japs withdrawing towards W. They captured 1 enemy tunnel in vic 33.3-76.2. Our men blasted mines in tunnels, and continued their advance up the hill. At 1300 hrs, trps reached vic 33.7-79.1. Trps by-passed more than 20 enemy pillboxes and tunnels in vic 35.3-76.2. A tunnel with 2 75mm guns was captured and occupied by our men in vic 33.7-76.8.

TIME ITEM

2055 1:- AGUSAN. Artillery pilot reports 1 Jap killed at vic 50.8-92.2 by artillery fire on 9 Aug. 1 dead Jap seen in river at 51.2-92.4. Elms of 113 Inf attacked hill position defended by 35 Japs in vic 54.8-93.0. Hill captured and 3 Japs KIA.  
110 Exp Bn captured 1 Jap on 10 Aug in vic HALAPITAN. PW's name is Pvt ICHIMIRA MITSUAKI. He is fm the 11th Co, 41st Inf, in fair shape, but has low mentality. Cannot remember dates or places. States that his company, with Naval elms, were last to leave SURIGAO. Had LMGs with 13600 rds each, 3 Knee Mortars and rifles with 120 rds each. Naval men had 1 LMG and rifles. Due to illness he fell out 4 days ago fm his unit at a place he does not know. He wandered down river until captured at HALAPITAN vic. When he left his unit there were approx 60 men under Co Comdr 1st Lt SHERODA. Naval elms had only 25 men under Lt-Comdr NUMATA. 3rd platoon is under 1st Lt KISAKI with 34 men; had reached WALOE vic. His platoon leader told him that Gen MOROZUMI is at WALOE vic trying to get to the coast.

Elms of 112 Prov Bn captured high ground vic 53.7-94.4 which was occupied by est 50 Japs. Patrol killed 6 Japs and found 3 dead Japs at vic 50.3-92.9.

10 2335 2:- BUKIDNON. Elms of 112 Regt killed 1 Jap, 1 mile N of HANNAM. Another ptl, 2 miles S of HANNAM reported unest Nr of Japs this area who ran away before our men got close. No encounter made but our men burned some Jap shacks this area on 9 Aug.  
Civ reports that unest Nr of Japs seen at HALAN-SAGING vic 76.7-75.7 on 9 Aug.

0 1900 3:- DAYAC. Elms of 130th Inf on way to get supplies fm 1st Bn CP, were ambushed by enemy.  
Elms of 111 Prov Bn reached vic 34.0-76.5 approaching enemy pillboxes. Other elms are now at 34.2-76.5. Advance slow due to ravines and hills.  
Elms of "A", "C", and "D" Cos, 111 Prov Bn, encountered enemy near tunnel 300 yds fm vic 34.0-76.5 at 1145 hrs, 10 Aug. 1 Jap killed. "B" and "G" Co, 130th Regt received enemy automatic weapon and heavy MG fires 300 yds ahead of their position at vic 34.2-76.5.

09 2038 1:- BUNIDON. Elements of 111th Inf, encountered unest number of Japs, 1 mile NE of MANGAN on 9 August. 2 Japs killed and some equipment captured. Ptl also burned 2 Jap barracks in area.

Elements 112 Inf killed 1 Jap sniper near LALIGAN (SS.O-54.0) on 8 August.

09 2230 2:- AGUSAN. VIOLANTA area. Our ptl from LA BAZ, reached SS.O-92.9 on 8 August. No signs of enemy observed on N bank of UMAYAN RIVER. On S bank, 8 Japs were seen on vic SS.O-92.2.

On 8 August, ptl contacted est 5 Japs, vic 47.5-97.8. 1 Jap killed and 1 knee mortar taken. Another ptl found 7 dead Japs at different points along MALAPTAN-COMOTA trail.

In a drive towards STO TOMAS, elements of 113th Regt encountered heavy machine gun and sniper fire from est 50 Japs dug in at vic SS.7-92.4. 1 Jap KIA.

09 2300 3:- 111 Prov Bn resumed operations against Jap hill positions. Units reached vic SS.6-79.3 at 1500 hrs. Other units reached vic SS.2-76.0.

10 0921 4:- AGUSAN. Gen MOROZUMI now reported at STO TOMAS. His troops are to assemble and then proceed to LIANGA. Probable route will be through NUEVO GRACIA, VERDELA and then the E coast.

08 2103 1:- BUKIDNON. Armed civs saw 10 Japs at KABONSAWAN vic 71.2-88.9 at 1400 hrs, 7 Aug. Japs dispersed to thick brush when fired upon. Footprints indicate that Japs fled towards BAROBO CREEK, vic 71.8-80.4. Jap equipment captured.

Civ operatives engaged 5 Japs at KALATUNGHAN, vic 71.1-88.9 at 1300 hrs, 7 Aug. 3 Japs KIA. Rest fled to wooded area. 1 Jap rifle and some equipment captured.

Civ states that unest nr of Japs were seen at BULOG vic 33.8-97.8, 1:250,000, on 7 Aug. Same info states that 1000 kilos of cinchona bark were stolen fm bodegas; it is believed Japs in the area took these.

06 2345 2:- AGUSAN. Ptl received MG and rifle fire fm 50 Japs dug on ridge, 53.8-92.4. Ptl found 12 dead Japs and killed 3 in vic 50.7-91.5. 10 Japs were seen at 98.9-50.0 by patrol of 112 Prov Bn. Japs fled upon seeing our ptl.

Late report. 2 dead Japs found were found in June in AGUSAN and ADGAWAN RIVERS. This not previously reported.

PW, Pfc SENJI YAMASAKI, captured on 7 Aug at WALOE were dogtag showing that he belongs to 12021 of 50th Div Hq Troops. PW was with party of 40 men including their CO, Capt MAEKATA, which left MANAGOK area in later part of May with the personal effects of Gen MOROZUMI who left ahead. Party took rafts E of PAGATPATAN but lost their things in waterfall between WALOE and PAGATPATAN. Their party broke up into small groups on 3 Aug. PW states that Gen MOROZUMI is in STO TOMAS vic. Div personnel were ordered to assemble there and then will proceed to LIANGA, SURIGAO. PW met 10 men of TAKAGI unit at vic 50.2-91.2. He states that from BUKIDNON to WALOE between 400 and 500 dead Japs were seen by him. On 27 July he saw est 80 Japs of the 74th Inf, 2 kms N of PAGATPATAN. His party was last to leave BUKIDNON. Behind them were troops to fight delaying action.

08 2355 3:- AGUSAN. Diary taken fm Jap killed in WALOE on 7 Aug reveals that ptl fm Gen MOROZUMI contacted elms of TAKAGI unit (AGUSAN-SURIGAO) on 21 July. Ptl reached MOROZUMI's Hq on 24 July. Paybook taken in WALOE identifies the 4th Field Hospital, 30th Div.

- 07 1440 1:- DAVAO. Recon ptl from MADAUN towards KINKING, returned with info that unest number of Japs are now at KINKING, 73.9- 66.2 PANTUKAN Sheet. This is 4 kms E of KINKING along the road.
- 07 1540 2:- DAVAO. Co 'I', 130th Regt at KILAGONG (45.9-94.0, NORTH DAVAO GULF Sheet 12, 1:250,000) reports that est 1000 Japs are at MANSALIMAO (42.3-94.5), MACUTON (41.7-95.6) and KAPALONG (42.7-94.4). Japs have mortars, machine guns, rifles and rifle grenades. One squad of Co 'I' now reached MANSALIMAO on ambushing mission.
