5. This office therefore authorizes any, Teniente del Barrio, President of Natiorhood Association of any barrios, within your areas to apprehend or report said unauthorized collectors to this Hq. at any time up until inclosed order be revoked;

4. Any Officer or soldier arrested for disregardance of this order, shall be properly punished by his direct Commander;

5. In commection to this all outside organization soliditing aid from the civilians within your areas such as the lith and lith Inf. of USAFIP NL, are soldiers of another command, but are flighting for the same cause as soldiers of this command; there are hereby suthorized to collect footstuffs within this platrick with the signature of the Area Commander only;

6.And in the meantime you will continue firmishing this Hq. foodstuffs especially my favorite diet until further order.
