It should be understood that the following units before the activation of the 107th Division was under the administrative administration of this divisions: 130th Inf Regt., 11th Prov. Bn and the 112th Prov Bn. All archives that bear the marks of the 110th Division should be filed under the 110th Div., and those without the mark of the 110th Div prior to the activation of the 107th Div should be filed under the 107th Div. (1st Aug 1944 activation of the 107th Div).

10th MD cont'd -

Sulu Area Command

125th Inf Regt

This regiment was under a separate command from the 10th MD, it gets direct orders from the South West Pacific Area Comd under Gen MacArthur.

2. For your information the "A" Corps, WM was activated as an organization under the 10th MD, USMIP. Due to enemy actions in western Mindanao during the closing year of 1943 Colonel Fertig, the District Comdr transferred his comd to the 110th Div., province of Agusan. The activation of the A Corps was to assure continuous close supervision over four Divisions in WM. They were the following: 105th Div, 106th Div, 108th Div and the 109th Div. After the enemy operation lulled in that area, Col Fertig established again his headquarters somewhere around Dansalan, Lanao, thereby terminating the need for the "A" Corps on about April 45.

3. The 10th Military District (Orla) became the 6th Inf Division PA on 10th August 1945. The following were the units of the Philippine Army in Mindanao:

2. All Finance Records should be sorted by divisions only, records bearing units below a division should be classified under the corresponding division in accordance with par 1, above. Records which do not indicate any divisional unit or any unit under any division should show either Hq "A" Corps, Western Mindanao or Hq, 10th MD, USFIP, as the case may be. They should therefore be filed accordingly - - under the headquarters indicated in said records. Records which do not show any organization or unit and those which bear units other than those specified in par 1, above, should be referred to the undersigned for disposition.

EXAMPLES / EXPLANATION:

1. Records bearing 113th Inf, 110th Div, 10th MD USFIP should be filed under 110th Division.
2. Records bearing 114th Inf, only should be filed under 110th Division. (See par 1, above, 114th Regt falls under the 110th Division)
3. Records bearing Hq, "A" Corps, 10th MD USFIP should be filed under Hq, "A" Corps. (It is assumed that these records do not indicate regimental or divisional units. If they do, they should be filed under the correct division).
4. Records bearing Hq, 10th MD, USFIP, without any indication of unit or units lower than said headquarters, should be filed under Hq, 10th MD USFIP.
5. Records bearing no organization, or bearing organizations other than those enumerated in par 1, above, should be referred to the undersigned for disposition.

3. For your information, the "A" Corps, Western Mindanao was activated on 1 Jan 44 by, and as an organization under the 10th MD, USFIP. Due to intense enemy action, Col Wendell W. Fertig, the District Commander, who was then in the area of the 110th Division (Western Mindanao) created aforesaid "A" Corps to assure close supervision over three divisions in Western Mindanao. These were the 105th, the 106th, and the 108th Divisions. After the enemy operations lulled, Col Fertig moved(his) and established his headquarters at Dansalan, Lanao, at which station close supervision over all the divisions under the 10th MD could be had then. On 1 April 45, the "A" Corps was inactivated and the three divisions under the "A" Corps reverted to the direct control of the 10th MD. Only records which pertain to matters directly within the headquarters "A" Corps should be filed under Hq, "A" Corps, therefore.

4. For your further information, the 10th MD USFIP (GRLA) became the 6th Infantry Division PA on 10 August 45, on which date Colonel Charles W. Hedges who succeeded Colonel Fertig as District Commander of the 10th MD assumed command of the activated 6th Infantry Division PA. Orders were subsequently issued by the Hq, 6th Inf Div PA inactivating the guerrilla units under the defunct 10th MD USFIP. Personnel of the inactivated guerrilla divisions soon became members of the Philippine Army regiments which were activated by Headquarters Philippine Army as units under the 6th Inf Div PA, and the 63rd Inf Regt PA. Among the records filed with those of the 10th MD USFIP can be found papers issued by or referring to the 6th Inf Div PA and/or the subordinate units. You are enjoined to sort all 6th Inf Div PA records separate from those emanating or pertaining to the 10th MD, USFIP, (GRLA).

5. Mr. Solite, Miss Garcia, and/or the undersigned should be consulted on any matter relative to above instructions. Folders containing records already sorted in accordance with preceding instructions should be kept by the sorter in his possession for inspection by any of the aforesaid persons. Henceforth, mistakes shall be unreasonable.

Subject: Location of Units under Tenth Military District, USFIP (GRLA)

To : All Employees, "Philippine Army Library," Project "Charley",

1. Ament letter, dated 12 May 1947, subject "Units Comprising Tenth Military District, USFIP (Guerrilla)", following information is published for the guidance of all concerned:

a. 111th & 112th Prov Bns. and 130th Regt

The above units have been classified under the 107th Div, 10th MD USFIP. These units, however, already existed, and were under the control of the 110th Division, 10th MD USFIP before the 107th Division was activated. The early 110th Division occupied part of the province of Misamis Oriental, and the whole of the provinces of Agusan, Surigao and Davao. In 1944, the enemy effected an intensive and extensive operation against the Mindanao guerrilla, with the special purpose of capturing Colonel Fertig and his 10th MD headquarters personnel who were then around the municipality of Talacogon, Agusan. Due to aforesaid enemy operations, the 110th Division headquarters often lost contact with its subordinate units, especially the above units which occupied the southern part of Agusan and the whole of Davao. There was and still is no road connecting Agusan and Davao. Radio communication between the 110th Division headquarters and its subordinate units was nil. Correspondence between and among these headquarters took 15 days at least to reach location of addressee. Thick forest and swamps separate headquarters. The dire need of creating another division consequently brought to existence the 107th Division. Control over the above units was transferred from the 110th Division. The whole province of Davao and the southern portions of Agusan and Surigao fell under the jurisdiction of the newly-created division.

You are therefore directed to file under the 107th Division only those papers pertaining to the above-captioned units, if no indication appears therein that the 110th Division still exercised control over these units. Papers marked "111th Prov Bn, 110th Division," or "112th Prov Bn, 110th Division," or "130th Regt, 110th Division," or in any manner involving the 110th Division with any of the above units should be filed under the 110th Division; otherwise, they should be filed under the 107th Division.

b. 125th Regt

The above unit covered the island of Sulu. This regiment was originally under the 105th Division, 10th MD. However, sometime in the early part of 1944, due to difficulties involving transportation and communication between Sulu and Mindanao, Sulu became known as the "Sulu Area Command". This command was distinct and separate from the 10th MD USFIP; it received direct orders from the southwest Pacific Area (Gen MacArthur's Australia headquarters).

Cont'd

Unless a 125th Regt record specifies that the regiment was under the 105th Division during its date of issue, such record should be filed under the "Sulu Area Command", otherwise, it should go to the 105th Division file. The "Sulu Area Command" should be treated separately. Its records do not belong to the 10th MD USFIP or any of its subordinate units.

- c. 3d Davao FC, 8th Davao Company FC, 6th Constabulary District, etc.

The 10th MD USFIP never had any of the above-captioned units under it. In fact, there never was a unit designation under the 10th MD USFIP which was prefixed or followed by "FC". "USFIP" (United States Forces in the Philippines) was generally used in the 10th MD USFIP.

Close scrutiny of papers indicating above-captioned units convinced the undersigned that they - and all the other FC units in Mindanao after 16 September 42 - were Japanese entities. Two examples of pertinent records found in the Library are hereunder printed:

(2) A general voucher dated August 31, 1944 reads: "To reimbursement for the payment in sending official telegram to the District Commander, FC, 6th Constabulary District, Davao City as shown below: Receipt of Telegram Charge - - ₱20.10". This voucher was signed by Major Ramon E. Aguirre, FC, Senior Inspector, Butuan, Agusan. Typed in the same voucher is the unsigned name of G. B. Francisco, Chief, Philippine Constabulary. The undersigned personally knew Aguirre who was rounded up by the units of the 110th Division in Agusan province after the guerrilla attacked the Japanese garrison at Butuan. He was caught with people believed to be rabid collaborators.

All concerned are enjoined to file above papers and everything similar thereto in folders marked "Japanese Entity". Mr. Solite shall return same to the Philippine Army Library, Bldg #65.

d. 5th Replacement Bn PA, 7th Ordnance Bomb Disposal Squad
PA, 34th Finance Disbursing Section PA

All the above units were Philippine ARMY units. They never were under the control of the 10th MD USFIP (guerrilla) The 6th Infantry Division PA succeeded the defunct 10th MD USFIP. The above units were in Mindanao, the area of the 6th Infantry Division. Although they were at one time or another attached to the 6th Infantry Division PA, yet they were units separate and distinct from the 6th Infantry Division. Their correspondence and reports were addressed to Headquarters Philippine Army from which they received direct orders.

Separate folders for each of the above units should be had. Papers pertaining to these units should not be filed with those of the 10th MD USFIP or the 6th Infantry Division PA. They should be treated individually and separately.

2. Questions have arisen regarding the classification of records which do not indicate units of origin. Following shall be done:

a. Many records indicate station location. Pasted on the bulletin board is a map indicating units under the 10th MD USFIP and their respective locations for your guidance. The divisions and/or separate regiments occupied the following provinces:

105th Division - Misamis Occidental and northern Zamboanga
106th Division - Cotabato
107th Division - Davao
108th Division - Lanao
109th Division - Western half of Misamis Oriental and whole of Bukidnon
110th Division - Eastern half of Misamis Oriental and Agusan and Surigao. (From 1943 to the middle part of 1944, Davao was under its jurisdiction)
121st Regt - - Southern Zamboanga
125th Regt - - Sulu Archipelago

6th Infantry Division PA - Alae, Misamis Oriental
61st Inf Regt PA - Pasonanca, Zamboanga
62nd Inf Regt PA - Maitum, Misamis Oriental
63rd Inf Regt PA - Maitum, Misamis Oriental
1st Bn, 61st Inf Regt - Alae, Misamis Oriental

(NOTE: Alae and Maitum are technically within the province of Misamis Oriental. However, these locations are so near the Misamis Or-Bukidnon boundary that commanders were often mistaken; you will find papers with the following station locations as "Alae, Bukidnon" and "Maitum".

b. If you cannot still classify records with the above station locations as your guide for some other reasons, refer these records to the undersigned for disposition. Ask questions pertaining to any matter you are not sure of.

3. The above instructions were issued without the intention of rescinding or revoking any previous instruction issued by any entity. The undersigned has no authority to do so. Instructions and the information covered herein have been based on the personal knowledge of the undersigned whose various designations with the Hq 10th MD USFIP and the 6th Inf Div PA make him feel quite competent in making the preceding statements. It is regretted that no sufficient evidence could be presented at this time of writing to support these statements. Necessary orders and correspondence have not as yet been found among the files in the Philippine Army Library.
