

AFFIDAVIT

BEFORE ME, personally appeared S/Sgt William H. Brooks, 19048351, Who being duly sworn deposes and says:

"In December 1941, while General Wainwright and his Staff were at Bacolor, I believe Consuelo M. De Pineda's house was near the place we stayed. These people were very kind to us and they fed and lodged our men. They owned a black sedan but of what year or model I do not know. I do know that no soldier in our party commandeered this car. A Christphor De Pineda, his wife, mother and father were living in the house and the father was an invalid.

I had no reason to take his car because in the evacuation of fort Stotsenburg, I commandeered a 1941 Plymouth Coupe belonging to a 1st Lt. in the 26th Cav. In addition, these people, if they answer the description that I have given above, deserve all legitimate items they can obtain because they were a great help to us.

I was with a Lt. Col. C. A. Thorp after the fall of Bataan ard while we were working with the guerillas we contacted another Pineda family in Bacolor and Lt. Col. Thorp signed approximately 1500 pesos in chits to the for use in the field and purchase of food and clothing and as payment for other revices rendered by the Filipinos.

In regards to anyone putting in a claim for this or any other of Lt. Col. Thorps debts, I would appreciate it if I could be of help. The colonel and I were together until our capture and I know all the business con acts he made and I can also verify his signature if you would care to have me de it."




