I am forwarding to you a list of the former U.S. A. Q.M. Guards or Watchmen in the Port Area, Manila, and other posts in and out of the City, also of twenty Gas Station Guards. This is a true and official list as given me by Mr. Sullivan, Chief Clerk, Q.M.C. on or about Dec. 23-1941.

You will notice that the Gasoline Guards were issued firearms, which they signed for and which were probably taken from them by the Japs. When the Japs entered Manila, the men on duty were actually prisoners on their post. As I had been given instructions by Col. Brejine C. Q.M. to carry on when the Army went to Batuan.

One sheet with the names of some more men was lost, but I could identify any and all the men under me.

You will note the dates and salaries the men were hired at.

I am forwarding to you a list of the former U.S.A. Q.M. Guards or Watchmen in the Port Area, Manila, and other posts in and out of the City, also of twenty Gas Station Guards. This is a true and official list as given me by Mr. Sullivan, Chief Clerk, Q.M.C. on or about Dec. 23, 1941.

You will notice that the Gasoline Guards were issued firearms, which they signed for and which were probably taken from them by the Japs. When the Japs entered Manila the men on duty were actually prisoners on their post. As I had been given instructions by Col. Bresince C.Q.M. to carry on when the Army went to Bataan.

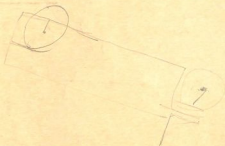
