

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and additional chew in the near future-Dec 18th Jap plane circled overhead last night-dysentery patients were fed eggs and tomatoes this morning-men 20 f at poker-Jap general inspected everywhere but Hosp.-paid gallup 56 f poker work hosp-Jap General orders hosp, be divided into a seriously ill section and general patient section-entire guard and 73 men from work barracks to be sent back to main camp-3 utilities officers (Drabtree, Bob & Jack Sherk) are relieved-quantities of Red Cross food starts coming into camp-Jap hq's promise us a good Xmas dinner-loose 3 games volleyball (clinic)-a little commissary dribbles in-Dec 20th Tom, Bob & Jack move out-settle power debts-start getting new utilities details set up-win 4 f at rummy-all sick men are moved into hosp-all men in main camp are on duty status-planes fly over last night-Japs inaugurate west farm program-play chess-starve getting rice bran for breakfast-sing Christmas carols - Dec 21st lat day of winter-very hot-commissary dribbles in-loose three games volleyball-loose 2 games Acroy- Dusoy-personally wreck kitchen to salvage lumber - loose 40 f at poker-work on detail set up-Japs run out of gasoline-bring ration etc. 6 kilometers from Gabanutan by caribou cart - Dec 22nd more commissary comes Inget haircut and shave-loose 50 f at poker-delicious show for supper-sing Christmas carols - 800 man detail goes out 6 kilometers to carry in wood because of gasoline shortage - Dec 23rd 800 man wood detail goes out again-continues hauling show by truck and carton cart into camp from Gabanutan-bring 1800 Christmas packages into hosp. Are-another "zero" day-have bad cramp/constestinal track must be in bad shape-take 10 man detail and a Jap guard of 5 men and go to old camp #2 for lumber (got a truckload of good tongue and Greycat)-this is the first time Alt had been away from camp since June 25th-the ride, sightseeing, etc. was most delightful-much clothing (hats, shirts, drawer) brought over to hosp-this food and clothing is Red Cross stuff which was originally destined for British prisoners of war-sing Christmas Carols and look forward to the big day-Dec 24th work hosp-continue bringing in food from Red Cross-it sure looks good-get three tomatoes from Giesske-loose 2 f at poker-let utilities off early-give permanent details cigars & cigarettes-a real feeling of Christmas is evident in camp-sing carols until late-my teeth ache so much as to keep me aware-catholics have midnight mass-Dec 25th get up at 5:00-go to early morning service (the candle libras utilities made were very effective)-had coco and pears for breakfast (Yum Yum)-lost 60 f at poker-got Red Cross package which contained candy, chocolate, tea, sugar, biscuits, margarine, bacon, cheese, deviled meat, Jam pudding, orange marmalade, steak & vegetables, tomatoes, rice pudding, vegetable can, and other canned foods-packages contained 15-17 articles and were not identical but were similar-this was the most appreciated Christmas package I have ever received-meals are good (canned beef, candy, greens, eggs, mongo beans, caribou, mutton)-feast and family played duplicate tournament bridge for the 1st time (not so good)-patients in hosp. were issued tobacco-I now have plenty of smoking-bull session and to bed-Dec 26th work hosp-everything goes wrong-the whole day exemplifies the gross inefficiency, lack of discipline, and general worthlessness of a large % of the present personnel (Corpo men stealing-officers counter orders & rackets)-practice volleyball-chas good but alzil-have bull session after chas (major Heinrich is most pleasant, warrant officer Michaelson (Him) most Vulgar-this camp has, without a doubt, the filthiest language I have ever encountered-Dec 27th get of late as it is Sunday-one of our chickens gets loose and we have a big time catching same-beautiful morning - kill three chickens for a special dinner with tomatoes gravy, apple pudding, milk & coffee of our own grain besides plenty of

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good issue chow-felt bad last night-won 5 \$ at poker - loose more men from utilities gang - Dec 28th have steel test in a.m. which tested okay-some relief-chow continues excellent-BG cooks up a delicious omelette buy 4 cans milk at 1.50 f ea. - win at Acey-Deucy-win 1st poker-work hoep-to laundry-fix me a pillow & mattress from excellier in Christmas packages - Dec 29th an idea of the food stock BG & all have on hand-orange, tangerines, pomelos papaya, coconuts, mangos, peanuts, condensed milk, evaporated milk, liver paste & about 50 other assorted cans smoking for at least 6 weeks- a month ago we were broke & eating rice & work hoep - win at Acey Deucy - win at poker - have hoep, show - Dec 30th work hoep-win at poker- get issued flannel pajamas (red form fitting pants and a blue shirt-they are night-order (three Japs) of gins-American and canadian red cross packages start coming into camp - couch, northby and I uncrated 1600 1600 packages for the Hoep, in less than an hour last night BG cooked us up a mess of mang beans and sausages with onions and peppers added which made a good dish but it also was hot-reminded me of the list and the boy who used the crests to keep from setting the woods on fire-continues to think up plans for our matrimonial venture - Dec 31st 3 dead today which made a total of 152 for Dec. (# of No. in Nov.)-bad teeth examined- 6 cavities-had the filled-work suspended up with 5/5 of Gia so the whole crowd of us sat around and drank it with orange juice, tea, or pineapple juice-we also had cheese, devilled meat, biscuits and butter-the Americans really celebrated making more noise than the Nips-Jan 1st don't feel so well in a.m.-ate native sausage & plum pudding for dinner-feel much worse in p.m.-eat no supper-go to bed with fever-Jan 2nd very sick-dent eat-taste rutab 104-105-best trots-chills-feel most miserable physically and mentally-start taking quinine-Jan 3rd have taken 40 gr. quinine in past 18 hrs. so feel all dope up and can't bear-no food-read a little-Jan 4th feel a little better-drink a little milk-"Boo" says it's malaria I say its "arrhen some as "illid-no stain so can't take smear-red nose-Jan 5th eat fruit, milk, eggs and feel better get a pack of camels from Red Cross cut an off tobacco Jan 5th okay but very weak and am jouniced-the recovery periods are long out here-read-play and win at poker-Jan 6th eat like a horse-win at poker (119th)-will go back to work tomorrow-as rumors since chow is so good-have decided no more smoking - Jan 7th Work hoep-eat heaps of everything but rice-haven't eaten rice this year yet! am back to normal-Jan 8th feel fine (still weak)-get shave-work hoep-play valley ball (win 2 of 3)-Jan 9th very windy-finish reading "The good companions and start" study Longman's most howick and damned tired of being a P.W.-news has been scarce lately-Jan 10th feel fair tal ked into pitching softball for hoep, we loose-and playing didn't help my physically after my fever cook up a good omelette with my quan win 125 f at poker-am big winner in the card game now-an very, very restless hoping for something to happen-Jan 11th, made myself an omelette of tomatoes, onions & eggs for BR, about 7:30 a.m. we saw several flights of planes, about 20 total, flying to the north and west where they broke formation and started circling and diving-shortly quite a few bomb explosions were heard-the show lasted about 1/2 an hour-my guess is guerrillas however all sorts of rumors are flying around-tho Jap guards are training intensively again-finishing reading "studs Longman"-got a book! Am still way in the dumps - lose rumy to 20 - sit up late talking and drinking tea-Jan, 12th work hoep-issued fine wool "Cardigan" which came from British Red Cross-heavy winds all day-my red & blue wool pajama's feel mighty good-had a fine snow from main camp full of cracks about Batam and Corregidor-Jan 13th still very windy-feel tired and lousy so stay in bed most all day-slept all after noon which is most

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unusual-as very, very horny\* lately and do a lot of reminiscence on gals of the past-but rumors have made us all pessimistic about getting out in the next year-Jan 14th still windy-still sleepy & Dopey-the vast farm program is still in progress with the hosp now furnishing 130 patients for work daily-even at "Farmer" Jones when the silly; laughing at "Farmer" Jones when he passes-big fire towards Cabenstum last night - Japs mount machine guns on tracks going for rations-report says Jay Capt's house was set on fire-fire was spread by wind and half of Cabenstum turned down-J's left Cab' on train for Manila-rumor from Cab says planes were after Guerrilla's and that they levelled several barrios-lose 10 f at rumy to 50-eat prunes from R.O. package-sho's are good-Jan 15th do complete laundry-boil all my clothes then rinse thoroughly-were the 6pm-trim the Japs issued as for the 1st time-my shoes are going to pieces-have nailed heels on at least 4 times and have made other repair's but they won't last much longer-ordered complete uniform from Manila including 2 Pcs shoes-the money to be taken from postal savings if the Japs approve-let's pray they approve-have already given 50 f to the Welfare Fund from my postal-savings-play chess and get a soldier to start carrying me a good set-win rumy from BG Jan 16th 45 man detail (auto mech) & 2 corps men & 1rd go out in an-gec shave-Cel. Guy gives me a new deck of cards-win 22 f at poker - swap decks of our baby's-are issued one pack of Amer. Cig (camels); BG gives me his (Bellagio)-wind dice cut-Jan 17th-check tools-play poker all day-win 267 pesos the most I've ever won in one sitting-had mangoes for dessert at lunch (delicious)-sat up late on a general bull session-Jan 18th 4 dive bombers came over early and staged another bombing raid on an area about 15 km's NE of camp-another 100 man detail went out-a flight of 9 medium bombers flew south-2 truckloads of Japs left camp with all of their equipment-lost 2 out of 3 volley ball games making our f 300 in the league-bought a 100 f check from Hornbostel for 20 f cash-Jan 19th got a shave-feel lousy-very cold last night-won 15 f from BG at rumy-play volley ball against an all-star team from group I and beat them 3 straight games-have amateur show which was fair-the orchestra from the main camp was over and furnished good music they now have 2 guitars, 1 organ, 2 trumpets, 1 clarinet, traps, and a leader - Jan 20th get up late and miss breakfast so fry myself 2 eggs-buy 1 pack cansel from couch for 5 pesos on the poker sheet-start new book inspection-soldier man 15 shot-Filippines confined (male & female)-camp attitude apathetic.-the dead pass our baby everyday (average is 10/day now) (when Alh took out burial detail it was 38)-Nov 22nd Tom Grabtree's birthday-lose 10 f at Asay Dopey and 70 f at poker-we celebrate thanksgiving by having the best dinner Alh has ever enjoyed-7 of us cooperated and had tomatoe cocktail-3 fried chickens (we had fattened them on rice for a month)-chicken milk gravy-steamed rice-boston baked beans-river greens-type C coffee with milk and sugar-coconut wine and smokes-not a small After wards we eat and talked of golf-schools-travels (everyone in the crowd had seen enough so that practically the entire world could be discussed)-noted personalities-and the folks back home-by far the most pleasant day Alh has spent in the P.I.-Nov 23rd-work hosp-organise volley ball teams-laundry-patch old shirt and convert into short jacket-cut long pants down to shorts-J's issue us 1 pr. socks (without heel)-Nov guard barracks committed suicide by hanging himself-man in ward 20 was killed when he fell from bed level to floor (2 ft-struck head)-worked hosp-finished jacket-feel better-Nov 25th Barney Clark died last night-worked hosp-beautiful sunrises and sunsets-win softball game 2-1 in a tight personal prop-either army or Jap issue-stealing from sick

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patients is so prevalent that no one going to the Hosp. takes valuables - a Dr's statement - "Med. officers first-corps men next-then patients-then anyone else"-I love the Med. Corps!!!

Nov 14th Fri-Not a day! No men for work-Major Durand says he's moving in as Provost Marshall-he leaves then Lt Col McKee arrives says he's taking over as Pro Marshall-wants an office-orderly etc.-we argue-he is going to make arrangements tomorrow-Goody bahay-Nov 14th Col McKee sees Col.
