1. BENJAMIN DAGWAY - BG Residing at Bambang, Nueva Vizcaya.  
a. Active leading Enemy patrols in Guerrilla hideout, Captured Capt. Brulio D. Duliso 14th Inf. in Salinas.  
b. Responsible to the death of Pablo Menduza and Ramon Escola shot at Municipal Plaza on March 27, 1942.
2. MARTIN BUTAS - Japs Agent of Japs, Solano, N. Vizcaya.  
a. Instrumental in the killing of José Méndez Nov. 1944 and maltreated several civilians in Solano, NV.
3. MARTIN MAGABADBAG - Japs MP of Solano, Nueva Vizcaya.  
a. Notorious apprehending, maltreatment and killing civilians connivance to the Usafte in Bayombong, Solano, Udyacan and other places leading Patrols. (at large)
4. TANGAN - Japs MP, Lantap, Bagabag, Nueva Vizcaya.  
a. Responsible in the massacre of civilians in Lantap Bagabag, NV, the families of Asuncion Ricille Oct. 1944. Tangan is now seeking refuge in Tuguegarao, Cagayan.
5. Manolo Jimenez - BG residence of Bayombong, Nva. Vizcaya.  
a. Abducted the enemy torturing several civilians assisting Guerrillas. He suspect Crisante Basco on May 1944 in Bayombong.
6. FRANCESCO GANADO - BG of Bayombong, N. Vizcaya res. of Solano.  
a. Collapsed with the Japanese Army led the Patrol to Ablang which cause the killing of Sgt. E. Reyes family and Sgt. Alipio Baranda and maltreated Flora Barata of Solano, 1945.
7. BIBING CERUZ - BG, Residence of Solano, NV.  
a. Active excruciating civilians aiding Guerrillas and leading Patrols Places suspected hideout of Usafte.
8. FRANCISCO BILUANUEVA - Informer of Solano, N. Vizcaya.  
a. Instrumental in the maltreatment of Sergio Peralta with others civilians and the killing of Mendez.

SUBJECT: BLACKLIST OF PRO-JAPS and SPIES of Nueva Vizcaya

TO : THE COMMANDING OFFICER  
32nd CIC Detachment  
Air # 32.

1. DEMETRIO QUIRINO- Provincial Governor of Nueva Vizcaya, Commonwealth and Japanese Government.
  - a. Collaborated fully with the enemy since the occupation of Nueva Vizcaya by the Japanese in 1942.
  - b. Strict compliance, executing Japanese Administration orders, sending spies, Bureau of Constabulary and Japanese patrols to Guerrilla or USAFIP hide-outs, and places where Guerrillas are suspected to be operating.
  - c. He worked for the capture and surrender of Guerrillas or USAFIP and enforced Japanese orders to his people.
  - d. Rigid apprehension and torture of persons suspected of aiding Guerrillas or USAFIP.
  - e. Made Public Speeches urging full cooperation to the enemy and non-return of the United States administration.
  - f. Allowed Japanese, BC, MPs in maltreating and killing persons suspected of conniving with the Guerrillas and USAFIP.
2. LEANDRO U. ROSARIO- Ex Lt. USAFIP and served in the Japanese administration as Captain, Special Civil-Military Detail and Special Agent of the Provincial Governor.
  - a. Full cooperation with Governor Quirino in collaborating with the enemy since he voluntarily surrendered to the Japs in 1942.
  - b. Strong in leading enemy forces with his men, torturing persons suspected and killing several persons conniving with the USAFIP. Followers did much maltreating in 1942, 1943, 1944 and 1945, also raiding Headquarters of the Guerrillas.
  - c. On March 12, 1943, 21 men of Binalian were maltreated by him with his men and killed one Civilian, Basilio Aliaga.
  - d. Made Public statement urging all people to collaborate with the Japanese in eradicating remaining Guerrillas or USAFIP and had no hope for the United States to return to the Islands. He was highly praised by the enemy for his full cooperation.

3. GALITFO BULAY Mayor of Aritao about the month of October 1944 to 1945.  
a. Had been working with the Japanese as Spy in 1942, 1943, 1944 leading enemy patrols to Guerrilla hide-outs.  
b. Reported names of Elia s Baria, Lrimio Fauna of Aritao to the Japanese authorities on November 1944 and others like the Paringit brothers, which cause the death of Baria and Fauna and also the maltreatment of others.  
c. Made Public Speeches emphasizing to the people that the American Forces would never come to the Philippines because the Japanese had prepared defenses in the Islands.
4. VICENTE BIBILA Mayor of Solano, 1942; 1943 in Bayombong and Bagabag.  
a. Strong in attacking the United States Government, concentrating all civilians in towns. Strictly executed the orders of the Japanese and enforced them to the people.  
b. Apprehended persons suspected of consiving with the USAFIL, pointing them to the Japanese Garrison and leading enemy patrols.
5. MATIAS R. de FIRSTA Mayor of Bagabag, 1944, 1945. Resident of Solano.  
a. Fully cooperated with the Japs. He apprehended his people in Bagabag putting them to Garrison especially those suspected of aiding the USAFIL or Guerrillas.  
b. During his term as Mayor, he had been reporting all persons cooperating with the USAFIL to the Japs. He attacked the United States Administration.
6. RILIA MAGALANG Mayor of Bambang in 1943. A pro-Jap, collaborator to the enemy, strictly executed orders of the Japanese enforcing them to his people. Urged his people to collaborate with the Japanese Administration.  
b. He shot his clerk to death on 11 October 1943 and he was apprehended and put in the garrison. In 1945, he was released by Governor Virino and now is working with the Governor.
7. DELFIN PAGDAD Special Agent of the Japanese from Nueva Vizcaya to Nueva Ecija and other Provinces.  
a. Strong in leading the Japanese in all suspected places since the occupation of the Japanese in Nueva Vizcaya in 1942, 1943, 1944 and 1945 and now is driving cars of the Japanese Officials and active in guiding the enemy.
8. H. CAL Japanese Agent from Nueva Vizcaya to the Cagayan Valley and at the same time Policeman residing in Solano and Aritao. Active in leading patrols executing civilians.  
Bataan II Adjunct Sgt. of DC of Bayombong. 230 Case  
a. Active in leading patrols on August 1944 with Captain Moyto in company and captured Lt. Langley with his men in Ilogan, guided by some pro-Japs. Maltreated several civilians, raided the C. of Major Lapuz on 14 August 1944 at Ballocongong, Malacan with the undersigned brought supplies to Lapuz.

- b. Came down to Pangasinan in company with the Japanese, squad of BC. Several persons in San Nicolas, Natividad and other places were tortured and killed.
  - c. He led the patrols to Kayapa Proper, N.V. and maltreated the undersigned severely soaked in water and many others were also tortured on 28, 29 and 30 August 1943. Killed Saket Camoyin in company with Captain Sayto, Garrison Commander of Bayombong, proceeded to Pangasinan and did the same. Guerrillas in Iba pang were garrisoned and tortured.
  - d. Members of BC with Albano, Sgt. Cuturan, Bambo were strong in torturing suspected persons conniving with the USAFIS. With Japs made abuse to our girls.
10. MANGABATI - Sgt. of BC of Bayombong. Former PC surrendered to the enemy.
- a. Special Agent of BC, MP. Strong in Iba pang, enemy patrols, fighting the guerrillas and maltreating persons conniving with the USAFIS. At present with the enemy fighting the United States Forces.
11. HERRERA, CLEMENTIA and BENITO GUYOS, killed Gongcog members of the enemy MP of Nueva Vizcaya in company with the Japs leading enemy patrols, maltreating civilians when Japs occupied this province in 1943 until 1944 and 1945.
12. SERGIO LAURENT - Major of BC, former PA, organized the Bureau of Constabulary in Nueva Vizcaya 1942 to 1943.
- a. Organized 5 companies quartered in different municipalities of Nueva Vizcaya sending out patrols and spies in all places suspected as USAFIS hide-outs.
  - b. Attacked the United States Government in his public statements and also the Guerrilla organizations or USAFIS.
  - c. Transferred to the Illocos Provinces and relieved by Federico H. Santo Tomas, Captain, Provincial Inspector of the BC for N. Vizcaya.
13. FEDERICO H. SANTO TOMAS - Captain BC, Provincial Inspector of Nueva Vizcaya.
- a. Relieved Major Laurent in 1944 to 1945 as BC Inspector of Nueva Vizcaya.
  - b. Fully collaborated with the enemy sending out his men for espionage, patrols fought the Guerrillas or USAFIS together with the Japs.
  - c. 120 BC under F.H. Santo Tomas remained when the enemy disbanded. Some BC are now with the Japs fighting the USAFIS.
  - d. Capt. Santo Tomas has Staff Officers 1st Lt. Ramon A. Alcaraz, 2nd Lt. Severino M. Basa, known conniving with USAFIS garrisoned. Other Staff Officers 1st Lt. Marcelo F. Alvarez, 3rd Lt. Gregorio Vitis, Jose C. Gasparas, Felix Castillo, Donato, T. Vargas, Victor D. Gragasan and Staff Officers, members of BC joined the enemy while others fled and joined the guerrillas.
14. JIBASL - Japanese Nestor of Baguio. Military police with some Filipinos in Bayombong, Nueva Vizcaya.
- a. Bigand had been collaborating with the enemy from Baguio and transferred to Nueva Vizcaya. Active in reporting Guerrillas and torturing civilians.

15. MARIO LUG Mayor of Selano 1942 to 1943 and resident of same municipality.
- Active in sending patrols, spies in places suspected. Apprehended persons aiding USAFIP or Guerrillas and garrisoned them. During his Mayoralship he attacked the United States Government.
16. EMILIO TOLANTING ex-Judge of Bambang, appointed as Mayor of (Tikarte) or Lingkian and Kaya a, December 1942, 1943.
- Strict in the execution of orders of the Puppet Government, enforcing to the inhabitants, concentrating all people residing in out-lying barrios, organized Neighborhood Associations and Districts.
  - Sent SG for espionage, urging civilians to report any USAFIP or Guerrillas hiding and compelled them to surrender to the enemy.
  - In his public statements, he emphasized to the people the non-return of the United States Forces in Philippines, (General Aurora and American officers sent by the United States Govt to urge the remaining USAFIP to surrender to the enemy.
  - Reported the inhabitants of Lingkian, Sampag, Kaysapa and other places as non-cooperative to the Puppet Government, to Governor Mirin due to the influence of Major GAF or Guerrillas. Resigned when Chief of Police Macino Baculuan of Bungal was kidnapped by the Guerrillas.
17. FRANCISCO WHITNEY Mayor of Santa Fe, 1942 to 1943.
- Active in 1943 in sending out Spies, his policemen spying, his volunteers and urged his people to report any remaining USAFIP. Sent out one spy of his volunteers of Lingan, spying Ayapa proper, Lingkian and other places looking for Lt. Nobres.
  - Voluntarily surrendered Sgt. Vicente Budizan and other men under Captain Ousdin in Bayombong Garrison, captured Lt. Langley led by his men on 13 August 1943. Strict in executing orders.
18. ADONIETO SANTILL Chief of Police of Aritao 1942 to 1943.
- Collaborationist to the enemy. Active in sending his policemen in spying the whereabouts of the remaining USAFIP, leading the patrols to the mountains.
  - Apprehended and tortured persons found conniving with the USAFIP.
  - Became SG as Sergeant did the same actions working against the United States Government. Apprehended by the Guerrillas of the 11th Infantry and joined.
19. ENOCIO UGAN Sergeant of Police of Aritao, 1942 to 1943.
- Active in spying and leading patrols to places suspected as hide-outs of USAFIP or Guerrillas, torturing persons aiding the USAFIP, apprehended persons suspected and had them garrisoned.
  - Transferred to Santa Fe as Chief of Police. Did the same actions 1944 and 1945.

20. BANKEO SANTOS: Sub-Governor 1942 to 1943 and Agent of Jairin.  
a. Active in reporting Guerrilla activities or USAFIP to the enemy.  
b. Appointed Mayor of Aritao 1944 urging people to report any remaining USAFIP or Guerrillas to surrender to the Japanese authority. Appointed 2000 Supervisor of the southern municipalities of Nueva Vizcaya.
21. A. MUNIBALD: Policeman of Aritao, 1943 - 1944.  
a. Led patrols of Japanese in all out saying of places suspected. Maltreated innocent civilians.  
b. Sent to the Japanese Garrison Commander of Aritao with 10 companions to Lingkian, Kayapa, proper investigating people of the whereabouts of the remaining USAFIP or Guerrillas on Aug 10, 1944.
22. BASILIO MUNIBALD: Policeman of Aritao, 1943-1944. Approximately 2 yrs old. Son of 1<sup>st</sup> w of Casilli.  
a. Highly praised by the Japanese for actively guiding patrols all over the mountains, Lingkian, Kayapa, Naujan, Paracuan, Ilagan and other places. Maltreated the undersigned and apprehended with Lt. Horimoto, Sgt. Laributan on 1<sup>st</sup> August 1944 and tortured almost all the civilians of Kayapa, Paracuan and other places.
23. MELITO: So, Guide, Resident, of Aritao, approximately 50 yrs old, dark brown, 5'2" height.  
a. Notorious in maltreating civilians, leading the enemy patrols with Capt. Alfonso, a Prison Commander of Southern N. Vizcaya, Lt. Horimoto patrolling Lingkian, Kayapa, Ilagan, Paracuan, Lingkian, Kayapa and other places where they had been torturing several persons especially in Kayapa where he maltreated almost all civilians on Aug. Oct. 1944.
24. RUBEN OMB: Policeman of Aritao 1942, occupation of Nava Vizcaya  
b. 1<sup>st</sup> w  
1. Guided Jap patrols in Lingkian, Paracuan and other places to Langley, October, December 1942. Let all civilians of Lingkian surrender to the enemy and tortured several persons.
25. DINOC PEGALAY: Policeman of Santa Fe, December 1942.  
a. Active in saying the hideouts of USAFIP or Guerrillas, reporting activities of Guerrillas and reporting persons aiding the USAFIP.  
b. Sent saying Lingkian proper, Balingas, and the mountains with 10 Filipino companions by Mayor Francisco Almey with the enemy, December 1942.  
c. Fled from the enemy and joined the outfit of Capt. Larion.
26. JOSUE CIFARAL: Sergeant BC, Bayombong, Nueva Vizcaya, approximately 50 yrs. 17 years as BC.  
a. Guided company of Captain Mayo from Bayombong with one squad of BC with Sgt. Benjamin Albino in Lingkian where they captured Lt. Langley and his men in Lingkian 1943 of August 13th, com Mocodan, San Nicolas, Latiwidal and other places to Vizcaya where they tortured several persons suspected of aiding the USAFIP, killed, abused girls, collected arms possessed by the civilians.

27. CLIMENTIA, Military Police of Bayombong, N. Viscaya 1941 to 1945. (PILIPINAS)  
a. Strict in executing Military Administration orders of Japanese, apprehending persons conniving with the USAFIP or Guerrillas, fighting against the USAFIP and torturing persons aiding the USAFIP, leading Japanese patrols.
28. BENITO GUNGO, Military Police of Bayombong, N. Viscaya 1943 to 1945 with the Japs.  
a. Instrumental in his duty as MP with the Japs, investigating suspected persons, leading enemy patrols, apprehending couriers to the USAFIP, against Guerrilla or USAFIP.
29. DONATO AGUADO, Civilian, acting SS- of enemy in Aritao, N. Viscaya.  
a. Active in reporting guerrilla activities to the enemy, leading enemy patrols to Guerrilla hide-outs in Nueva Viscaya.  
b. Shot by the Guerrilla twice, treated by the enemy, became worst, in Aritao.
30. MARIANO RAFAHANS, Agent of Japs assigned for the Province of Nueva Viscaya 1942 to 1943.  
a. Led enemy patrols, aiding places occupied by the guerrillas reported to the enemy. As reported by Pedro Rodeta or Alias Pedring his companion, appointed Agent of Japs in Nueva Viscaya and other provinces and shot to death by Guerrillas or USAFIP.
31. ANTONIA FERNANDEZ, Chief of Police of Basbar, 1942 to 1945.  
a. Instrumental in the execution of Puppet Government with the enemy, sending out his policemen, patrolling with the enemy and spying guerrilla or USAFIP hide-outs, fully collaborated with the Japanese, killed one person.
32. BAZING, SS of Provincial Governor Alvaro 1942 to 1945. Approximately 35 years old.  
a. Follower of Rosario, notorious in maltreating civilians aiding USAFIP.  
b. Tortured Basilio Allaga of Binalian to death March 12, 1943.
33. DEMETRIO SENG, MP under Rosario stationed at Basbar 1942 to 1945. 23 years old.  
a. Policeman of Basbar, actively leading enemy patrols torturing persons.
34. RUDOLFO SALAZAR, SS of Japs 1942, 1943, 1944.  
a. Active in spying hide-outs of USAFIP or Guerrillas, guiding Jap patrols in Nueva Viscaya, apprehending persons aiding USAFIP.

35. OZON; BG of Barrat, Bambang, 1943 to 1945,  
oldest son.  
a. Active in guiding Jap patrols, investigating people of  
the whereabouts of the Guerrillas or USAFFE hiding.  
b. Guided Captain Gana with his soldiers 1 Bn in Pingidian,  
Pampanga, Leyte proper mopping up all mountains on April  
to May 1944 and in previous years he had been active in  
the eradication of the USAFFE.
36. VELAS JUNR; GSF with Japs, resident of Delano 1943  
to 1945.  
a. Actively collaborating with the enemy, leading patrols in  
all Nueva Viscaya.  
b. Joined Guerrilla "E" Company of 11th Infantry for few days  
and fled resumed his designation as GSF with the enemy and  
on October 16, 1944 assumed Guerrilla activities or USAFFE.
37. TALICIO SAMSON; Bayombong, Nueva Viscaya, Military Police of  
the Japanese in 1942 to 1945.  
a. Notorious, active in torturing persons suspected of condon-  
ing with the USAFFE or Guerrillas, and apprehension with  
the enemy. Led Jap patrols in all-out Nueva Viscaya and  
now fighting against the Allied Forces with the Japs.
38. SISON; Special Agent of Governor Udriño, Bayombong,  
Nueva Viscaya 1942 to 1945.  
a. Active Agent of Udriño and the enemy, reporting Guerrilla  
or USAFFE activities, enforcing "Urdiño government Executive  
Orders to the people, fully collaborated with the enemy against  
the United States Government.

SUBJECT: BLACKLIST OF INFORMERS, SQUEALERS and GUIDES  
of the Enemy in Nueva Visayas.

TO : THE COMMANDING OFFICER  
32nd CIC Detachment  
A/C # 32

1. MATIS GAL-OH: - Farmer, 27 years, of Pampang, Kayapa, Nueva Visayas.  
a. Maltreated by the enemy, squealed to the enemy under Capt. KILITO October, November 1942, that Alus Agabab and Seric Marten with Major Marques, Pampang, Nagtan to Kayapa and Alus. Seriously maltreated by the Japs.  
b. Squealed by the people of Nagtan, Kayapa Proper as conniving with the Guerrillas or USAFIP. 2 Persons, Cayet Spada and Patian Iagus of Pampang guided the two US apprehended civilians of Nagtan, Jose Bognay, Laquias Lab, Nasy Agusting and others severely tortured by the enemy. One shot to death, Dionisio Basiganwan.  
c. He had been guiding enemy patrols.
2. PIERO GUIMBUNDAN: Sgt. Guerrilla under Cushing and Lt. Nobles, resident of Imugan, Nueva Visayas.  
a. Active in guiding men or civilians gathering cables in Lagod Saw Mill as business, selling it to the enemy June, July 1943.  
b. Captured by the enemy in Imugan with Lt. Langley and others. Squealed to the enemy his superior officers, Major Lepham and Lt. Nobles, his companions and civilians or persons aiding USAFIP or Guerrillas, caused the maltreatment and apprehension of persons collaborating with USAFIP.

d. Upon his release from the Jap Garrison, he went back to Pangasinan and was active in scrap iron business, selling it to the enemy.
3. ESTANISLAO PARLINGIT: of Ariteo, Nueva Visayas (Squealer)  
a. Guided the enemy to Guerrilla hide-outs in Bata Ariteo with Dionisio Halario as instructed by him, and enemy raided Bata shot Sgt. Sackey of 11th Infantry, September 17, 1943.

1. DEMETRIO QUIRINO, Provincial Governor of Nueva Viscaya, Commonwealth and Japanese Government.
  - a. Collaborated fully with the enemy since the occupation of Nueva Viscaya by the Japanese in 1942.
  - b. Strict compliance, executing Japanese Administration orders, sending Spies, Bureau of Constabulary and Japanese patrols to Guerrilla or USAFIP hide-outs, and places where Guerrillas are suspected to be operating.
  - c. He worked for the capture and surrender of Guerrillas or USAFIP and enforced Japanese orders to his people.
  - d. Rigid apprehension and torture of persons suspected of aiding Guerrillas or USAFIP.
  - e. Made Public Speeches urging full cooperation to the enemy and non-return of the United States administration.
  - f. Allowed Japanese, BC, MPs in maltreating and killing persons suspected of conniving with the Guerrillas and USAFFE.
2. LEANDRO U. ROGARDO, Ex Lt. USAFIP and served in the Japanese administration as Captain, Special Civil-military Detail and Special Agent of the Provincial Governor.
  - a. Full cooperation with Governor Quirino in collaborating with the enemy since he voluntarily surrendered to the Japs in 1942.
  - b. Strong in leading enemy forces with his men, torturing persons suspected and killing several persons conniving with the USAFIP. Followers did much maltreating in 1942, 1943, 1944 and 1945, also raiding Headquarters of the Guerrillas.
  - c. On March 12, 1943, 21 men of Binlian were maltreated by him with his men and killed one Civilian, Basilio Aliaga.
  - d. Made Public statement urging all people to collaborate with the Japanese in eradicating remaining Guerrillas or USAFIP and had no hope for the United States to return to the Islands. He was highly praised by the enemy for his full cooperation.

3. GALINDO DULAY - Mayor of Aritao about the month of October 1944 to 1945.
- a. Had been working with the Japanese as Spy in 1942, 1943, 1944 leading enemy patrols to Guerrilla hide-outs.
  - b. Reported names of Elia's Barria, Brinio Fathua of Aritao to the Japanese authorities on November 1944 and others like the Paringit brothers, which cause the death of Barria and Fathua and also the maltreatment of others.
  - c. Made Public Speeches emphasizing to the people that the American Forces would never come to the Philippines because the Japanese had prepared defenses in the Islands.
4. VICENTE BUBILA - Mayor of Solano, 1942, 1943 in Bayombong and Bagabag.
- a. Strong in attacking the United States Government, concentrating all civilians in towns. Strictly executed the orders of the Japanese and enforced them to the people.
  - b. Apprehended persons suspected of committing with the USAFIL, ~~returning~~ turning them to the Japanese Garrison and leading enemy patrols.
5. MATANZO B. de FIESTA - Mayor of Bagabag, 1944, 1945. Resident of Solano.
- a. Fully cooperated with the Japs. He apprehended his people in Bagabag putting them to garrison especially those suspected of aiding the USAFIL or Guerrillas.
  - b. During his term in Aritao as Mayor, he had been reporting all persons cooperating with the USAFIL to the Japs. He attacked the United States Administration.
6. RILAN MAGNANTS - Mayor of Bambang in 1943. A pro-Jap, collaborator to the enemy, strictly executed orders of the Japanese enforcing them to his people. Urged his people to collaborate with the Japanese administration.
- b. He shot his clerk to death on 11 October 1943 and he was apprehended and put in the garrison. In 1945, he was released by Governor Shirin and now is working with the Governor.
7. DILIGENZA RAMIREZ - Special Agent of the Japanese from Nueva Vizcaya to Nueva Ecija and other Provinces.
- a. Strong in leading the Japanese in all suspected places since the occupation of the Japanese in Nueva Vizcaya in 1942, 1943, 1944 and 1945 and now is driving cars of the Japanese Officials and active in guiding the enemy.
8. H. CAL - Japanese Agent from Nueva Vizcaya to the Cagayan Valley and at the same time policeman residing in Solano and Aritao. Active in leading patrols executing civilians.
9. BALIBAGH ALBANT - Sgt. of DC of Bayombong. ~~280 Case~~
- a. Active in leading patrols on August 1943 with Captain Mayo in company and captured Lt. Langley with his men in Iungan, guided by some pro-Japs. Maltreated several civilians, raided the C. of Major Lapitan on 14 August 1943 at Balicongong, Alcasas with the undersigned brought supplies to Lapitan.

- b. Came down to Pangasinan in company with the Japanese, squad of BC. Several persons in San Nicolas, Natividad and other places were tortured and killed.
- c. He led the patrols to Kayapa Proper, N.V. and maltreated the undersigned severely soaked in water and many others were also tortured on 28, 29 and 30 August 1945. Killed Maket Camoyin in company with Captain Sayto, Garrison Commander of Bayombong proceeded to Pampan, Hinidian and did the same. Guerrillas in Pampan were garrisoned and tortured.
- d. Members of BC with Albano, Sgt. Gutgran, Santos were strong in torturing suspected persons conniving with the Japs. With Japs made abuses to our girls.
10. MANGABAT - Sgt. of BC of Bayombong. Former IC surrendered to the enemy.
- a. Special Agent of BC, MP. Strong in leading enemy patrols, fighting the guerrillas and maltreating persons conniving with the USAFIL. At present with the enemy fighting the United States Forces.
11. HUMMING, CLIMENTINA and BENITO GUYOS, killed-Compoong members of the enemy MP of Nueva Vizcaya in company with the Japs leading enemy patrols, maltreating civilians when Japs occupied this province in 1943 and 1944 and 1945.
12. SERGIO LAURENT - Major of BC, former PA, organized the Bureau of Constabulary in Nueva Vizcaya 1942 to 1943.
- a. Organized 5 companies quartered in different municipalities of Nueva Vizcaya sending out patrols and spies in all places suspected as USAFIL hide-outs.
- b. Attacked the United States Government in his public statements and also the Guerrilla organizations or USAFIL.
- c. Transferred to the Ilocos Provinces and relieved by Federico R. Santo Tomas, Captain, Provincial Inspector of the BC for N. Vizcaya.
13. FEDERICO R. SAMPO-TOMAS - Captain BC, Provincial Inspector of Nueva Vizcaya.
- a. Relieved Major Laurent in 1944 to 1945 as BC Inspector of Nueva Vizcaya.
- b. Fully collaborated with the enemy sending out his men for espionage. Patrols fought the Guerrillas or USAFIL together with the Japs.
- c. 129 BC under F.R. Santo Tomas remained when the enemy disbanded. Some BC are now with the Japs fighting the USAFIL.
- d. Capt. Santo Tomas has Staff Officers 1st Lt. Ramon A. Alcaraz, 2nd Lt. Severino M. Basa, known conniving with USAFIL garrisoned. Other Staff Officers 1st Lt. Marcelo F. Alvarez, 3rd Lt. Sergio Vitin, Jose C. Gasias, Felix Casullo, Donato, T. Vergas, Victor D. Oraganan and Staff Officers, members of BC joined the enemy while others fled and joined the guerrillas.
14. SIGASAI - Japanese mestizo of Baguio. Military Police with some Filipinos in Bayombong, Nueva Vizcaya.
- a. Sigasai had been collaborating with the enemy from Baguio and transferred to Nueva Vizcaya. Active in reporting Guerrillas and torturing civilians.

15. MARIO LUG M. Mayor of Selano 1942 to 1943 and resident of same municipality.  
 a. Active in sending patrols, spies in places suspected. Apprehended persons aiding USAFIL or Guerrillas and garrisoned them. During his Mayorship he attacked the United States Government.
16. MARIO TOLANTIHL ex-Judge of Bambang, appointed as Mayor of (Alcarts) or Lingkian and Kaya a, December 1942, 1943.  
 a. Strict in the execution of orders of the Puppet Government, enforcing to the inhabitants, concentrating all people residing in out-lying barrios, organized Neighborhood Associations and Districts.  
 b. Sent BG for espionage, urging civilians to report any USAFIL or Guerrillas hiding and compelled them to surrender to the enemy.  
 c. In his public statements, he emphasized to the people the non-return of the United States Forces in Philippines, (General Aungkura and American officers sent by the United States Gov't to urge the remaining USAFIL to surrender to the enemy.  
 d. Reported the inhabitants of Lingkian, Sampang, Kaysa and other places as non-cooperative to the Puppet Government, to Governor Alvarino due to the influence of hiding USAFIL or Guerrillas. Resigned when Chief of Police Maximo Baculuan of Bungal was kidnapped by the Guerrillas.
17. FRANCISCO MINI Y. Mayor of Santa Fe, 1942 to 1945.  
 a. Active in 1943 in sending out Spies, his policemen spying, his volunteers and urged his people to report any remaining USAFIL. Sent out one squad of his volunteers of Iungan, saying Kayapa proper, Lingkian and other places looking for Lt. Nobres.  
 b. Voluntarily surrendered Sgt. Vicente Baldasan and other men under Captain Cushing in Bayombong Garrison, captured Lt. Langley led by his men on 13 August 1943. Strict in executing orders.
18. ADMIRAL SAMAZAL Chief of Police of Aritaao 1942 to 1943.  
 a. Collaborationist to the enemy. Active in sending his policemen in spying the whereabouts of the remaining USAFIL, leading the patrols to the mountains.  
 b. Apprehended and tortured persons found conniving with the USAFIL.  
 c. Became BG as Sergeant did the same actions working against the United States Government. Apprehended by the Guerrillas of the 11th Infantry and joined.
19. EULOGIO LUGAN Sergeant of Police of Aritaao, 1942 to 1943.  
 a. Active in spying and leading patrols to places suspected as hide-outs of USAFIL or Guerrillas, torturing persons aiding the USAFIL, apprehended persons suspected and had them garrisoned.  
 b. Transferred to Santa Fe as Chief of Police. Did the same actions 1944 and 1945.

20. BENITO SANCHEZ: Sub-Governor 1942 to 1943 and Agent of Security Service in reporting Guerrilla activities or USAFIP to the enemy.  
a. Appointed Mayor of Aritao 1941 urging people to report any remaining USAFIP Guerrillas to surrender to the Japanese authority. Appointed HQ U Supervisor of the Southern municipalities of Nueva Vizcaya.
21. A. MURAKAMI: Policeman of Aritao, 1943 - 1944.  
a. Led patrols of Japanese in all out skirts of places suspected. Maltreated innocent civilians.  
b. Sent to the Japanese Garrison Commander of Aritao with a company to Lingdian, Nava, Roger investigating people of the whereabouts of the remaining USAFIP or Guerrillas on Aug 10, 1943.
22. HARUO KAWABE: Policeman of Aritao, 1943-1944. Approximately 7 yrs old, son of Lt. Kawabe, w of Gasshi.  
a. Highly praised by the Japanese for actively cutting roads all over the mountains, Lingdian, Razon, Nagaya, Bontoc, Paracutan, Itogon and other places. Maltreated the unshielded and apprehended with it. Norimoto, Sgt. Marikam on 1st August 1943 and tortured almost all the civilians of Nagaya, Razon and other places.
23. MEI HEI: 16 yrs old, Resident of Arayat, approximately 50 yrs old, dark brown, 5'2" height.  
a. Notorious in maltreating civilians, leading the enemy patrols with Capt. KAMATO, Garrison Commander of Southern N. Vizcaya, Lt. Horimoto patrolling Lingdian, Razon, Bontoc, Itogon, and asinan, Nagaya and other places where they often burnt several persons especially in Nagaya where he maltreated almost all civilians on Aug. 1st. 1943.
24. RUBEN OGARI: Policeman of Aritao 1942, occupation of Nava, Vizcaya  
G. Army.  
1. Guided Jap patrols in Lingdian, Razon and other places to number, October, December 1942. Let all civilians of Lingdian surrender to the enemy and tortured several persons.
25. PINGOS PUGALAY: Policeman of Santa Fe, December 1942.  
a. Active in spying the hideouts of USAFIP or Guerrillas, reporting activities of Guerrillas and reporting persons to the USAFIP.  
b. Sent spying Nagaya report, Bontoc, and the mountains with 1, Filipino companies by Major Francisco Langley with no enemy, December 1942.  
c. Fled from the enemy and joined the outfit of Capt. Norono.
26. JOSÉ CUFARAN: Sergeant BC, Bayombong, Nueva Vizcaya, approximately 50 yrs. 17 years as PC.  
a. Guided company of Captain Jayte from Bayombong with one squad of BC with Sgt. Benjamin Albino in Imugan where they captured Lt. Langley and his men in Imugan 1943 of August 13th, from Mocodan, San Nicolas, Latividal and other places to Vizcaya where they tortured several persons suspected of aiding the USAFIP, killed, abused girls, collected arms possessed by the civilians.

28. BENITO GUINO; Military Police of Bayombong, N. Viscaya 1943 to 1945 with the Japs.  
 a. Instrumental in his duty as MP with the Japs, investigating suspected persons, leading enemy patrols, apprehending couriers to the USAFIP, against Guerrilla or USAFIP.
29. DONATO SINGUMO; Civilian, acting SS of enemy in Aritao, N. Viscaya.  
 a. Active in reporting guerrilla activities to the enemy, leading enemy patrols to Guerrilla hide-outs in Nueva Viscaya.  
 b. Shot by the Guerrilla twice, treated by the enemy, became worst, in Aritao.
30. MARIANO RAFANAH; Agent of Japs assigned for the Province of Nueva Viscaya 1942 to 1943.  
 a. Led enemy patrols, spying places occupied by the guerrillas reported to the enemy. As reported by Pedro Rodita or Alias Pedong his companion, appointed Agent of Japs in Nueva Viscaya and other provinces and shot to death by Guerrillas or USAFIP.
31. ANTONIA FERNANDO; Chief of Police of Bambang, 1942 to 1945.  
 a. Instrumental in the execution of Puppet Government with the enemy, sending out his policemen, patrolling with the enemy and spying guerrilla or USAFIP hide-outs, fully collaborated with the Japanese, killed one person.
32. BAZIO; of Bayombong, SS of Provincial Governor Quidino 1942 to 1945. Approximately 35 years old.

In my last letter I wrote concerning the Japanese coming to Angkor with the Major Tolentino. I implored public attention of the Societies and Presidents secretly not letting the people know my undertaking. I called them for the reason that they believed the proclamations of Major Tolentino advising the people that Americans are already defeated in this war and that no aid will come from America, and they believed on the propaganda of the Japanese, besides those people there are now cooperative to the USA. At first when I called their attention explaining them all the present situation of the War, they were confused, unless they are cooperating, especially in giving provision to the USA. They are now bringing substance for Army use. They had captured one M-16 rifle, one hand grenade and 1200 rounds of bullets and I submitted to the Governor.

During my absence here [2d] Japanese soldiers from Sugui had been patrolling this place since, Iwagiso, Nagoya, Roger, and Iwagiso shore they stayed about two weeks and captured two civilians, Inamura and Sano. This Japs have their advance guard an American man. Rare have (2) Usseas men caught by them. Mr. Rare according to information he concedes the white men staying here. He did not squall, he reported to the Japs that he had seen 2 white men stay outside of this place, reported by them as his. After three stay here few days, they left to Nagasaki on May 2nd. 
