

SPRODUCERS AGREEMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into at Leyte on this 0-th day of Mey A. D., 1940, by and between the Abase producer's Cooperative Association, (NAFCO Braneh No. 6) formed under the laws of the Philippines having its principal place of business at Teolobum, Leyte hereinafter referred to as the ASSOCIATION and Mr. Filmsman Gallette producer of abaca of Bureness at the PRODUCER.

WITNESSETH:

(A) The ASSOCIATION agrees to comply for the benefit of the PRODU-

CER with the following obligations:

(d) Furnish the PRODUCER implements of production and cultivation, goods merchandise and articles of consumption that may be indispensable for the maintenance of the necessary laborers to improve, strip or exploit his abaca plantations. The ASSOCIATION will fix the maximum amount that the PRODUCER may borrow on the basis of his paying capacity.

(2) Establish warehouses where the PRODUCER, may deposit or store his

(3) Advance to the PRODUCER, if he so desires, part of the value of his alacca deposited in the warehouse, provided it does not exceed 60% of its market value and the loans of merchandise, implements of production and california and articles of consumption made to the PRODUCER are properly taken care of by the latter.

(4) Sell by itself or through the NATIONAL ABACA AND OTHER FI-BERS CORPORATION at private or public auction, the abaca deposited in the warehouses of the ASSOCIATION. The latter may reject any offer or bid. The ASSOCIATION may also purchase directly the abaca deposited if it so desires.

(5) Make the necessary arrangement to export the abaca deposited in the warehouses in order to obtain the best possible price, whenever advisable or when the quantity or volume of abaca deposited and the existing circumstances or con-

ditions justify it.

(6) Pay to the PRODUCER as soon as the abaca is disposed of, the proceeds after deducting all sums that may have been advanced in merchandise, goods, articles of consumption or in eash to the PRODUCER, as well as a certain reasonable amount to over the expenses of maintenance and operation of the ASSOCIATION and the creation of a reserve fund for the attainment of its objective as set front in its Articles of Incorporation and By-Laws.

(7) Work for the reduction of freights, thru the adoption of any means or procedure that may best insure the attainment of such objective.

(8) Allow the examination of the books of the ASSOCIATION by any Public Accountant that the PRODUCER may designate at the end of every fiscal year, with the authorization of the Manager.

(9) Post daily in a conspicuous place of the building of the ASSOCIATION and in the warehouse the market quotations for hemp.
