**Division History:**

Division HQ was mobilized on 19 Nov 41 with Lt Col Carter McMenan Cav as acting Comdg Off. On 23 Nov 41, Brig Gen Chynoweth arrived at Iloilo and took command of all forces in Panay and Negros. The mobilization of the 61<sup>st</sup> Div was then not yet complete as there were only 2 Inf Regts and one FA Regt when the war broke out on 8 Dec 41. The 3<sup>rd</sup> Inf Regt was hastily mobilized one rifle Bn of which came from Romblon. One Regt of the 61<sup>st</sup> Inf was sent to Negros as its holding forces. On 26 Dec 41 the 62<sup>nd</sup> Inf and the 61<sup>st</sup> FA were ordered to Mindanao together with the 61<sup>st</sup> in Negros. With the reduction of the forces in Panay and Negros Gen Chanoweth ordered the recruitment of volunteers to replace the units that went to Mindanao. The 61<sup>st</sup> and the 65<sup>th</sup> Infns were organized in Panay and the 73<sup>rd</sup> Inf in Negros. On or about 28 Dec 41, the forces remaining in Panay and Negros were ordered to prepare for an indefinite guerrilla resistance. Since then all preparations were centered in hauling supplies to the mountains, until the enemy landings on Panay were made on 15 April 42. Food supplies enough to last for 1 year were stored in different caches in the mountains and the Div was geared for guerrilla operations. First encounter with the enemy was on Dilagila Ridge west of the town of Calinogon central Panay. The 3<sup>rd</sup> Bn of the 63<sup>rd</sup> Inf ambushed the enemy consisting of one reinforced Regt, on 28 April 42 inflicting heavy casualties on the enemy. None suffered on our side. From then on ambuscades were conducted by small detachments of our forces in May until the orders to surrender on 16 May 42 was received by radio from Gen. Sharp. Gen. Christie refused to surrender without sanction from Gen MacArthur and answered Gen Sharp to that tenor. However, on 22 May 42 an emissary from Gen Wainwright arrived and explained that the Japs will massacre the Fil-Americans trapped in Corregidor if we do not surrender. Our Div

(61") surrendered on 26 May 42, but only a few officers and men actually surrendered. Before Gen Christie consented to surrender, he called Col Peralta and Lt. Col. Velarde, Lt Col Pedro Senen and Major Chaves and gave the instruction to "Carry on" stressing on the importance of furnishing accurate intelligence to Gen MacArthur. For this purpose, the radio set was left in the mountain.

But while December 7 meant "Pearl Harbor" to most of the world, it meant "Clark Field" to the Filipinos and the Americans in the Philippines -- the date to them, halfway around the world and across the international date line, was December 8, 1941. At almost the same moment that the Japs hit Pearl Harbor, they made their attack on Clark Field in Central Luzon, only fifty miles from Manila. There they knocked out the American Far Eastern Air Force with almost the same devastating effect they dealt the U.S. Pacific Fleet 5,000 miles away.

The North Luzon Force, dispersed throughout the central and northern Luzon area, was commanded by Major General Wainwright. It included two units of the Regular Army, the 31st Infantry Regiment and the 192d Tank Battalion, a former National Guard Organization, as well as six units of the Philippine Scouts. These were the 15th and the 57th Infantries, (PS); the 26th Cav. (PS) and the 23rd, 25th and 88th F.A. Regiments (PS). General Wainright also had the following Philippine Army Divisions:

The 11th Reserve Division under Col. William E. Brougher, AUS

The South Luzon Force was under the command of Brig. General George Parker. It consisted of one Regular Army unit, the 13th Tank Battalion; one Philippine Scout unit, the 86th Field Artillery; the 1st and the 2nd Philippine Constabulary Regiments, and three Philippine Army Divisions:  
The 1st Regular Division under Brig. Gen. Fidal Segundo, PA  
The 41st Reserve Division under Brig. Gen. Vicente Lim, PA  
The 51st Reserve Division under Col. Albert H. Jones, AUS  
The Visayan-Mindanao force was commanded by Col. William F. Sharp, with headquarters in Mindanao, and it contained no Regular Army units. It had one Philippine Scout Regiment, the 43rd Infantry; the 3rd Philippine Constabulary Regiment, and three Philippine Army divisions:  
The 61st Reserve Division, under Col. Bradford G. Chennault, USA.  
The 81st Reserve Division, under Col. Guy D. Forty, PA  
The 101st Reserve Division, under Col. Joseph P. Vachon, PA.

There were also elements of other divisions including the 2d Infantry, the 73rd Infantry and the 93rd Infantry.

The Harbor Defense Command, consisting of Corregidor and its satellite islands, was commanded by Brig. Gen. George F. Moore and was composed of two Regular Army Regiments, the 59th and 60th Coast Artillery; two Philippine Scout units, the 91st and the 92nd Coast Artillery Regiments, and the 4th U. S. Marine Regiment, which had just been moved in from Subic Bay.

Command headquarters feared that the single blow at Clark Field had virtually decided the course of the war in the Philippines. The 26th Cavalry, bombed out of Fort Stotsenburg, moved into the nearby mountains, prepared to strike at the first enemy beach landing whenever it might come. On December 9, Nichols Field, another key army air base at Manila was bombed almost to destruction. The Japs apparently hoped to catch that part of the PAF which had gone there for refuge. Group installation destruction, however, was all they accomplished — but that was complete.

Nichols Field was bombed again on Dec 11. The ground force troops had been at defense stations for weeks. The 11th and 21st Divisions were on the Lingayen Gulf beaches, with the 11th covering from Dagupan to the north and the 21st on the beaches around Bolinao to Viga, on Dasol Bay. The 31st Division covered the coastal plain from Dasol Bay to Subic Bay. One battalion of the 15th Philippine Constabulary was rushed to Bagac, on Batangas; the 71st Division and the 91st Division were held in Camp O'Donnell and Cabanatuan as USAFFE reserve. The 1st Division, Philippine Army was disposed to delay advance of the enemy force coming towards Manila from Legazpi; the 11th Division was disposed to oppose landings on the Cavite and the Batangas Coast. The 51st Division was set to meet east coast landings at Lason Bay. The 61st Division went into position in the Visayan-Mindanao area with the 101st Division.

On December 20, the scheduled landing was made by one reinforced Japanese regiment at Davao, on Mindanao. This landing of the Sakaguchi Detachment was virtually unopposed. General Sharp had more than 1500 miles of shore to defend and no air reconnaissance to indicate where the Japs might strike. His 61st Division, just then being organized, was in Cebu. He had started the organization of the 101st Division only a short time before. General Sharp, therefore, had to depend primarily on the 61st Division, Philippine Army, the 3rd Philippine Constabulary Regiment, and two companies of the 43rd Infantry, Philippine Scouts. Supplementing these he had one regiment from each of three divisions — the 1st, the 71st and the 91st — of the Philippine Army in Luzon. It had been planned originally that these three regiments would join their divisions in Luzon, but the sudden outbreak of the war prevented this, and so they remained under General Sharp's control.

Once again a Philippine commander was faced with the prospect of opposing enemy artillery with rifles. Within five days after the landing at Davao, another artillery-reinforced company landed on the island of Jolo, on General Sharp's southwestern flank. This little island is almost exactly halfway between North Borneo and Zamboanga on the end of Mindanao, dividing the Sulu from the Celebes Sea.

In general, no overall impression is presented because much more has been learned subsequently than indicated. An analysis of consequences can be based on events to within 001 second and just 0.001 second earlier. Events during which one event fails to influence another had all ended at some time before the earliest event. Events which occur a long time later are excluded. Information held on planning levels and initial levels is retained and has been checked against available knowledge and had not been eliminated. Information which is retained is -- fail not has fail not fail not -- retained until it does not affect planning normally used for it. Most of work accomplish is not done until an analysis starts that shows significant errors would occur because of it or has a high probability that it does not occur. Some significant information is discarded after it is determined that it does not contribute significantly to the final answer.

Regimental History: The 1st Bn of the original 63d Inf which became th 1st Bn of 6th Inf was mobilized at Banga, Capiz 27 Aug 41. The majority of the members of the regiment or the component parts were mobilized at Ft San Pedro, Illeilo City on 13 Dec 41. The men were called to active duty between the period of 13 Dec 41 to 17 Dec 41 and were inducted "en masse" as they reported for duty by Col. Quimbo at Dingis, Illeilo City. On 6 Jan 42 the Regt was at Dingis and proceeded to Das, Capiz, its permanent sector. During the month of Feb and Mar '42 organized the 66th Inf but were able to organize only three Cos. A, B & C were attached to 6th Inf for duty. CO "C" was designated as warning service. On 16 Apr 42, the enemy landed at Capiz. A delaying action was fought until the Regt retreated and encountered the enemy at Miangy, Sigma and Dumaraoc, Capiz. During this encounter light casualties was sustained. Upon order of Gen. Christie, Commanding General of 61st Div., to surrender the Regt surrendered at Tapaz and Libacae, Capiz on 30 and 31 May 1942.

Bn History: The officers and keymen were mobilized on 27 Aug 41 at Banga, Capiz, and was inducted on 1 Sep 41. After induction the Bn moved to Camp Delgado, Iloilo City for refresher course under the American Instructors. After completion of the course they were taken to Panitan, Capiz to receive their men. When the war broke out, they were sent to Pavia, Iloilo for temporary station. The whole Bn was move to Quartero, Capiz. After a month in this place the Bn was transferred to Bo Mianay, Sigma, Capiz. In the latter part of Mar '42, the Bn was ordered to go to their security area in Jamindan, Capiz. On 16 Apr 42 the Japs landed in Capiz, Capiz. Upon order from Regt Hq., Co "C" under Capt Guillermo Ortaliz, was given a mission to delay the enemy at Bo Mianay, Sigma, Capiz. A day after the enemy made a successful landing in Capiz beach, the Jap troops proceeded to Lambunao, Iloilo via Sigma road. Co "C" engaged the enemy at Mianay, Sigma road and made several hundred casualties against the enemy. The greater bulk of men of this Co, were not able to join the Bn which was ordered to proceed to their security area at Mt Baloy. On 30 May 42, under order from higher commander the Bn surrendered at Tapaz, Capiz. Officers and men who made a formal surrender were taken to Dao Church, Dao, Capiz then to Capiz Emmanuel Hospital. After a couple of months as POW, we were sent to Pototan Market at Iloilo. In view of the activities of the guerrillas in Panay the Japanese Bn moved the POW to Ft San Pedro Iloilo City and later to camp Delgado, Iloilo wherein the POW in the three provinces of Panay Island were concentrated. On 5 Nov 42, a Japanese transport took

all POW to Manila. On 9 Nov 42, the boat arrived in Manila. The POW passed the night in Bilibid compound. The following day we were taken to Camp O'Donnell, Capas, Tarlac. On 21 Jan 43 thousands of POW were released.

FROM THE HISTORY OF THE 102D MEDICAL BATTALION (PA)

The 102nd Division was activated on Feb 1942 in Northern Mindanao under the command of Col Joseph Morse, USA. The Hq Medical Bn of this Division was organized by Capt Cesarico de Asis out of medical civilian volunteers from Cebu and Mindanao. The Bn Hq and Clearing Station was established in Sante Fe, Bukidnon, about 10 Km from Del Monte. The 102d Div composed of the 61st FA and 61st FA (fighting as Infantrymen) and the 103d Infantry saw action on the beach of Cagayan - Tagaloan on 3 May 42 and at Daling, Bukidnon on 7 May 42 until the day of surrender 10 May 42.

Bn History: During the first week of March 1942, the 3<sup>rd</sup> Bn was reorganized when officers regularly commissioned arrived from Bataan. All commissioned grades before reorganization were acting capacity to fill up the T/O & E while there was shortage of officers ROTC Cadets were commissioned Actg 3<sup>rd</sup> Lts. After a few week Capt. Sabino was assigned CO of the Bn and there was another reorganization on or about 23 April 42. Capt Malino was transferred to the Regt Hq, Lt Fajardo was assigned as CO "K" Co and Lt Ac-Ac as Ex-0 and Adjutant and Bn S-4. On or about 22 May 42, the 3<sup>rd</sup> Bn was given the Valderama-Sn Remigio Sector where Lt Ac-Ac was assigned sector Comdr vice Capt. Sabino. An order of surrender was issued and the Bn surrendered 31 May 42. The Bn strength before surrender reached 520 officers and men and poorly armed. Boles and spears were being used instead.

Bn History: Most of the officers and non-commissioned officers were sent to Ft William McKinley where they were trained beginning to 1 Sept 41 to about the end of Nov 41. Then they were all sent to Iloilo and assigned for further training at Anilao, Iloilo. Bn was there when the war broke out. For security and to better cope with service to the Division, the Med Bn was transferred to Caling, Iloilo on or about 11 Dec 41. Then on the early of Jan 42, the Hdtrs and Hdtrs Detachment and the Clearing Co. were abolished and their respective personnel and equipments were distributed among the three Collecting Companies - which were assigned:-Coll "A" to Iloilo; Coll "B" to Capiz; Coll "C" to Antique. Landing of the enemies the three Collecting Cos. were:- "A" Collecting at Mambunao, Iloilo. "B" Collecting at Jamindan, Capiz, and "C" Collecting at Valderrama, Antique.

The 61st and 62nd Medical Companies and the Medical Detachment for the 61st FA Regt accompanied their respective units to Mindanao shortly before X'mas of 1941.
