- 10-4-43- Medical supplies from Jap yesterday. Rather large supply of B Eliter, Eliter of Newbretal, Brown's Cough, mixture etc. Good day. No rain. Making movie - 1900 engaged.
- 10-5-43- Good day no rain. Contains to make more. Only 3 00 prisoner involved- Col Brady chief.
- 10-6-43- Cool, mixed cloudy and sunny. No rain. Dr. Such iro hospital & camp supply for his last () none found so far-Hospital is getting fixed up fairly well, but much to be done yet. Only 150 on () detail today.
- 10-8-43-Lovely day. Cool & clear. Has conference c Col Beecher, Shrene, Faquet, Freemy, drummond, schwartz & myself. He-ders doi ng farm. He says it is a Japanese order but he will try to work as ma ny of the Drs into camp sanitation and mess details as he can by a gradual process, i. e. A proportion ate numbers. We wire see how it works but I'm not too hopeful. Have a meeting of the casual () and in formed them of the results of the conference. We now get ¥40.00 per () but we can buy very little no one in camp may have more than ¥50 .00 in his possession during one month. () may high in most instances. Coffee- 12.50 per kilo; eggs 25¢ & very scarce; corned beef-7.50 to 10.00 per can & scarce; One blat file cost; ¥35.00)Thirty five Pesos(; The Japanese say we can now buy our clothes & no more will be issued us. A pair of shoes would probably cost two months salary. Our Drs at the same time work on 10¢ per day jobs (but do not get it).
- 10-9-43- Fair day-Inspectedhosp to Schwartz-Getting straightened and fairly well since the move. Yesterday Little Speedo got hear t up because he was identified as the party who cut up a litter in the hosp area. Also we were called to Jap hqrs and told that 220 () what on the last detail and the Manila office did not know about it were not too happy. A hqrs must write a letter and explain why the amoebic were sent. Any way the hospital was inspected today and everything was wrong. () was about to be relieve (He identified li ttle Speedo). Capt was told he was wasting fire most by making shoes out of it (He needed shoes) & that fire wood was very scarce(The Americans cut all of the wood.)They did contain the utility shop in the hospital to make more room. For pts altho no more room is needed no damned go od.
- 10-10-43- Jap inspected groups and again raised hell. The dr had to go to Manila unexpected today. The amoebics must come back and be replaced by non-amoebics including Capt Vernon. Hard rain about noon. Maj Leutz comes in and tells this one: A few days ago Maj. Sult was in the his Bahay. Maj. Bodine & Maj Hubbard were there also not know ing Sult was there. Hubbard read a () Mendation, for DSC for Bodine which Hubbard had written. Bodine asked Hubbard to hav e the recory inendating with him for a while so he could get the gist of the recommendation and then I (Bodine)were write you (Hubban) one what t he Hell Today Hubban is sent back to the Hosp as a pt on request of Col Beecher. Hubban wants to make a test case of his case to see if the line has a right to () Mr. D's to do ordinary work.
- 10-11-43-Happy birthday to Patsy. I'll bet if she is alive and well she will be happy for she is like that. Yesterday we had Dr on the farm & E. men acting as 1st aid men. Funny set up-Today we have the same thing and tomorrow same thing. The Jap are still making the picture of down c-the Star and Strips. Now 100 prisoners are engaged i n the making. They seem to be enjoying it but it seems a funny set up to me-I'm waiting on Treatment of war wounds for Dr Nogi. We get cigarettes, sugar, & Bananas today and appreciate them very much.
