This one sat out by the ravine
near the hospital entrance and
took all the bombing and shelling
that came. Shrapnel and high exp.
fragments punched holes in it and
battered it up considerably but she
kept right on turning over. After
the surrender, moved it up to Top-
side with us and it kept on
turning out the work. When we came
to Manila, loaded her aboard the Sierra
Mare and brought over as a part
of hospital equipment. Here at
Belvid set it up and has been
turning out the entire hospital laundry
for the prison hospital. This machine
has thus served to date thru thru
23 months of the war, 6 mos. under
fire, and 16 mos. in prison camp.
