to the Demalog trail. Trail 3x was a scene of utter confusion-artillery trucks, Filipino soldiers and stragglers from the AC regt. Air activity was intense and wholesale massacre of the massed personnel was prevented only by the exhaustion of ammunition by the Jap planes, which continued to drive and strafe the trail as a harassing measure. We came upon a stalled private auto. which Lt Col Hardee was helping to push over the embankment close to the Demalog Trail and gave him a lift over Col. Doane appeared in a command car and issued orders to hold the troops on the Demalog Trail stating that he and Lt Col Hardee were going to the telephone at the junction of the East road-Demalog and contact corps, that he'd return in fifteen minutes - They were not seen again for over since hours-

After waiting for approximately two hours in the above position, I decided to order a withdrawal to the East Road and at the junction of the East road & the Demalog Trail received verbal orders from Col Doane transmitted by Lt Gouse ~~1/4~~ to retire the Limay and await further orders. Upon arrival at Limay & ordered the troops to deploy along the east road and rest. At approximately 9:00 a --- Lt Col Brady, 31st Inf. (US) arrived from the west and stated that he had just left General Blumel and that a position at KF 148 was to be occupied and that he was on his way to Corps ---- further, that time Baylight was short and ----- should be occupied during the hours of darkness. The absence of other orders at that time, and April 7th, 1941.

After having withdrawn units along the OFIP to the MLR orders were issued to take of a position running diagonally NE-SW establishing contact on the left at the junction of TRAIL #38 and the proper RRL and on the right with the 31st Inf (PA) at a point approx. 500 yds south of the former MLR complied with and reported to regt. Co. in person at his temp. CP on RRL in center of 1st Bat. position approx. 300 yds in rear. Col Doane retired to the rear to establish himself at the new Regt. CP (Location unknown at the time, Lt Col Hardee having been about a considerable time to locate CP & contact II Corps) stating that he would notify me by couriers of new position and would issue any necessary orders then. Having received no message for approx. 2 hrs. and small arms fire having increased in intensity and drawn near during this time, I left Capt Coleman in command and from proceeded on boat, accompanied by Lt Col Sewall, who was also in search of Regt CP. A little more than few miles back of the RRL, Col Doane, Lt Col Hardee and members of the regt. Staff were found finishing a prepared lunch. No messengers had been passed en route and no effort had been made to establish any contact with either Bat. Col Doane ordered that a new position along the Fotoc Trail be occupied with the right flank of the 1st Bat at the junction Fotoc #34, the front extending to the SW with the 2d Bat on the left. Lt Col Sewall and I borrowed a command car and drive and returned to my right flank, passing stragglers from the 31st Inf (PA) as well as air corps soldiers from the 2d Bat., picking of two wounded. The command car and wounded were sent to the rear upon reaching my right flank where I issued the necessary orders to withdraw and sent Capt Coleman to the junction of Fotoc. Lt Col Sewall proceeding in the direction of his Bat. position. In less than ten minutes Lt Col Sewall passed at a high rate of speed in an identified command car enroute to the rear. Units of the 2d Bat followed in disorder. I stopped an officer who reported that force of Japanese infantry risen and tanks had broken-through their line on the left cutting off two squadrons- I remained on my right flank position and directed the 20th Bomb, Bg. 27th Bomb Gp., 17th Bomb Sq, and lastly the 48th Mt. Sq., Lt Col Sewall having neglected to transmit the orders for withdrawal or to take up the new position. I accompanied

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the 48th Mat. Sq., as a rear guard, but no contact with enemy troops was made. Air activity, artillery action, and small arms fire was intense on the left flank along and west of trail #38 as well as to the north; however no barrage was laid nor bombs dropped on the troops scurrying along trail #34- at the junction #38-Potoc, I ordered Capt Coleman to proceed with the 48th and inspect the men here to ascertain that each unit was in position and proceeded to the Regt. CP to report that the regt. was occupying the position. Upon arrival I was fortunate to catch a car occupied by Lts Gouse and Kennedy departing for the rear-the CP was deserted. I was informed that the report of Japanese troops and tanks from miles in the north had caused a great deal of confusion and that Col Doane & Lt Col Hardee had jumped into cars and rushed away shouting "Banks" Let's go. Everybody fall back to the Demalog. No message had been sent to the command. I sent my runner to notify Capt Coleman and drove later that they had fired upon Japanese infantrymen in the Bat. left flank inflicting two casualties, and withdrew to their assigned station at the junction of T #30 and the CFLR-after a personal reconnaissance at a point approximately midway between flanks and approx. two hundred yards rear of the center sp. (28th Mat Sq) The 19th AB Sq Co. notified me by runner that contact had been established with the 31st FA on the right and the Sq Co of the 7th Mat Sq. did likewise as regards quite with the right flank of the 2d Bat. All organization cars reported in person as sent officers to report contact all along the Bat. front CO's reported in person on sent officers to report contact all along the Bat. front in the new position. This information was in the new position, given to the Regt Co. who had established temporary CP close by-approx. 2 hrs. elapsed during which enemy artillery and an action on our left continued and sporadic small arms fire was heard there was no contact with the enemy on my front at this time although others was increasing every enemy air recon. over the area. The Regt. Co. stiff withdrew to establish a new CP farther to the rear and to attempt to establish contact with II Corps, Col Doane stating that he would notify me by courier immediately upon reaching the new CP its locations and would issue any pertinent orders at that time. After several hours of comparative inactivity with increasing small arms fire on our left.

April 6th 1941 - Intensified air and artillery actions to our left continued this date. Rolling barrages were seen to roll per back of our original MLR and enemy battery positions were observed in ----- to our NLR on the left. This information was reported by the regimental CP. The entire 1st Bat. was increasing-by ----- and the action on our left continued through the night.

April 7th 1941 - Early this a.m. regt. CO ordered-that the heavy weapons be held in readiness to be sent by truck to the rear-necessary orders were subsequently issued and the heavier 50 Cal. guns and plusammunitions was sent to the rear necessary orders were subsequently issued and the heavier 50 cal. guns and plus ammunition were sent to the rear shortly after daylight., at approximately 7:00 in Regt CP ordered that the units on the left on the CFLR be drawn to the rear forming a dragon line maintaining contact with the 31st Inf. (FA on the night on the original CFLR position and with the right flank of the 2d Bat. at the MCR. This had hardly been accomplished

when the order ---- issued to withdraw units from the BFLR and to contact the 31st PA on the right at a point south of the HLR and the 3d. to the Demlog trail. Trail 3x was a scene of utter confusion--artillery trucks, Filipino soldiers and stragglers from the 40 regt. Air activity was intense and wholesale massacre of the massed personnel was prevented only by the exhaustion of ammunition by the Jap planes, which continued to drive and strafe the trail as a harassing measure. We came upon a stalled private auto. which Lt Col Hardee was helping to push over the embankment close to the Demlog Trail and gave him a lift over Col. Doane appeared in a command car and issued orders to hold the troops on the Demlog Trail stating that he and Lt Col Hardee were going to the telephone at the junction of the East road-Demlog and contact corps, that he'd return in fifteen minutes - They were not seen again for over nine hours-

After waiting for approximately two hours in the above position, I decided to order a withdrawal to the East Road and at the junction of the East road & the Demlog Trail received verbal orders from Col Doane transmitted by Lt Cause ~~AAA~~ to retire the Limay and await further orders. Upon arrival at Limay I ordered the troops to deploy along the east road and rest. At approximately 3:00 a --- Lt Col Brady, 31st Inf. (US) arrived from the west and stated that he had just left General Blumel and that a position at KP 148 was to be occupied and that he was on his way to Corps ---- further, that time daylight was short and ----- should be occupied during the hours of darkness. The absence of other orders at that time, and April 7th, 1941.

After having withdrawn units along the OPLP to the MLR orders were issued to take of a position running diagonally NE-SW establishing contact on the left at the junction of TRAIL #38 and the proper RRL and on the right with the 31st Inf (PA) at a point approx. 500 yds south of the former MLR occupied with and reported to regt. Co. in person at his temp. CP on RRL in center of 1st Bat. position approx. 300 yds in rear. Col Doane retired to the rear to establish himself at the new Regt. CP (Location unknown at the time, Lt Col Hardee having been about a considerable time to locate CP & contact II Corps) stating that he would notify me by courier of new position and would issue any necessary orders then. Having received no message for approx. 2 hrs. and small arms fire having increased in intensity and drawn near during this time, I left Capt Coleman in command and from proceeded on boat, accompanied by Lt Col Sewall, who was also in search of Regt CP. A little more than few miles back of the RRL, Col Doane, Lt Col Hardee and members of the regt. Staff were found finishing a prepared lunch. No messengers had been passed en route and no effort had been made to establish any contact with either Bat. Col Doane ordered that a new position along the Potos Trail be occupied with the right flank of the 1st Bat at the junction Potos #34, the front extending to the SW with the 2d Bat on the left. Lt Col Sewall and I borrowed a command car and drive and returned to my right flank, passing stragglers from the 31st Inf (PA) as well as air corps soldiers from the 2d Bat., picking of two wounded. The command car and wounded were sent to the rear upon reaching my right flank where I issued the necessary orders to withdraw and sent Capt Coleman to the junction of Potos. Lt Col Sewall proceeding in the direction of his Bat. position. In less than ten minutes Lt Col Sewall passed at a high rate of speed in an identified command car enroute to the rear. Units of the 2d Bat followed in disorder. I stopped an officer who reported that force of Japanese infantry risen and tanks had broken through their line on the left cutting off two squadrons- I remained on my right flank position and directed the 20th Bomb, Sq., 27th Bomb Sq., 17th Bomb Sq, and lastly the 48th Mat. Sq., Lt Col Sewall having neglected to transmit the orders for withdrawal or to take up the new position. I accompanied

the 48th Mt. Sq., as a rear guard, but no contact with enemy troops was made. Air activity, artillery action, and small arms fire was intense on the left flank along and west of trail #38 as well as to the north; however no barrage was laid nor bombs dropped on the troops scurrying along trail #34 at the junction #38-Petec. I ordered Capt Coleman to proceed with the 48th and inspect the men here to ascertain that each unit was in position and proceeded to the Regt. CP to report that the regt. was occupying the position. Upon arrival I was fortunate to catch a car occupied by Lts Gause and Kennedy departing for the rear-the CP was deserted. I was informed that the report of Japanese troops and tanks from miles in the north had caused a great deal of confusion and that Col Deane & Lt Col Hardee had jumped into cars and rushed away shouting "Banks! Let's go. Everybody fall back to the Demlog. No message had been sent to the command. I sent my runner to notify Capt Coleman and drove later that they had fired upon Japanese tanks trying to the Bat. left flank inflicting two casualties, and withdrew to their assigned station at the junction of T #30 and the OPLR-after a personal reconnaissance at a point approximately midway between flanks and approx. two hundred yards rear of the center sp. (28th Mt Sq) The 19th AB Sq Co. notified me by runner that contact had been established with the 31st FA on the right and the Sq Co of the 7th bat Sq. did likewise as regards quite with the right flank of the 2d Bat. All organization cars reported in person as sent officers to report contact all along the Bat. front CO's reported in person on sent officers to report contact all along the Bat. front in the new position. This information was in the new position. Given to the Regt Co. who had established temporary CP close by-approx. 2 hrs. elapsed during which enemy artillery and an action on our left continued and sporadic small arms fire was heard there was no contact with the enemy on my front at this time although others was increasing every enemy air recon. over the area. The Regt. Co. staff withdrew to establish a new CP farther to the rear and to attempt to establish contact with II Corps, Col Deane stating that he would notify me by courier immediately upon reaching the new CP its locations and would issue any pertinent orders at that time. After several hours of comparative in activity with increasing small arms fire on our left.

April 6th 1941 - Intensified air and artillery actions to our left continued this date. Rolling barrages were seen to roll per back of our original MBR and enemy battery positions were observed in ----- to our NLR on the left. This information was reported by the regimental CP. The entire 1st Bat. was increasing-by ----- and the action on our left continued through the night.

April 7th 1941 - Early this a.m. regt. CO ordered-that the heavy weapons be held in readiness to be sent by truck to the rear;necessary orders were subsequently issued and the heavier 50 Cal. guns and plusammunitions was sent to the rear necessary orders were subsequently issued and the heavier 50 cal. guns and plus ammunition were sent to the rear shortly after daylight., at approximately 7:00 in Regt CP ordered that the units on the left on the OPLR be drawn to the rear forming a dragon line maintaining contact with the 31st Inf. (FA on the night on the original OPLR position and with the right flank of the 2d Bat. at the MBR. This had hardly been accomplished

when the order ---- issued to withdraw units from the RFLR and to contact the 31st PA on the right at a point south of the NLR and the 3d. But on the left on a diagonal to the RFL at Trail #38, the 2d Bat to extend in a diagonal direction to the W of #38 covering this trail and refusing over flank. Orders were issued to the -----

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
