INSTRUCTIONS

1. There are four carbon sheets fastened in the inside back cover to this book. These are intended to permit the making of one, two, three, or four carbon copies of the message. At least two carbon copies are always required, the original and one carbon copy to be delivered to the message sender and the other carbon copy to be retained in the book or other local file. It may be desired or required by local regulations that one or two additional carbon copies be prepared for other distribution. Only the required number of carbon copies are prepared.
2. Write plainly. Print proper names (except signature and grade of writer) and code or cipher groups in CAPITALS.
3. Write the message in as few words as possible. If the writer desires punctuation marks transmitted they must be spelled out, otherwise they will not be sent (examples: Comma, colon, period, dash). Use only authorized abbreviations.
4. "No."—Insert the serial number given the message by the writer.
5. "Date"—Write the date in the following order: Day, month, year (example: 16 Dec 31).
6. "To"—Insert the official designation of the person addressed (example: CO 1st Inf). Add his actual location only when necessary to insure delivery. Do not use the telephone code as an address code.
7. "Official designation of sender."—This shows the official capacity in which the sender is serving (examples: "CO 1st Inf 1st Inf" or "Leader, Patrol No 1").
8. "Time signed"—This must always be filled in (example: 10:45 AM).
9. "Signature and grade of writer."—This includes the personal signature of the sender of the message or of the person who may be authorized to write the message for him.
10. The tissue sheets in the back are for pigeon messages. They may also be used as file copies.
11. The vellum sheets in the back are for sketches or tracings.
