at 1st Bombing Hosp #1 Bataan, Lt. J. McAverney & Civilian Willard Hart, Capt. Madill (then Lt.), at that time constructing Hospital addition, were in Col. Fertig's office. The bombing set afire the gasoline & diesel fuel dumps. The fire was approaching a large dump of 155 G.P.F. demolition charges and detonators. The above named men secured a truck and loaded the explosives, surrounded by fire, and took the truck thru to the ordnance depot. Recommended for Silver Star by Cap't George Wood, Supply officer--deceased.
