Determination Under The Missing Persons Act (EOD DATE for WAR DEPARTMENT CIVILIANS)

1. In the completion of a determination of status under the Missing Persons Act for a War Department Givilian employee an entrance on duty (EDD) date will only be shown when appropriate.

2. No special effort will be made to ascertain or report in the Memo for Record as "Interest on Duty" date when civilian pay records shor payment of salary for the senth of November 1941. In such cases the statement "paid through 30 November 1941" will be included in the Memo for Record.

3. If the EDD date is alleged to be 1 December 1941 or a date subsequent thereto but prior to the surrender on 6 May 1942, the Memo for Mecond will contain a discussion of the EDD date. The date determined to be the first day of duty will be shown in the Memo for Memord and smooth the Official Determination of Status of the person concerned. In such cases the EDD date will be shown in the official Determination of Status between the period of service and the agency or department where employed as follows:
