USARCEN FORM 646, REQUEST FOR ARCHIVE INFORMATION  
AND REPORT OF SEARCH

WHEN USED: This form is used by the Sections of Recovered Personnel Records Branch when requesting information from the Archive Records.

NO. COPIES: One.

DISPOSITION: Upon completion of Archive search, Archival information will be recorded in Item eleven (11), Remarks portion thereof; and Item twelve (12) (A-B-C-D). Form is then routed to originator of request.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Each file to be searched is indicated in Item ten (10) by placing an "X" in the pertinent box or boxes. If a search of particular items under "USAFFE Card Index Files" is required, request for search can be indicated by placing an "X" in the appropriate box in Item eleven (11).

a. USAFFE Card Index Files:

1. Capas Death Roster: If a card(s) for identical or similar name is found on file the word "Listed" will be entered in space provided under item eleven (11). An extract will be prepared directly from card to USARCEN Form 670 (See Figure 6). If no card(s) is found, an "X" is placed in the box prior to entry "NR" under item eleven (11) Capas Death Roster.

2. O'Donnell POW: If a card(s) for identical or similar name is found on file, the book and page number is shown in space provided under item eleven (11) (ie: MN 26 or Off 25). (The term "Off" is to indicate commissioned officers since they are listed on a separate roster). Extracts are prepared directly from the official records, therefore this step is not completed until the remainder of the items are searched. USARCEN Form 629 (See Figure 14) is completed and inclosed with USARCEN Form 646. If no card(s) is found an "X" is placed in the box prior to entry "NR" under item eleven (11) O'Donnell POW.

3. Manila Tribune: If a card(s) for identical or similar name is found on file the word "Listed" will be entered in space provided under item eleven (11). Extracts(s) will be prepared directly from information shown on card(s) onto US ARCEN Form 629 (See Figure 9) however, if rank is not shown on card it will be necessary to make manual search of Manila Tribune file. If no card(s) is found, an "X" is placed in the box prior to entry "NR" under item eleven (11) Manila Tribune.

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4. Pampanga POW: If a card(s) for identical or similar names is found on file the word "Listed" will be entered in the space provided under item eleven (11). Extract(s) will be prepared directly from information shown on card(s) onto USARGEN Form 669 (See Figure 8). If no card(s) is found, an "X" is placed in the box prior to entry "NR" under item eleven (11) Pampanga POW.

5. Malaybalay: The reference on this item may be entered in two different ways.

a. If a card(s) is found on file pertaining to roster of troops, the reference (ie: 383.6 F3 P5) is placed in spaces provided under item eleven (11). Information is extracted from Archive to USARGEN Form 629, (See Figure 7) therefore this step is not completed until remainder of items are searched.

b. If a card(s) is found on file pertaining to the POW list by Provinces, the word "Listed" is placed in space provided under item eleven (11) and the information is extracted directly from cards(s) to USARGEN Form 629 (See Figure 7).

c. If no card(s) is found an "X" is placed in the box prior to entry "NR" under item eleven (11) Malaybalay.

6. Casualty in Field and Elsewhere: If card(s) is found in file, the file reference number will be entered in space provided under item eleven (11). (Example: Supp list #5 P6) Extract(s) must be prepared from the official records directly to USARGEN Form 638, (See Figure 15) therefore this step is not completed until the remainder of items are searched. If no card(s) is found, an "X" is placed in the box prior to entry "NR" under item eleven (11) Casualty in Field and Elsewhere.

7. Hospital(s): If a card(s) is found on file pertaining to Tarlac Provincial; Pampanga; Hermosa Emergency; Bulacan Provincial or War Invalids from Veterans Hospitals, the name of the hospital(s) will be entered in the space provided under item eleven (11). Extract(s) will be prepared directly from information shown on card(s) onto USARGEN Form 675 (See Figure 10) on War Invalids from Veterans Hospital. In the case of the other hospitals, file and reference number will be entered in space provided under item eleven (11). (Example: Tarlac Prov Hosp #1031 P12). Extracts will be prepared from official records onto USARGEN Form 675, therefore this step is not completed until remainder of items are searched. If no card(s) is found pertaining to hospitalization, an "X" is placed in the box prior to entry "NR" under item eleven (11), Hospital.

8. NSLI (National Service Life Insurance): There are three (3) type of reference cards pertaining to NSLI, each type is listed separately below:

a. Radiograms (NSLI): If card(s) is found on file with information shown as follows: "NSLI Bk 21 P32," the reference information is

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entered in space provided under item eleven (11) on USARGEN Form 646 (ie: Bk 21 P32). The information will be extracted direct from archive onto USARGEN Form 676, (See Figure 12) therefore this step is not completed until remainder of items are searched.

b. NSLI Policy data: If card(s) is found on file with information similar to the following: "NSLI-SN 90 014 051-Pol #9 759 448-\$1000-Eff. date: 3-1-42-\$67 Allot. Date: Sched B. Disch Date: None: The word "Listed" will be entered in space provided under item eleven (11) on USARGEN Form 646. Information will be extracted direct from reference card onto USARGEN Form 676. (See Figure 12)

c. WDGR (War Department Casualty Report): If card(s) is found on file, usually a yellow card of IBM size, which shows the name, rank, service number, ninety million (90,000,000) number and usually the next of kin or beneficiary, the word "Listed" will be entered in space provided under item eleven (11). (Note: The entry "Listed" need only be entered once under NSLI). The information will be extracted directly from card onto USARGEN Form 683 (See Figure 13).

d. If no card(s) is located pertaining to NSLI, an "X" is placed in the box prior to entry "NR" under item eleven (11).

9. Other (Specify): If card(s) is found in file pertaining to USAFFE (PA) organizations, Philippine Army Special or General Order files or other miscellaneous archives, the reference information is placed in space provided under item eleven (11). Each reference is given a number in the order it is listed. (Example: (1) 300.4 F1 P2 (2) 242.5 F2 P1 (3) Army Hqs Bk 1 Pr (4) Cas Rpts 6th MD Bk 2 P29). This is done in order that when the reference data is entered there will be no confusion in identifying references at a later date. Information will be taken from the records and extracted onto USARGEN Form 626 under "Remarks". If the "Remarks" section is not large enough for all data to be entered, the reverse side and/or additional sheet of paper may be used. If no card(s) is found pertaining to organizational or other miscellaneous archives, the entry "NR" will be entered under item eleven (11) "Other (Specify)".

When all references have been listed the searching clerk will remove appropriate records from the USAFFE Archive and Philippine Special Order File, entering information on extract forms, where applicable, and writing (or printing) other compiled data in the appropriate space provided on USARGEN Form 646.

When it is necessary to furnish typewritten extract copies of archives, the searching clerk completes all other items requested on USARGEN Form 646, then gives typist the case and appropriate archive for extract(s) to be typed.

2. Guerrilla Affairs Division (GAD) Rosters: When an "X" appears in the box preceeding Guerrilla Affairs Division Rosters under item ten (10), searching clerk will check item four (4) to determine specific guerrilla

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organization(s) involved. An alphabetic and phonetic search of the GAD IBM card file will then be made. Code numbers shown on card(s) will be checked against IBM code listings to determine if any cards pertain to a similarly named individual serving with specific organization. (NOTE: The code on IBM cards are arranged as follows: 02 011 269; the first group of two (2) digits refer to guerrilla organizational code; the second group of three (3) digits pertain to page on which name appears; and the third (3rd) group of three (3) digits give the folder numbers of the guerrilla organization).

a. Positive search: - If card(s) is located on a similarly named individual serving with specified organization, the following procedure will be followed:

(1) An "X" will be placed in box, immediately prior to entry "See Reverse Side" on same line as entry (item ten (10) "Guerrilla Affairs Division Rosters".

(2) Rosters(s) as indicated by IBM card(s) is located and searching clerk withdraws appropriate guerrilla rosters(s) from file.

(3) Searching clerk will make a check of rosters(s) to determine whether or not name is listed on roster as shown on IBM card(s).

(4) Searching clerk enters information concerning the contents of the roster and the recognition dates of the organization are entered under item twelve of USARCEN Form 646 as follows:

(a) The type of roster (Initial Reconstructed Troop Roster or (Initial and Revised Reconstructed Roster) are indicated by lining thru the inappropriate entry.

There are two (2) types of rosters concerning initial recognition:

(1) A roster which serves as the Initial Reconstructed Troop Roster (IRTR) and the Reconstructed Revised Roster (RRR).

(2) Rosters which pertain to the initial period of recognition only. (Some of these rosters pertain to the only recognition period granted to units and others may have separate RRR's).

(b) The complete designation of the guerrilla unit as shown on the roster will be entered in space provided under item twelve (12) A.

(c) The recognition data, Initial Date of Recognition, Limiting Date of Recognition (if applicable) and Revised Date of Recognition will be entered in spaces provided, (Item 12 A). (The Revised Date of Recognition will be entered only if the statement "Initial Reconstructed Troop Roster" is lined out).

All pertinent recognition data should be found in the front of folder

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containing recognition roster.

Exceptions to this procedure are made on the following units:

- (1) Tenth Military District (10th MD) - An asterisk is placed under items twelve (12) A and remarks similar to the following are made under item twelve (12) D: "See Guerrilla Book":
- (2) Zambales Military District (ZMD) - The remark "As Indicated" is entered in the space provided for recognition data.
- (3) "T" and "V" Companies, 1st Yag Regt, Markings Fil-American Troops. - "As indicated on Roster" will be entered under "Limiting" date of recognition.
- (d) Information pertaining to the individual will be transcribed from the roster in its entirety to space provided under item twelve (12) A.
- (e) If there is a separate RRR, the roster will be manually searched, if information on an identical or similar named individual is located, the information will be transcribed from the roster to space provided under item twelve (12) B.
- (f) The Revised Date of Recognition of Units, as shown on appropriate Revision Recognition letter found in front of folder containing rosters will be entered in space provided under item twelve (12) B.
- (g) If casualty roster information is located, the information will be transcribed in its entirety from the roster to space provided under item twelve (12) C.
- (h) The type of Casualty (KIA - Killed in Action) (KILD - Killed in Line of Duty) (DILD - Died in Line of Duty) (WIA - Wounded in Action) (WILD - Wounded in Line of Duty) (MIA - Missing in Action) or any other specified type will be indicated under item twelve (12) C after the entry "Casualty Roster." The complete designation of the organization will be entered immediately after the type of Casualty information.
- (i) The same conditions applying to the recognition dates of the IRTR apply, however, if there is a Revised Date of Recognition, only the Revised Date of Recognition need be entered.
- (j) The Approval date of Casualty roster will be entered directly from roster to appropriate space under item twelve (12) C. This information is furnished in KIA, KILD, DILD and MIA only.

When no card(s) is found on file in the Guerrilla IBS Card file for a

similarly named individual who served in the specified guerrilla organization, a manual search of the IRTR, Casualty rosters and RRR (if applicable) of the specified guerrilla organization will be made. If information pertaining to a similarly named individual is found by the manual search, the procedures outlined above will apply.

b. Negative Search - When no pertinent Guerrilla IBM card is found on file and a manual search of the IRTR, Casualty roster and RRR (if applicable) of the specified guerrilla organization is negative, an "X" will be placed in box immediately prior to entry "RR" under item eleven (11) on same line as "Guerrilla Affairs Division Rosters" under item ten (10).

3. Guerrilla Archives: When an "X" appears in the box under item ten (10) prior to entry "Request search of Guerrilla Unit Archive", a guerrilla archive search will be made.

a. Positive Search - A manual search of the archives of the specified guerrilla unit is made for information pertaining to a similarly named individual. The information will be listed in the space provided in a brief and concise manner, or, if extract copies are requested, the appropriate archive folder is given to typist for preparation of extract.

b. Negative Search - If a thorough search of the appropriate guerrilla archives is made and no information pertaining to a similarly named individual is found, a negative statement is made in the space provided under ~~remarks~~ item twelve (12).

4. Project "J" Archive Search: A Project "J" Archive search is requested on USARGEN Form 646 by completion of items one (1) thru nine (9) and making the specific request under "Remarks" item nine (9).

a. Positive Search and Compilation of data - A search is made of Project "J" Archive Card File and/or AG 201 file for references pertaining to information requested. If references are located, appropriate records are removed from Project "J" Archive File, and information is entered in the space provided under "Remarks" section of item eleven (11) Search Report, or, on a separate sheet of paper using the following procedure:

- (1) Each reference is numbered consecutively.
- (2) The exact decimal equivalent, Book number and Page number is shown.
- (3) The exact Title, Dates and Origin as shown on book are listed.
- (4) A Brief summary of all information, showing exact spelling of name is written. (See Examples below)

Examples:

(a) 330.32 Book 22 Title: Rosters, 31st Inf (PA)  
Date: Nov - Dec 1941 Origin: Official Troop Rosters. The Monthly Roster of  
"A" Co., 31st Infantry (PA) dated 31 December 1941 lists a Smith, Frank T.  
SN: 16 262 451, Corporal, Remarks: On D/S with 21st Inf PA since 22nd.

(b) 300.4 Book 21 Title: Special and General Orders,  
Hqs, USAFFE Dates: 1951 - March 1942 Origin: Original and/or Mimeograph  
copies Special Order #29 dated 16 February 1942 lists a Smith, Thomas Frank  
SN: 16 261 162, Corporal A Co, 43rd Infantry (PS), promoted to Sergeant  
effective 17 February 1942.

b. Negative Search - If a thorough search of the Project "J"  
Card File and references found listed in AG 201 file reveal no pertinent  
information, a negative statement is made in the "Remarks" section of  
Item eleven (11) Search Report. (See Examples below)

(1) No Project "J" Card found on file. A search of all  
references listed fails to reveal any information pertaining to subject  
individual.

(2) A search of Project "J" Archive reference file 500.4  
Bk-32; 999-5-13-1; 1000-1-8 and Project "J" Archive Card file fails to reveal  
any information pertaining to S/I.

**WHEN USED:** When archive information on file in RPRB is needed for completion of Work Unit. Used for subjects, affiants and other necessary personnel.

**NO. OF COPIES:** One.

**DISPOSITION:** 1. Form forwarded to Records Section as a request for archive information.

2. On return of form from Records Section, file as a permanent part of 201 file of subject of form.

**INSTRUCTIONS:** 1. Examiner initiates form and indicates date and type of case in upper right hand corner. If form is on individual other than subject, place name of subject case in upper left hand corner.

2. Examiner completes items one (1) thru ten (10). In some cases Item eleven (11) can be used by examiners when search of a specific Archive, as listed, is to be requested. Item nine (9) is a multiple information blank and should be filled in to the best information available. Item ten (10) Search Requests should be indicated by "X" in blocks preceding archive titles.

3. Examiner submits to Records Section.

4. USARCEN 650 (figure 5) will be used to forward USARCEN 646, or previous editions of form, which contain prior verification of Archives to Records Section, RPR Branch.

5. Records Section completes check for information requested, enters data on form in the spaces provided, and return to Examiner.

6. Examiner files completed form in 201 file of individual named in Item (1).

7. Examiner uses data furnished as evidence in completion of the Work Unit.

8. Remarks: For detailed information regarding completion and content of Form by Records Section, see SOP of Records Section, RPRB.
