1. The following ^{is an estimate} ~~estimates~~ of the number of Philippine Army personnel that died prior to surrender or in POW camps and those that survived:

2. A survey of 10,256 201 files was made to determine the probable number of cases that would be effected in arriving at the cost of paying for No Casualty Status, erroneous deductions pertaining to NSLI, Quarters, 3 months advanced pay, and emergency & guerrilla monies.

3. The ratio of officers to enlisted men is determined as 1 officer to 15 Enlisted men. In computing the cost of the items listed in paragraph B, this ratio was applied to 74,446 Philippine Army personnel estimated to have survived the surrender. The following (1) an estimated 79,312 enlisted men survived

- (1) Survey of 10,256 cases showed 1498 cases had NSLI verified
- (2) 22,000 policies were known to have been issued.

①

- (3) .4% of 1% of the 120,146 ^{known} USAFFE personnel had erroneous deductions made from arrears in pay for NSLI. This error factor is conditional since 201 file in some instances have not been reviewed for verification of NSLI since deduction for NSLI was

$$120,146 \times .0044 = 528.64$$

- (5) THE AVERAGE AGE OF THE USAFFE personnel was estimated at 27 years.
- (6) THE AVERAGE AMOUNT OF policy and premium carried by those with NSLI was \$4,000 and \$2.76 premium monthly.
- (7) THE maximum period THAT Policies could have been in effect was 1 Jan 42 through 30 Jun 46 or 54 months.
- (8) The maximum amount of premiums that could have ^{been} erroneously deducted were as follows:

- (a) 37,000 officers + Enlisted USAF^{Personnel} were considered to have been recognized guerrillas.
- (b) 2.8% of the cases surveyed revealed erroneous deductions.
- (c) An average of $\text{\$} 140$ per man was determined as deducted erroneously.
- (d) The total amount of Emergency + Guerrilla Invoices erroneously deducted from Arrears in Pay was as follows:

are submitted concerning the erroneous deductions for emergency and guerrilla monies:

- A. From the survey of 10,256 cases, it was found that 2.8% of the cases showed erroneous deductions.
- B. An average of P140 was deducted.
- C. To reimburse the Philippine personnel for erroneous deductions of emergency & guerrilla ^{as civilian guerrillas} monies, would amount to the following:

1- Quarters

a. Errors in quarters ^(entitled, not paid) are being checked to determine the cost involved to reimburse those people that were married + entitled to quarters allowance. This means pulling the 51 201 files involved & checking the period of ave that A/P determined was a pay status. The days involved then must be broken down to prior to 1 Jul 42 + subsequent to 1 Jul 42 in order to compute the amount involved.

b. Question - Our statistics show that 191 officers and 2738 EM were reported as single & not paid. Inasmuch as the Committee contends that inadequate quarters were furnished, ^{all men married or single} should we compute the actual cost of quarters in view of the possibility that they may be reimbursed this amount or will the committee accept the number of people involved & decide one way or the other based on those figures alone.

To compute this amount would mean pulling 2929 201 files and figuring the no. of days of pay status prior to 1 Jul 42 unless a statement of pay + allowances is present in case

& subsequent to 1 Jul 45. Is it necessary to do this?

2- NSLI - The cost of reimbursement on NSLI cannot be computed from our figures and would mean checking each rol file in order to determine how many months premiums were deducted erroneously.

3- Returned to Military Control after 15 Aug 45. -

a- From the 10,000 records surveyed, 1360 records revealed individuals returning to military control after 15 Aug 45; however, they were not denied Arrears in Pay. The records were not checked to see if ^{the} Arrears in Pay Program charged the individual with pay for the period subsequent to 15 Aug 45 during which ^{they} were not present ^{for duty} and then deducted it again. It is possible in most of these cases that the A/P program deducted this pay without giving them credit in their total pay. (See claim submitted by the Committee on Obolds + Nicholas).

b. If so each 201 file that shows a deduction w/o basis would have to be rechecked in order to find out the total amount deducted.

c. There is a total of 288 files found that reveal erroneous deductions were made.
