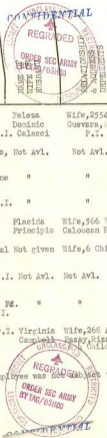



Receipt is acknowledged of the Department's third indorsement of August 1, 1934, requesting the concurrence of the Commission in according Julian Villaflor, an employee of the Philippine Department, a classified status.

From the abstract of service which was furnished, it is noted that Mr. Villaflor is seventy-three years of age and, therefore, is eleven years past the retirement age. He appears to have had practically continuous service since August 14, 1899, in positions of head janitor, messenger, foreman of laborers, capataz, laborer, and janitor.

The Assistant to the Quartermaster, in the first indorsement, recommends that Mr. Villaflor be given a classified status under the Executive order of March 1, 1904, as messenger, with a view to immediate retirement. Such a proposal, even if otherwise permissible, could not be effected because Mr. Villaflor is now past the retirement age. However, attention is respectfully invited to the fact that Mr. Villaflor has never occupied any except unskilled and skilled laborer positions which were specifically excepted from the classified service by the Executive order of March 1, 1904. It is believed the Philippine Department is confused by the Executive order of May 15, 1931, which was designed to correct irregular appointments and reads as follows:

On recommendation of the head of a department or independent establishment and with the approval of the Civil Service Commission, any employee of such executive department or independent establishment in the Philippine Islands who on the date of this order is in the Federal service and who for at least seven years had rendered

faithful and exceptionally meritorious service in a classified position, and who has acquired a rating of at least 40 in a civil service examination that would qualify him for probational appointment in the position, may be given a classified status. Such an employee who has served continuously since March 1, 1904, may be given a classified status without examination.

Attention is invited to the fact that the Order relates only to those irregular appointees who are serving in classified positions; in other words, those positions which are filled from lists of eligibles maintained by the Bureau of Civil Service at Manila. Skilled and unskilled positions are not in this category. The classification of Mr. Villafior cannot, therefore, be effected under existing regulations.

In this connection the Department's attention is respectfully invited to the fact that the Department of Labor, in a circular dated June 8, 1934, General Order No. 209 (55775/263), relating to the application of Immigration Laws to citizens of the Philippine Islands, declared that Filipinos who are not citizens of the United States will be considered aliens on and after May 1, 1934, the date the Act approved March 24, 1934 (Public No. 127 - 73rd Congress), was accepted by concurrent resolution of the Philippine legislature. It appears, therefore, that native employees of the United States Government may no longer be classified under any order.

Reference is made of Department's second indorsement of Oct 8, 1934, approving recommendation of the CSC, that an inclosed radiogram dtd Sep 29 1934 from the Philippine Dept relative to the eligibility of Filipinos for appointment be referred to this office for clarification and instructions.

In this connection you are advised that the commission has decided to continue with its former policy with respect to the admission of Filipinos to examinations, since it appears that Section 8 of the Philippine Independence Act of March 24, 1934, does not effect a change in the status of Filipinos at the present time. The paragraph in the Commission's letter of Aug 9, 1934, to which reference is made, should accordingly be disregarded.
