

- Edisting directives which transferred the function of processing AUS personnel of the light infantry from Paramague Replacement & Disposition Center to the 20th Station Hospital do not provide for similar processing of Philippine Scouts who return to military control.
- 2. Since the processing of Philippine Scouts is a function which was performed by Farmaque Replacement & Disposition Conter and which they consider themselves to have been relieved of as of 25 jan 187, it is requested that current directives to the OD, FHIDOUS and CO, 20th Station Nospital be smended to include that processing of Philippine Scouts.
- 3. It is estimated that no more than 20 Philippine Scout personnel will return to military control.
